On Wednesday, they held a campaign in Punnamma Thota of 19th Division in Vijayawada. The District Collector said that the programme's aim was to know the people's problems and solve them at their doorstep. He said that they allocated Jagananna houses to about 35 families who live on the banks of the Bandar canal at Godavarru and another six families whose applications were delayed would also get houses in the second phase.

The collector promised Muslims to construct Shadi Khana at R&B vacant land near YV Rao Hospital with the permission of the government. Rao promised to an old couple A Ramulu and Parvathi to sanction a house in the Jagananna Colony and to undertake cataract surgery for them.

Avinash said that in his constituency every eligible person would be benefited. He also said that they will construct a Dobbikhana at a cost of Rs 9.75 lakh. Deputy Mayor Bellam Durga and others participated.

A review meeting was conducted on Wednesday on drinking water, sanitation and electricity supply in R&R colonies with Tahsildars, the MPDO, Village Secretariat engineering assistants, and Rural Irrigation department engineers in the ITDA meeting hall here.

Sub-Collector Katta Simhachalam attended the review meeting. Pravin said that applications related to problems in R&R colonies of the Polavaram project can be sent to www.polavaramrr.ap.gov.in. He mentioned that applications can be submitted through village secretariats in the app.

Similarly, in case of minor problems in R&R Colony, he also directed the officials concerned to register such issues online. He also directed the officials to submit the

list of those living in R&R Colony. He said that the funds received by the panchayats in the flood areas for the Polavaram project should be spent on R&R colonies. In every R&R colony, the infrastructure should be established by the respective village secretariat. He asked the officials to create awareness among the residents of R&R Colony to submit applications online. Tahsildars, Srimannarayana and Veerabhadra Rao and MPDO Ratna Kumari were present.

MACHILIPATNAM Member of Parliament Vallabani Balasoury appealed to Union Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari to develop several roads in Machilipatnam Parliamentary constituency mainly connecting roads of the Bandar Port under the Sagar Mala Scheme.

He met the Union Minister in Delhi on Wednesday and asked to undertake development works of the roads with a cost of Rs 925 crore. The Union Minister was informed that AP Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy would lay a foundation stone for Machilipatnam port construction very soon. If the port completes, about 20,000 people would get jobs directly and indirectly, the MP claimed. The MP was asked to widen Manginapudi beach road into four-lane and requested him to construct a green field road to connect the port by connecting NH-16. He also appealed to minister to construct a four-lane greenfield road towards north side of the port by connecting NH-46.

The MP also met Central Minister Kishna Reddy at Delhi requesting him to develop Manginapudi beach of Machilipatnam under the Swadesh Darshan scheme. He also insisted on sprucing up the Hamsala Deevi as a tourist destination.

RESERVE BANK OF INDIA (RBI) encourages cardholders to tokenise their cards

To protect the interests of cardholders, RBI has mandated that with effect from October 1, 2022, entities other than card networks and card issuers cannot store card data, such as card number, expiry date, etc. (Card-on-File or CoF). At the same time, to ensure that cardholders are not inconvenienced, RBI introduced CoF Tokenisation. Tokenisation is done so that the cardholder continues to enjoy the convenience of not entering card details for every transaction; at the same time the merchant does not store or use the card details which prevents potential loss of card details and associated misuse. Use of tokens augments safety and convenience of card transactions and is in the interest of cardholders.

What is Tokenisation or Card-on-File (CoF) Tokenisation?

1. Tokenisation (or CoF Tokenisation) can be done at any time of convenience.
2. Tokenisation is the process of replacing the debit or credit card details with a unique alternate code called a "token".
3. Tokenisation is prescribed only for online / e-commerce transactions, and not for face-to-face or Point of Sale (PoS) transactions.
4. Tokenisation needs to be done only once for each card and at each online / e-commerce merchant. Each token is unique to a particular card and a particular online / e-commerce merchant. Cardholder can tokenise a card at any number of online / e-commerce merchants.
5. A token cannot be used for payment to any merchant other than the merchant for whom it is created.
6. Once the token is created, cardholder need not enter or remember token details for undertaking transactions in future. For identifying the tokenised card, the last four digits of the card will be displayed during the checkout process.
7. Cardholders shall also have an option to de-register their tokens, at their own choice.

How to Tokenise a Card?

1. To opt for tokenisation, cardholder has to do a one-time registration at the merchant website / application.
2. To register, cardholder has to enter card details and provide consent. The card issuer will validate the consent through an Additional Factor of Authentication like an OTP.

Cardholders are encouraged to tokenise their cards to have a safe, secure, seamless and convenient experience.
