In the bowling department, Rohit had spoken about bringing Kuldeep Yadav slowly back into the scheme of things. With the series in the bag, India might field the wrist spinner in place of Chahal to maintain the balance of the batting order.

However, there might be very little change in the pace attack, possibly Deepak Chahar in place of Shardul Thakur, as Mohammed Siraj and Prasidh Krishna, the player of the match in second ODI, have been impressive and had very little game-time so far.

"We don't mind losing a few games trying out a few things. Because it is important to look at the long term goals. We will see what works out well for the team combination," Rohit had said on Wednesday. Going by the captain's words and from what we have seen so far in the series, there could be a lot more experimentation in the coming months until they figure their best possible team combinations.

Meanwhile, the team management will also have a decision to make as either of Suryakumar Yadav or Deepak Hooda will have to make way for Pant in the middle-order on Dha-

India seek positive start amidst uncertainty

THROUGH the course of 2021, India skipper Mithali Raj insisted on their top-order performing consistently, especially in the ODIs, for them to put up scores over 250 consistently. "If we have to visit the 2017 World Cup where the team did well and put on a score of 250-270 is because there's at least one top-order bat who played through the innings and the rest of them revolved around that batter," Mithali had said in their pre-departure press conference last month.

In the last 12 months, both Smriti Mandhana and Shafali Verma haven't been able to convert the starts they have got.

Verma has one fifty in six innings while Mandhana has two in eleven. Which is why, the five matches against New Zealand is crucial for India to get the openers back at their best before the World Cup begins.

However, with doubts over Mandhana's availability, who's in MIQ per New Zealand government rules, Mithali and Co. will have to make do with the available players. Given the team management's priority to have a left-right combination at the top, Bhatia could open with Verma, who hasn't been consistent herself, if Mandhana is not available as she did in the T20.

In hindsight, it might not be a bad thing to happen as Mith-



ali, who will be taking the place of Sabbineni Meghana, could be batting at three followed by Harmanpreet Kaur at four. Through 2021, the argument for India skipper to move up to No 3 couldn't materialise, largely due to unavailability of the injured Kaur. Mithali batting at three would mean that India

will have Deepti Sharma, Richa Ghosh and Pooja Vastrakar battling one position higher than they did last year, creating a space for an extra all-rounder in Sneha Rana.

In the bowling department, Poonam Yadav's deteriorating form is a concern. Jhulan Goswami is likely to take her place, but whether Meghana Singh or Renuka Singh Thakur could accompany her in Simrah Dil Bahadur's spot will depend on their availability. Either way, it is almost certain that India will play three seamers instead of two as they did in the lone T20.

Vesely confident Czech men's stocks will rise soon on court

A GLANCE at the ATP rankings will reveal that Czech Republic does not comprise a single player in the top 100. For a country which won the Davis Cup back-to-back in 2012 and 2013, that does not augur too well. Jiri Vesely, currently ranked at 123, is one of their best singles players from the country, six places below Tomas Machac.

In fact, the region has not been able to produce elite players like Radek Stepanek and Tomas Berdych after their retirement in 2017 and 2019 respectively. "There have always been periods in every country where you had top players — (Andre) Agassi and (Pete) Sampras — and last few years Americans didn't have top players in the top 30. Now they have (Taylor) Fritz, (Reilly) Opleka and these young guys coming up. Now, we also have talented players so I think we will find more Czechs in top 100, 50, 30..." said Vesely, who ended India's singles challenge at the Bengaluru Open, beating Prajnesh Gunneswaran 3-6, 6-2, 6-1.

Interestingly, the situation is completely different for Czech Republic when it comes to women's tennis. In the last ten editions of the Fed Cup, they emerged champions six times, showcasing their dominance. Such kind of results can only be achieved when there is great depth and quality. They have eight players in the top 100 with Barbora Krejickova and Karolina Pliskova ranked third and fourth, respectively, in the WTA rankings.

Krejickova also clinched the 2021 French Open. Petra Kvitova, ranked 23, has two Grand Slams. Full story: newindianexpress.com

City beat Brentford, Spurs lose

Pep Guardiola warned many hurdles still lie in the way of Manchester City and a fourth Premier League title in five years after sweeping aside Brentford 2-0. Tottenham's top four bid suffered a blow in a dramatic 3-2 defeat against Southampton.

City have dropped only two points in the league in 14 games stretching back to October. Guardiola's men were not at their scintillating best at the

Etihad, but still had far too much for a Brentford side that risk being dragged into a relegation battle. The Bees had held out bravely for 40 minutes until a mistimed tackle from Mads Roerslev brought down Raheem Sterling and Riyad Mahrez coolly slotted away the penalty.

Until that point City had been guilty of not taking their chances as Sterling fired over on the volley from Phil Foden's perfect cross and Aymeric Laporte side-footed inches wide from

Ruben Dias' knockdown.

The hosts never looked in danger of conceding as they registered a 14th clean sheet in 24 league games this season.

However, Guardiola's celebrations when the second goal finally arrived 20 minutes from time told the story of nerves beginning to build around the Etihad that their dominance was not showing on the scoreboard.
