Faulty package delivery by app-based transport services causing hardships to customers

APP-BASED auto and cab services which undertake package delivery service for the benefit of people seem to be causing hardship to customers while handing over packs at their doorstep.

Customers allege that they are not receiving parcels on time. In the absence of customer care services they are finding it difficult to lodge complaints. They demanded a grievance redress system to address their issues.

A customer, Suresh Rao, who often uses package delivery service said, "this type of service was introduced for making people's life easy. But we are facing problems, as recently I ordered a package from Uber but I have not received it on time. There is no customer care number or email ID where I could address my grievances. As per

norms, the service should have a grievance redress email ID; only there is a single email ID that is for everything. They should be a proper platform where a customer can lodge a complaint; there should be

an instant response. It will be better if the State government takes stern action against the violators." Said Sai Teja, another often user, "when this service was introduced for making our life easy, it should have provided a source where we

could express our problem. But unfortunately this app-based service does not have this facility. Recently I received a damaged item. When I called the driver he did not respond.

As per law, the State government should take stern action against the online app. If it does not following the law it should be banned. As customers will be losers, the government should enforce strong rules and regulation; it should post someone to monitor the situation," he said.

Anil Reddy, a customer said: "Recently when I ordered a parcel from Uber I have not received it on the delivery date. When I called the driver, he said that I was not home. So I asked him to return my parcel, but I am yet to receive it. Apart from the driver's contact number, there is no other option where we can address our issue. It will be better if all services provide a customer care number".

FEW SPELLS OF RAIN OR THUNDERSHOWERS FORECAST

The IMD has forecast generally cloudy sky with a few spells of rain or thundershowers in the city from October 15 to 18. The IMD bulletin said on Friday that on October 19 and 20 there is possibility of rain or thundershowers, as the sky will be cloudy.

In a yellow warning to Telangana, the IMD said there will be heavy rain in Ranga Reddy, Hyderabad, Medchal-Malkajgiri, Vikarabad, Sangareddy, Medak and 12 other districts. The forecast stated that thundershowers with lightning are very likely at isolated places in all districts on October 15 and at a few places the next day. The forecast for October 16, 17 and 18 said light to moderate rain or thundershowers are very likely at a few places in the State.

Three murdered in city

A 78-year-old man and his son were hacked to death by unidentified persons at Uppal early on Friday. According to eye-witnesses, Narasimha (78) and his son Srinivas (35) were attacked with an axe by some assailants around 5.30 am.

They said the suspects targeted Narasimha; when Srinivas rushed to protect his father, he too was attacked. The lo-

cal police rushed to the spot and took up investigation.

In another case of murder, a man, identified as Baqiyar Qureshi alias Asaad Shooter, was stabbed to death by a group of persons at Bhavaninagar in old city on Tuesday night.

Qureshi of Rein Bazaar had come to meet some persons behind Anmol Hotel at Edi Bazaar when they attacked him with sharp weapons. He died on the spot due to severe bleeding, the local police said.
