PANIC AS UKRAINIANS WATCH WAR ARRIVE

At dawn, Ukrainians' uneasy efforts at normalcy were shattered As the day progressed alarm rose across Ukraine, forcing many to move to safer areas

KYIV THE missile fragment pierced the ceiling of Mikhail Shcherbakov's apartment in Kharkiv. In an instant, Ukrainians found that war, after weeks of warnings, had hit home.

"I heard noise and woke up. I realised it sounded like artillery," Shcherbakov said. He jumped from the couch and ran to wake his mother, and something exploded behind him.

Some panicked immediately. Others clung to routine, with irritation. "I'm not afraid. I'm

going to work. The only unusual thing is that you can't find a taxi," one resident complained, even as sirens wailed. Many seemed unsure of how to react.

In Mariupol, the Azov Sea port city that many fear will be the first major target because of its strategic importance, similar confused scenes of routine and fear played out. Some residents waited at bus stops,

seemingly on their way to work, while others rushed to leave the city that is only about 15km from the front line with the Donetsk People's Republic, one of two separatist-held areas recognised by Russian President Vladimir Putin as independent this week in a prelude to the invasion.

As the day progressed, alarm across Ukraine rose. People crowded grocery stores and ATMs, seeking supplies and cash. In Kharkiv, worried residents inspected fragments of

military equipment strewn across a children's playground.

Kyiv Mayor Vitaly Klitschko called on the city's 3 million people to stay indoors unless they worked in critical sectors and said everyone should prepare go-bags with necessities such as medicine and documents.

For weeks, President Volodymyr Zelensky had tried to moderate expectations of aggression by Russia, even as warnings by the US became more urgent. Zelensky argued that panic would lead to societal destabilisation that could be as much of a tactical advantage for Russia as the estimated 1,50,000 troops that had massed on Ukraine's borders.

On Thursday, as the president imposed martial law, Ukrainians realised with a jolt that everything might change. "I feel panic, scared and excited. I don't know who I should ask for help," said Kyiv resident Elizaveta Melnik. "We didn't believe this situation would come." AP

'UNPROVOKED AND UNJUSTIFIED' WORLD LEADERS REACT TO ATTACK ON UKRAINE



UNITED STATES

"The prayers of the entire world are with the people of Ukraine as they suffer an unprovoked and

unjustified attack by Russian military forces," President Joe Biden said on Thursday. He warned "Russia alone is responsible for the death and destruction this attack will bring."

EUROPEAN UNION

"In these dark hours, our thoughts are with Ukraine and the innocent women, men and children as they face this unprovoked attack and fear for their lives. We will hold the Kremlin accountable," European Union chiefs Ursula von der Leyen and Charles Michel said.

Paris: World leaders on Thursday condemned the Russian invasion of Ukraine, with Western capitals vowing to escalate sanctions against Moscow while the head of the United Nations demanded an immediate end to the conflict.

CHINA

Foreign Minister Wang Yi told his Russian counterpart Sergei Lavrov in a phone call that China understands "Russia's reasonable concerns on security issues," China's foreign ministry said.

ITALY

Prime Minister Mario Draghi called Russia's invasion "unjustified and unjustifiable." "Italy is close to the Ukrainian people and institutions in this dramatic moment," he stated.

UKRAINE

President Volodymyr Zelensky compared Russia's invasion of his country to Nazi Germany's military campaigns during World War II. "Russia has attacked Ukraine in a cowardly and suicidal way, like Nazi Germany did during World War II," Zelensky said in an online briefing.

CANADA

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau condemned Russia's "egregious" and "unprovoked" attack on Ukraine as "a clear further violation of Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity" and of Russia's obligations under international law.

First day of invasion 'successful': Russia Moscow: Russia said on Thursday that its military had achieved its goals set out for the first day of its invasion of Ukraine, after launching the attack despite warnings of sweeping Western sanctions.
