

# Modi insulted sacrifices of people for TS, says Harish Rao

- Recalls PM's comment on formation of Telangana State in 2014 that the mother died but the child survived
- Harish holds Prime Minister responsible for the misery of migrant workers during the Covid lockdown in first wave

MINISTER for Finance and Health T Harish Rao held Prime Minister Narendra Modi responsible for the untold misery of the migrant workers who were stranded at their workplaces after the sudden enforcement of lockdown during the first wave of the coronavirus pandemic.

Addressing a press conference here on Thursday, Harish Rao said that Modi who didn't give time for the migrant workers to move to their native places is now blaming the local governments, accusing them of aggravating the Covid-19 pandemic by arranging their return journey to their homes.

"Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrababhan Rao not only ensured food essentials and cash to the migrant workers but also engaged special trains to send them off to their native places. Instead of recognising these services, Modi says that it led to the spread of coronavirus," Harish Rao said.

He said that Modi's utterances didn't stop here; he went on to comment on Telangana formation, thus insulting

decades of spirited struggle and sacrifices of the people. It's not the first time Modi insulted Telangana people, he said, recalling the words of Modi on the formation of Telangana during general elections in 2014, that the mother had died but the child survived.

"Notwithstanding the obligation to fulfill the assurances given to Telangana under the AP Reorganisation Act-2014, the BJP-led Central government failed to establish Railway coach factory, steel plant etc. Moreover, the Centre merged seven mandals of Khammam district, including the Sileru Project, with Andhra Pradesh. The Centre has always shown empty hands to Telangana in the budget. Despite this, Telangana made strides in welfare and developmental programmes," Harish Rao said.

Telangana got nothing even though the Centre had sanctioned 157 med-

ical colleges. Despite repeated requests, the Centre also didn't give a single Navodaya School or IIM or IIT, Harish Rao said, daring BJP State leaders to explain about the Centre's ignorance.

Seven of the 10 villages in Telangana topped the Adarsh Villages under the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY), Union Ministry of Rural Development. This apart, the State received several awards at the national level, he said. Telangana stood third in the country, whereas BJP-ruled Uttar Pradesh languished last in health-care, according to NITI Aayog, Harish Rao said. Referring to the developmental activity, Harish Rao said that Warangal will soon become a health hub. The Chief Minister had already laid the foundation for a multi-specialty hospital with an estimated cost of Rs 1,100 crore.

The State government has already established 20 T-Diagnostic Centres which cater 57 types of laboratory tests. Plans are afoot to set up labs in other 13 districts with an outlay of Rs 3.5 crore, he added. The government will soon upgrade Mulugu (200 beds), Bhupalpally (300 beds), Mahbubabad (200 beds) and Narsampet (200 beds) hospitals. The State will soon have eight medical colleges and four TIMS hospitals, he added.

Earlier, Harish Rao inaugurated a mother milk bank, TB specialty clinic, blood storage unit and 42-bed paediatric care unit in the MGM Hospital.

## ‘Agonising to see BJP leaders supporting Modi’s remark’

IT’S agonising to see the BJP State leaders supporting the Prime Minister Narendra Modi despite the latter’s utterances against the formation of Telangana, Minister for Panchayat Raj and Rural Development Errabelli Dayakar Rao said.

Speaking to media persons here on Thursday, he predicted that people in large numbers are expected to attend the pub-

lic meeting addressed by Chief Minister K Chandrababhan Rao in Jangaon on Friday, especially against the backdrop of Modi’s denigrating remarks on the bifurcation of erstwhile Andhra Pradesh. “It appears like that Modi is not aware of Telangana history, and it’s even worse that BJP leaders were rallying around him like illiterates,” Errabelli said.

Referring to KCR’s visit, he said that the CM will inaugurate the Integrated Collectorate Complex, TRS party office before addressing a public meeting. “With Jangaon district has been witnessing all round development, the locals in large numbers are expected to attend the public meeting. Jangaon, once a parched district, is now experiencing abundant water resources due to Mission Bhagirathi, Devadula Project etc,” Errabelli said. He predicted that

at least 1.30 lakh people, especially farmers and pension beneficiaries, are expected to turn up at the public meeting.

Minister for Tribal Welfare Satyavathi Rathod said that credit goes to KCR for turning Jangaon district into an agricultural hub. She criticised Narendra Modi for spitting venom on Telangana time and again. “Modi is scared of KCR as the latter would lead an anti-BJP campaign in the country,” Rathod said.

Earlier, the ministers reviewed the arrangements for the Chief Minister’s visit. MLC Pochampally Srinivas Reddy, MLA Muthireddy Yadagiri Reddy, Telangana Vikalanga Co-operative Corporation Chairman K Vasudeva Reddy and TSIC chairman Gyadari Balamallu were among others present.

## Vinod Kumar slams Bandi for deriding CM

## Tight security for Maha Shivaratri Jatara

TIGHT security arrangements were being made for the Maha Shivaratri Jatara at Vemulawada Rajanna Temple to be held from Feb 28 to March 2, informed Additional SP Chandraiah.

Although the police had intervened, party activists of both the parties reportedly sustained injuries. Meanwhile, BJP cadres staged a silent protest at Ambedkar Junction in Jangaon, demanding the suspension of police officials who supported the ruling TRS during Wednesday’s clash. The police dispersed the BJP activists besides arresting some of them, it’s learnt.

The agreement with NIMS will help all such patients. OGH has the equipment, staff and other necessary items to conduct common tests like X-rays, CT scans, blood tests and urine tests. But it does not have facilities for conducting major tests. Though the State government had recently provided some new equipment to the hospital it does not include equipment or facilities for conducting major tests. Since the pressure on the NIMS diagnostics would increase, it is learnt that NIMS has decided to hire the services of more medical staff and lab technicians so that the referral patients’ needs can be taken care of.

## Bhadrachal bandh total, peaceful

SEEKING takeover of the five panchayats which were alienated from Bhadrachalam and merged with Andhra Pradesh, all political parties observed the town bandh on Thursday. All business establishments such as cinema halls, hotels and schools voluntarily downed shutters as part of making the bandh total, which passed off without any incident. All the RTC buses were confined to depots due to the bandh.

The protesters staged a dharna on the national highway. As a result, traffic came to a standstill

for over an hour. The police rushed to the spot and dispersed the activists and the leaders and ensured resumption of traffic. Due to the bandh, the devotees could not visit the Lord Ram temple. Addressing the programme, various party leaders strongly demanded that the Telangana government take back the five panchayats of Yetpaka, Purushothapatnam, Pichukulapadu, Kannayagudem and Gundala from AP. They said the people in the grampanchayats were keen to rejoin Telangana. Following the recent move of the AP government to reorganise districts, the panchayats concerned would be merged in the new Paderu district.

## No RT-PCR test; No quarantine

This option, however, is only available for passengers arriving from 72 countries whose vaccination programmes the Indian government recognises as part of a reciprocal programme.

These countries include Canada, Hong Kong, the United States, the United Kingdom, Bahrain, Qatar, Australia, New Zealand, and some European nations.

Airlines (will) allow boarding (of

only those passengers who have filled in all the information in the self-declaration form... and uploaded the negative RT-PCR test report or COVID-19 vaccination certificate... The Health ministry has said. Only asymptomatic passengers will be allowed to board, and Covid-appropriate behaviour, including the use of face masks and practicing of social distancing, must be followed during the flight. On arrival, in addition to thermal screening, passengers selected at random (up to

two per cent of total passengers per flight) will be asked to undergo RT-PCR tests.

Passengers will be selected by the airline and must “preferably” be from different countries. Passengers found to be symptomatic will be immediately quarantined and tested, with contact tracing carried out if they are found to be Covid-positive. All other passengers must self-monitor for 14 days for any Covid symptoms, the Health Ministry said.
