# 'Reconsider restrictions on market borrowing'

Balagopal hands over memorandum to Nirmala seeking expansion of Net Borrowing Ceiling by 1% of the SGDP

FINANCE Minister K N Balagopal has asked the Union government to reconsider the new restrictions on Open Market Borrowing (OMB). On Monday, he met Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and handed over a memorandum seeking relaxations and to expand Net Borrowing Ceiling by at least 1% of the SGDP.

Kerala is facing a crisis after the Union government decided to fix the ceiling for OMB after adjusting the off-budget borrowings (OBBS). Thus, an amount of ₹14,312.80 crore,

Fund Board (KIIFB) and the Kerala Social Security Pension Limited (KSSPL). Thus, an amount of ₹14,312.80 crore,

OBBS availed of by both the entities, will be deducted from the OMB space in four annual instalments starting 2022-23.

Balagopal has now asked the union minister to consider the net borrowings by the KSSPL and KIIFB, not gross borrowing, to determine the OBBS. If so, the estimated cut of ₹14,312.80 crore would come down to ₹7,813.06.

"The state's request to consider the borrowings of KSSPL and KIIFB as contingent liability is pending with the Union Ministry of Finance. A net borrowing formula may be considered until a final decision is taken," he said in the memorandum.

He also pointed out that the unutilised portion of OMB lim-

it amounting to ₹1,619 crore during the last FY has also not been added to the quota for the present FY.

The Union Department of Expenditure had given in principle approval for taking an additional borrowing of ₹4,060 crore in the current year for achieving the reforms target in the power sector.

But, Balagopal said, the GoI is yet to grant sanction for the additional borrowing. He also asked the union minister to transfer ₹1,548 crore due to the state as GST compensation.

# Letter row: CB to submit report to DGP today, likely to recommend detailed probe

THE crime branch will submit its preliminary report in the letter row involving Mayor Arya Rajendran to state police chief Anil Kant on Tuesday. The team is likely to recommend a detailed investigation after registering a case as the controversial letter has not yet been recovered.

Since the Mayor reiterated that the letter is forged, an FIR needs to be registered to conduct a detailed probe, crime branch sources said. The officers also said that they could not conclude that the letter is forged as it is yet to be traced.

Both the crime branch and the vigilance received only the screenshot of the letter and also recorded the statement of two corporation employees - Vinod and Girish - at the mayor's office.

In his statement before the crime branch and the vigilance, works standing committee chairman D R Anil admitted that he prepared a letter to be sent to the CPM district secretary Anavoor Nagappan seeking Kudumbashree workers for appointment as daily wage labourers at the SAT Hospital. He also told the sleuths that he destroyed the letter. Anil, however, maintained that he was not aware of the controversial letter, purportedly written by the mayor to the CPM district secretary.

Vigilance officials said they will conduct an inspection at the corporation office in the coming days as complaints regarding backdoor appointments are prevalent.

Meanwhile, the protests by

the BJP and the UDF councillors continue at the corporation office demanding the resignation of the mayor. Curiously, BJP councillors protested on the terrace of the corporation office raising slogans demanding the dismissal of the governing council and later took out a march to the mayor's office. Hindu Aikya Vedi activists also gathered to express solidarity with the protesting BJP councillors. However, they were taken into custody by the police.

UDF activists also took out a march towards the corporation office and tried to barge into the premises by pushing the front gate and jumping over the fence. However, the police locked the gate and had a minor scuffle with the protesters. Later, some of the workers threw a chair at the police, leading to a heated argument.

## Defamatory remarks: Mayor initiates legal action against Jebi Mather

T Puram: Mayor Arya Rajendran has initiated legal action against Rajya Sabha member and Mahila Congress state president Jebi Mather for allegedly making defamatory remarks against her during a Mahila Morcha protest march on the corporation office premises last week. Mayor's counsel Murukumpuzha R Vijayakumar Nair has sent a legal notice to Mather. As per the notice, Mather should give a written apology as well as apologise in front of the media within seven days. Failure to do so, legal action will be taken against Mather, the notice said. Meanwhile, Mather told mediapersons that she did not defame the mayor and only called her "mayorutti" (mayor kid) affectionately. "It is not a defamatory remark. However, I will give a reply to the notice and respond to the media once again," she said. The mayor had earlier stated that she would take legal action against the anti-women remarks made by the Congress MPs. During the Mahila Congress protest, Mather came with a dummy suitcase with a poster saying "Mayorutti, Go to Kozhikode with the stolen money". Mather had also said that her husband's house is safe for the mayor and will continue the protest until she resigns.

# Legends join to set up football academy, to launch club later

LEGENDS of Kerala football have joined hands to set up a new academy, aiming to establish a professional club by the end of 2028. Novus Soccer Academy is led by former Indian captain U Sharaf Ali and IM Vijayan is appointed the technical advisor. Former Kerala team captain Victor Manjula is the training advisor while K T Chacko, Kurikesh Mathew, Jo Paul Ancheri, and Asif Saheer are part of the special observation panel.

The website of the academy was launched at a function held in Malappuram on Monday.

Chief coordinator Sharaf Ali said the academy will be launched in five phases. "We will coach children in the 6-16 age group. In the first phase, Non-Residential Novus Academy and E-Novus Academy will be launched. The Non-Residential Academy will be run in association with the schools in the state. The schools will need to give access to their grounds to associate with the academy. All other support, including syllabus and modern equipment for football training, will be provided by the academy. The students who perform well will get scholarships and chances to play for professional clubs," Sharaf Ali said.

The E-Novus Academy provides online coaching to students across the state. In the second phase, a residential academy will be set up at Areekode.

"The residential academy will have a FIFA-standard turf and other high-class facilities, including a gymnasium and a sports hostel," he said. The football legends plan to establish a professional football club under the academy. "In the third phase, the academy will set up a sports complex with a basketball court, volleyball court, badminton court, and a swimming pool. In the fourth phase, special training programmes for coaches and referees will be launched. In the fifth phase, a professional football club will be formed under the academy. The goal will be achieved by 2028," he said.

# Court allows Maoist leader to pursue higher studies

THE Special Court of Trial of NIA Cases on Monday passed a favourable verdict on a petition filed by Maoist leader B G Krishnamurthy alias BGK seeking permission to join an online course.

Despite being in jail for the past one year, his zest to pursue education never died. The court has now allowed him to study Post Graduate diploma in criminal justice conducted by the Indira Gandhi National Open University as requested. In his petition, Krishnamurthy had submitted that he was an LLB graduate and was eligible to join the PG course. He also said he was ready to pay the course fee of Rs.11,000.

Judge for NIA Cases Anil K Bhasker directed the welfare officer of Vyyur high-security prison, where Krishnamurthy is incarcerated, to make all necessary arrangements to facilitate the petitioner to pursue his studies by ensuring the availability of study materials at regular intervals and to appear for examinations.
