A horrific incident of honour killing came to light at Alamur village in Panyam mandal of Nandyal district on Saturday.

According to information, one Devender Reddy, who lost his wife was living with his two daughters at Alamur village.

Two years ago, he per-formed his eldest daughter Prasanna's marriage with a software engineer and a resident of Jillala village in Gospadu mandal in Nandyal district.

After marriage the couple is living in Hyderabad. Two months ago, Prasanna came to Alamur and was staying with her father and sister. Despite Devender making efforts to send her back to her husband, Prasanna was disinterested. Then Devender began to suspect the behaviour of Prasanna.

However, he came to know that Prasanna was in an affair with a person of another caste that's why she did not want to join her husband in Hyderabad.

Unable to digest Prasanna's affair with another caste person, Devender on February 10 strangulated her to death.

Taking the help of his friends, he took the body of Prasanna in a car and dumped it in Giddalur forest area.
