

A three-day "Research Scholars' Week" inaugurated at NIT Rourkela

Rourkela, (TNB): NIT Rourkela has organised "Research Scholars' Week" from 12 to 14 May 2023. The inaugural ceremony of the workshop was held today at BB Auditorium, NIT Rourkela. Around 180 scholars of NIT Rourkela, who have completed their research work in four years, will sum up their PhD research work and present it during this three-day programme. Prof. Pitamber Mahanandia (Professor-in-charge of Research Scholars' Week 2023) gave a welcome address and said, "Research Scholars' Week is held every year since its inception in 2015. It is a forum for PhD research

scholars to present their research work. Apart from the keynote speaker, eminent academicians and researchers will participate in this 3-day event. During the programme, papers presented by scholars are evaluated by a multi-departmental panel and selected PhD scholars are further evaluated by a competent committee to select the best research scholar in engineering, science and humanities stream." Inaugurating the event, Chief Guest Prof. K.K. Nanda (Director, Institute of Physics, Bhubaneswar) said, "Due to science and research, human life expectancy has increased;

with research, many products are invented and updated. There is a wide scope in the research field.

Students should try to complete the research work in three years and work hard to complete it in the ideal time. Research enables one to be a subject matter expert, and this programme will provide a common platform for all the researchers to discuss, interact and exchange their ideas." Prof. Pradip Sarkar (Director in charge of NIT Rourkela) congratulated all the selected and invited research scholars and wished them for their scholarly deliberations.



He said, "We are one of the leading institutes of national importance in NIRF research rankings. More than 1000 research scholars are currently pursuing PhD at NIT Rourkela. Celebrating the success of the tireless works of the research scholars, RSW 2023 will develop a new dimension for them. I thank the

distinguished guests and speakers for being part of this forum and interacting with students.

Prof. Susmita Mishra (Dean Academic, NIT Rourkela) gave a brief on academic disciplines and centres of research at NIT Rourkela and said that RSW would strengthen the work of

scholars. Through RSW, the newly admitted scholars will get to know the expertise of faculties at NIT Rourkela and will get a chance to share their ideas, which can be incubated in NIT Rourkela's incubated centre. Guest of Honour, Prof. Debasis Deb (Dept of Mining, IIT Kharagpur) emphasised more on passion-driven research and said, "The main aim of RSW is to determine and identify the best and most worthy research works of scholars and thus perusing research needs a passion for the subject. Many students enrol in random research subjects without having any interest in diving deeper into them. Re-

searchers should make a purpose to wake up in the morning and put continuous effort into achieving that. Identify yourself, choose a mentor or ideal to follow, and get a direction in your career for experiencing the best out of you."

Mr. Sourav Acharya (Scientific Officer-G, Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Mumbai) joined the inaugural session as the Guest of Honour and said, "In India, students get support from government schemes to pursue their PhD, but in many foreign countries, a sponsor is required to enrol in PhD program; mostly for product

based research work within a specific time. Large students to use the benefits provided, set their research goal, and plan their future scope of work." Prof. Jyoti Prakash Kar (Associate Dean Academic) concluded the event with a vote of thanks and applauded the scholars for completing their research in 3 years despite the Covid-19 pandemic. The first and second days of RSW will include poster presentations by research scholars and keynote speeches by guest speakers. Day third will consist of PowerPoint presentations by shortlisted candidates for best paperwork. The valedictory session will include prize distribution and a cultural programme.

Reflection Workshop puts Odisha at forefront in WASH services

Bhubaneswar, (TNB): A one-day workshop on Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) was organized by the Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department, Government of Odisha in collaboration with UNICEF and local and national development partners in Bhubaneswar on Thursday. The objective of the workshop was to analyze the status of progress of Sustainable Development Goal 6 (SDG 6), which is to ensure that everyone in the world has access to lasting and safe water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) services in Odisha. It also aimed to provide an overview of the enabling environment required to ensure safe and lasting services to all - it

looked into the water, sanitation, and hygiene policies, processes, finances, institutional capacities, etc. The workshop also included deliberations with multiple stakeholders on strengthening, convergence, and accountability.

At the outset, Sushil Kumar Lohani, Principal Secretary, Panchayati Raj & Drinking Water Department, GoO said, "More than 30% of villages have been declared as Open Defecation Free (ODF) Plus Odisha, (ODF plus village is a village which sustains its ODF status, ensures solid and liquid waste management and visually clean), our focus is on verification of ODF Plus status. We are focussing on Urban-Rural Convergence be-



tween Panchayati Raj and Drinking Water (PR&DW) and Housing and Urban Development (H&UD) departments to cater to the Gram Panchayats/Villages beyond a 20 km radius of Urban Faecal Sludge Treatment Plants (FSTPs) to meet their desludging requirements."

"The need of the hour is to adopt a multidimen-

sional approach for both toilet retrofitting means converting the existing single pit toilets into twin pit toilets and Faecal Sludge management (FSM) and I am delighted that Odisha is leading these innovative approaches in the country," he added. B Parmeswar, Director, Drinking Water Department, GoO said, "Construction of individual soak pits which has

been the norm under Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM-G) Odisha has also been taken up under the ongoing Sugam 3.0 campaign on a war footing. So far, Odisha has been successful in emerging as a top performing state in this campaign". He further said, "On the water front, the government provides safe and adequate drinking water to every household through the national flagship program. The tap water connection at the doorstep has a far-reaching socio-economic impact on rural livelihood systems."

The participants focused on the sustainability of the WASH service and emphasized systems

strengthening, developing tools and frameworks, and identifying locations for qualitative data collection and convergence of partners. Development partners like UNICEF, Water Aid, Water For People, SuSanA and IRC were present on this have shared a mission to develop strong and resilient local, state, and national water, sanitation, and hygiene systems. "Children and their families in poor and rural communities are most at risk of being left behind. Governments must invest in their communities if we are to bridge these economic and geographic divides and realise this important human right," said Shipra Saxena, WASH-CCES Specialist, UNICEF.

MoU between Mo College & Indian Psychiatric Society

Bhubaneswar, (TNB): On Friday an MoU has been signed between 'Mo College' and 'Indian Psychiatric Society (Odisha State Branch)' to create awareness about Psychological and mental health issues among students of various Government, Government-Aided Colleges & State-Run Universities. Shri Akash Dasnayak, Chairperson of 'Mo College', Dr. Amrit Pattojoshi (President) and Dr. Ashrumochan Sahoo (Secy.) were present during signing the MoU.

Rapidly increasing mental health issues including suicidal tendency of students is the major concern of society these days. Competitive and academic rat-race among young minds without being aware about its negative impacts the student has to bear the brunt throughout his/her life. 'India Psychiatric Society' is one of the oldest professional bodies with an aim to work for the improvement of mental health in society and to reduce the stigma and create awareness regarding mental health. Equipped with learned eminent psychiatrists with vast experience, it will be working major areas of deficit that



needs urgent attention like, increasing suicidality, stigma leading to gaps in treatment, reduced self-help skills, poor coping style, strained interpersonal relationships etc.

Throughout the training, students from various Colleges and Universities of Odisha will be trained to identify different mental health issues, stress management, create awareness, reduce stigma and also to identify warning signs of suicide as well as to build resilience and other supportive methods. During the event, Shri Dasnayak

said 'these days students are getting mentally pressurized due to several reasons. Let it be social media, online gambling, expectations of family and relatives as well as the peer pressure of establishing themselves well in society. When all this doesn't go accordingly, suicidal tendencies occur, so mental health awareness is need of the moment right now. On first phase, this awareness campaign will be held in 100 colleges'.

On the other hand, Shri Pattojoshi stated 'Human life is a gift of god. The main motive of this MoU is to empower youngsters and students as well as to create awareness over their mental health. It includes emotional, psychological, and social well-being.
