## FSOs seize 225 kg mawa made with refined oil & powder milk

Sweets shops and dairies inspected in Betma

A team of food safety officers (FSOs) raided a sweets shop in Betma and seized over 225 kilogram of mawa on suspicion that it was adulterated. The officials have also collected samples of mawa

barfi and ghee from the shop and sent them for testing to the state laboratory in Bhopal. On the direction of the district administration, a team of FSOs Himali Sonpatki, Amlemu PV and PL Dodiya raided Jain Mishthan Bhandar and Namkeen on Wednesday and collected samples.

"During the inspection, the shop owner was found making mawa from refined oil and powder milk. He admitted not using mawa to prepare the sweets after

which we collected samples and seized the mawa," Sonpatki said. She added that action would be initiated against the shop owner after they received the report.

Meanwhile, the officials have also collected samples of milk cake from Guru Dairy and samples of packaged drinking water from Shri Ram Sweets-both in Betma.

The FSOs said a complaint against the manufacturers was also received through the CM helpline.

# HARASSED BY CREDITORS...

## WOMAN INTERIOR DESIGNER LINKED TO CHIT FUND HANGS HERSELF AT HOME

An interior designer committed suicide on Tuesday evening in an apartment to which she had shifted a day earlier. She left a seven-page note behind expressing that she was in debt and creditors were harassing her. The entire suicide incident was recorded on CCTV. Her husband saw it while sitting in Bhilai and sent the neighbours to her rescue. But she could not be saved.

Lasudiya police station-in-charge Santosh Dudhi said woman interior designer Karuna Sharma hanged herself and committed suicide. She was alone in the flat. The

woman's husband and a daughter were in Bhilai. When the husband called from Bhilai, the woman did not answer the call. After several attempts at contacting her had failed, the husband checked the CCTV of the house which was linked to his phone and saw his wife hanging from a noose. He immediately called the neighbours to rescue her. But the woman had died by the time the people reached there. The body of the woman has been sent to MY Hospital for a

post-mortem examination.

The woman left a seven-page suicide note in which many people's names were mentioned. TI Dudhi said Karuna had shifted to this house a day before her suicide. The woman's husband has accused Hemant Atrawal, Pramila Atrawal, Mona Sharma, Aditya Agrawal and others of harassing her.

Her husband said that Karuna was associated with a chit fund which had been running since 2017. Other women, including Mona

Sharma, joined the group through her. Some members joined it by giving Rs 20,000 per month and some by giving Rs 10,000 per month. People also joined by paying Rs 50,000 and Rs 1 lakh.

Pramila Atrawal collects payments for the chit fund and manages cash. But she stopped paying money to the chit fund investors since Diwali last year. From January this year, Pramila's husband, Hemant, started threatening the people connected through Karuna and refused

to return their money. He said, "People regularly call up Karuna asking her to return their money, but we didn't have any money to return. We did not refuse to give their money back, but we could do so only if we had the money. I can't say how much money they've given so far." Karuna's husband alleged that, three months ago, Aditya Agrawal had come to their home and vandalised household items, besides threatening them. After this incident, Karuna sent off

her husband and their eight-year-old daughter to Bhilai.

According to TI Dudhi, a case was registered against Aditya Agrawal and his partner on the complaint of Karuna three months ago. In August, Karuna complained to the police that Aditya had come to her house at night and assaulted her over money matters.

## Civil surgeon issues advisory for anaemia prevention

Civil surgeon of district hospital Dr Vinod Gupta issued advisory for the early diagnosis and prevention of the anaemia on Wednesday.

Shedding light on the disease, Dr Gupta stated that the anaemia caused due to lack of blood in the body should be immediately diagnosed. A delay could lead to fatal consequences.

The disease hampers physical development and causes other major diseases too. He added that the condition worsens in case of pregnant women, who

are at a risk of even losing their lives, if suffering from the disease. He advised to get blood levels checked regularly and seek treatment.

Dr Gupta highlighted measures to be taken in case of pregnant women suffering from anaemia. He said that pregnant women suffering from anaemia should consume meals on time, which must necessarily contain fruits, green vegetables, lentils and other nutritious edibles.

According to Dr Gupta, free-of-cost check-up for anaemia are available at all government health centres.
