

UN demands release of jailed activist Fattah

GENEVA: UN rights chief Volker Turk called Tuesday on Egypt to immediately release Alaa Abdel Fattah, a jailed political dissident who has been refusing food and is now refusing water too. British-Egyptian Abdel Fattah, 40, was a major figure in the 2011 revolt that toppled longtime president Hosni Mubarak. After a seven-month hunger strike during which he consumed only "100 calories a day", he has for the past week refused food altogether, and on Sunday he stopped drinking water to coincide with the opening of the COP27 climate summit in Egypt.

EU on Pegasus tapping, rues panel

Committee complains that EC & govts are practicing code of silence on surveillance scandal

BRUSSELS: The European Parliament's inquiry committee investigating the use of surveillance spyware by the bloc's governments said on Tuesday the EU's executive arm and member countries are failing to properly tackle a surveillance scandal that has targeted opposition politicians and journalists. In a draft report published on Tuesday, the committee investigating Pegasus said the European Council and national governments "are practicing omerta"—or a code of silence—and regretted that the European Commission only shared "reluctantly and piecemeal" information concerning spyware

attacks on its own employees. A spokesman for the Commission responded that any attempt from national security services to illegally access data of citizens "is unacceptable" and insisted it has already started taking action to protect journalists from the use of spyware. The Parliament committee has been investigating the use by governments of Israel's Pegasus spyware and other invasive surveillance tools, viewing such technology as a threat to democracy in the 27-nation bloc. Pegasus was developed by Israel's NSO Group and is designed to breach mobile phones and extract vast amounts of information from them, including text messages, passwords, locations and microphone and camera recordings. The company markets the technology as a tool to target criminals, but many cases have been discovered worldwide of governments using it against dissidents, journalists and political opponents. According to EU lawmakers, the NSO Group has sold its products in at least 14 EU countries. "In at least four member states, Poland, Hungary, Greece, and



Spain, there has been illegitimate use of spyware, and there are suspicions about its use in Cyprus," they said, adding that Cyprus and Bulgaria serve as the export hub for spyware. "Member State governments have largely declined the invitation to cooperate with the PEGA committee," lawmakers said. "Some governments downright refused to cooperate, others were friendly and polite but did not really share meaningful information. Even a simple questionnaire sent to all member states about the details of their national legal framework for the use of spyware, has hardly received any substantial answers." The committee also deplored that Europol, EU's crime agency, did not start an investigation.

German U-turn on selling chip unit to China?

BERLIN: The German economy ministry has recommended that the sale of a chip factory to a Chinese-owned firm should be blocked as it poses a security threat, government sources said Tuesday. Sweden's Silex, a unit of Chinese company Sai MicroElectronics, had been seeking to take over Dortmund-based Elmos. But economy ministry sources said the acquisition would "constitute a threat to public order and... security." "The ministry has therefore suggested that the federal cabinet prohibits the acquisition of Elmos," they said. The ministry is headed by Robert Habeck from the Greens, one of three parties in Germany's ruling coalition.

\$3.4 bn bitcoin seized by the US

NEW YORK: The US government announced Monday it had seized \$3.4 billion in bitcoin from a real estate developer who stole the cryptocurrency from the dark web marketplace Silk Road a decade ago. James Zhong, 32, pleaded guilty Friday to committing wire fraud in September 2012 ago when he unlawfully obtained more than 50,000 bitcoin, according to federal prosecutors in New York. Agents recovered the digital money when they raided Zhong's house in Gainesville, Georgia, in November last year, the Southern District of New York said. They found the bitcoin on devices hidden in an underground floor safe and on a single-board computer that was concealed under blankets in a popcorn tin stored in a bathroom closet. Prosecutors say Zhong defrauded Silk Road by triggering quick transactions from roughly nine anonymous accounts that tricked the site's withdrawal-processing system into depositing the bitcoin into his accounts. He faces up to 20 years in prison.

REWRITING HISTORY

Exceptional haul of ancient bronzes unearths a new chapter

ROME: Italian authorities on Tuesday announced the extraordinary discovery of more than 2,000-year-old bronze statues in an ancient Tuscan thermal spring and said the find will "rewrite history" about the transition from the Etruscan civilization to the Roman Empire. The discovery, in the San Casciano dei Bagni archaeological dig near Siena, is one of the most significant ever in the Mediterranean and certainly the most important since the 1972 underwater discovery of the famed Riace bronze warriors, said Massimo Osanna, the Culture Ministry's director of museums. Thanks to the mud that protected them, the figurines were found in a perfect state of conservation. Alongside the figures were 5,000 coins in gold, silver and bronze, the ministry said. As evidence of the importance of the find, the ministry announced the construction of a new museum in the area to house the antiquities. Jacopo Tabolli, who coordinated the dig for the University for Foreigners in Siena, said the discovery was significant because it sheds new light on the end of the Etruscan civilization and the expansion of the Roman Empire between the 2nd and 1st

centuries BC. The period was marked by wars and conflicts across what is today's Tuscany, Umbria and Lazio regions, and yet, the bronze statues show evidence that Etruscan and Roman families prayed together to deities in the sacred sanctuary of the thermal springs. The statues bear both Etruscan and Latin inscriptions. "While there were social and civil wars being fought outside the sanctuary ... inside the sanctuary the great elite Etruscan and Roman families prayed together in a context of peace surrounded by conflict," Tabolli said. The find represents the largest deposit of bronzes from this era in Italy, notable also because most surviving antiquities from the period are primarily in terracotta, the ministry said in a statement. "It's a discovery that will rewrite history," Tabolli said.
