

'Tedious adoption rules lead to sale of infants'

THE PROCESS for adopting children should be made easier to check child trafficking, senior advocate and amicus curiae P Sri Raghuram submitted before the High Court of Andhra Pradesh on Tuesday.



Raghuram, appointed as amicus curiae to assist the court in a case related to the sale of infants and human trafficking, also noted the cumbersome adoption procedure in the country. Childless couples, wishing to adopt, have been seeking alternatives to avoid the tedious process. Some parents were also selling their biological children due to their financial condition, and

awareness should be created against such practices, he said. The amicus curiae also opined that child trafficking could be prevented if the police acted swiftly on any complaint related to missing of child. The high court has taken suo motu cognisance of two separate media on child trafficking as public interest litigations. When the PILs came up for hearing on Tuesday, the amicus curiae opined that ASHA and anganwadi workers should track the expectant mother right from her pregnancy to deliver better results. Raghuram sought more time to seek the views of stakeholders and NGOs concerned to get more details on sale of infants and human trafficking.

SURVEY ON ENCRoACHMENT OF LAKES, RIVER

Vijayawada: The State government Tuesday informed the High Court that it will take up a survey on encroachment of lakes, rivers and other water bodies in the State. The court had earlier taken suo motu cognisance of encroachment of lakes and taking up constructions on them. When the suo motu PIL along with other similar petitions came for hearing, advocate general S Sriman informed that the government is conducting a survey and sought time. The court posted the matter for hearing on September 14.

The State registered 11.3 per cent GDP against the national average of 8.3 percent, he pointed out. On infrastructure development, he said the government is constructing four more ports in addition to the existing six. Besides new ports, nine fishing harbours are also being constructed. The chief minister said exports from the State stood at \$19.3 billion, accounting for 4.8 per cent of the country's total exports. Once new ports are ready, exports from AP will go up to 10 per cent.

Referring to the legislation mandating companies to offer 75 per cent jobs to local youth, Jagan expressed that there should be a healthy industrial atmosphere and small issues should be solved through negotiations. This gesture will infuse confidence in entrepreneurs who

will come forward to invest in the State, he said. Jagan further pointed out that Andhra Pradesh is the only State with three industrial corridors.

Consul General of Japan Masayuki Taga said there are two Japanese firms in Visakhapatnam and the tyre plant is the third one. "Success of the three industries will attract more investments and entrepreneurs to Vizag," he noted. The CM performed the ground breaking ceremony or commissioned eight other industries, including Pidlite Industries, Megha Fruit Processing Unit, Inox Air Products Private Limited, Optimus Drugs Private Limited, and WinWin Speciality Insulators Limited.

Govt forms AP Dharmika Parishad

Panel has power to take steps to prevent corruption in temples & replace corrupt abbots

THE State government has issued an order establishing the Andhra Pradesh Dharmika Parishad with 21 members.

Speaking to the media at the Interim Government Complex, Velagapudi, on Tuesday, Deputy Chief Minister and Endowments Minister Kottu Satyanarayana said that the Endowments Minister will be the chairman and Endowments Commissioner will be member-secretary for the Dharmika Parishad. Principal Secretary (Revenue) and 18 others will be its members. The Dharmika Parishad has special powers. The State government is empowered to form Trust Boards for temples with an income less than ₹25 lakh and above ₹1 crore. However, Trust boards for temples with income ranging between ₹25 lakh and ₹1 crore will be set up by the Dharmika Parishad. The Dharmika Parishad has the power to prevent corruption and irregularities in the temples and take action against the abbot who commit corruption and irregularities and appoint someone else in their place. Similarly, it also

has power to extend the lease of the lands and properties of the endowments department beyond 11 years, the minister said.

CGF panel

Satyanarayana further said that the state government has issued GO.572 on Tuesday, including three more members in the (Common Good Fund) Committee. Endowments Minister served as its chairman, Endowments Commissioner is secretary and treasurer, Principal Secretary (Revenue) and Tirumala Tirupati Dev-

asthanam (TTD) executive officer are the members.

The government has appointed Kaliki Kodanda Ramreddy from Nellore district, Malireddy Venkata Apparao from Visakhapatnam, G Yandada and Karri Bhaskara Rao from Tadepalligudem of West Godavari district as members of the committee. The committee is working to take steps for the development of temples under the jurisdiction of CGF committee and bring many temples under Dhupa Deepa Naivedya scheme.

Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy had directed officials to implement Dhupa Deepa Naivedya scheme without restriction to the eligible temples. Steps are being taken to bring at least one temple in every village under the scheme. As many as 1,500 temples in the State are covered under the scheme and another 3,500 applications have been received. The officials have examined 2,346 applications and 2,200 were found to be eligible.

Pending cases

Satyanarayana said that around 4,708 cases were pending in the Endowment Tribu-

nal for a long time and 722 cases have been resolved so far. The local conditions were not conducive to solve the remaining cases and loopholes in the law were also an obstacle. It has been decided to urge the High Court to allocate the necessary 8 Amins to resolve all the cases. If these eight more Amins are appointed by the High Court, all the cases will be resolved soon. Similarly, he said.

Online services

The Deputy Chief Minister said that steps are being taken to provide all kinds of services online in all the major temples of the State, on the lines of TTD. It has already been implemented in Srisailem temple and steps are being taken to implement the system in all major temples. Recently, the chief minister has directed that all the temples under the department should use only organic agricultural products for preparing prasadam. Already, the TTD has started following the orders and steps are being taken to implement the same policy in other temples. Organic agricultural produce will be procured through AP Markfed.



Second warning withdrawn at Dowleswaram

WITH the heavy rains in the upper catchment area, the flood level at Bhadrachalam is rising again. The authorities withdrew the second flood warning at Dowleswaram Cotton barrage on Tuesday.

According to the flood conservator, the second warning was withdrawn on Tuesday morning with the flood level at Dowleswaram barrage coming down to 13.10 feet. However, since Tuesday morning, due to heavy rains in the upper catchment area, the flood level again slowly went up and touched 15.90 feet. The flood water discharge was recorded at Bhadrachalam as 13.70 lakh cusecs and 12.60 lakh cusecs at Dowleswaram barrage.

It is expected that the flood levels at the barrage may increase by Wednesday night.
