



Commonly used ingredients are dried herbs, activated charcoal, vinegar, garlic, caffeine and stinging nettle plants. The active ingredients from these substances are extracted in specific ways and processed into tablets, ointments, gels and drops.

Homeopaths say they aim to treat the whole person, taking into account personality, lifestyle and hereditary factors, as well as the history of the disease. One of the main guiding principles of homeopathy is that the treatments must be highly individualised. It depends on the person's specific



symptoms, medical and lifestyle history and lastly, body parameters. For instance, if two people are getting treatment for the same illness, they can receive totally different treatments from their homeopathic doctors because of their unique requirements and assessment of how their bodies are expected to respond. Since all people are unique, homeopathic medicines are prescribed to treat individuals. Homeopathy is effective for a wide range of ailments such as colds, flu, arthritis, allergies, and sprains to name just a few of the maladies for which there are homeopathic treatments. Homeopathy has effective, constitutional medicines for allergies. This means that a remedy is chosen considering the totality of the symptoms the person is experiencing. This requires the guidance

# Skill varsity's drone school to give training for rural, farming children



Ahmedabad : In an attempt to tap the demand for drones in agriculture sector, the newly established Kaushalya - The Skill University (KSU) has established its School of Drones where 20,000 children from rural background and from farming families would be enrolled and trained.

Looking at the scarcity of available trainers in drone aviation, flying schools, drone federations, drone start-ups and industries, "Nearly 20,000 children from rural background and wards of farmers will be given preference in admission. They will be trained over a period of five years. This is being done looking at the huge scope of drones in agriculture right from spraying of fertilisers of sowing," said Anju

Sharma, principal secretary, Department of Labour, Skill Development and Employment. KSU aims to establish the 'School of Drones' to provide a range of skill development programmes for encompassing the entire drone value-chain, from drone flying skills to assembly and maintenance, value added services such as data analysis, AI application among others. "The school of drones will also facilitate training of trainers, research, innovation, incubation and entrepreneurship to foster start-ups in drones and allied sectors. Already, Rs 20 crore has been allocated by the state for creating infrastructure and training manpower, of which a large part will go into a central laboratory at KSU," Sharma added. On "trainer entrepreneurs", officials said the university plans to train at least 100 persons with minimum knowledge of drones this year who can further train others, earning a remuneration per student.

"Due to fluctuating demand in this sector, fast technology updation and non-availability of drone experts, state government

decided not to hire these 100 trainers but create trainers who can then train others and earn at the same time," an official associated with the development said. Using the infrastructure of the university, these trainers whose remuneration will be linked to their performance, will be paid by the state government through university in case of free or subsidised training. More the trainees, the more the trainers earn with the university fixing the rates.

The state government also plans to take initiatives for development of human

resources in other fields also, in view of the likely expansion of the drone sector and its extensive application for improving governance and achieving transformational changes in the fields of agriculture, policing, defence, and mining. KSU has entered memorandum of understandings with the Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative, Drone Federation of India, Agriculture Skill Council of India, Electronics Skill Council of India, Aerospace and Aviation Sector Skill Council, Telecom Sector Skill Council and IT-TES Sector Skill Council.

## Over 120 million tonnes of cargo transported through Gujarat waterways in past five years

Ahmedabad : Over 120 million tonnes of cargo have been transported through national waterways in Gujarat in last five years, accounting for 34 percent of the total cargo movement through inland water transport in the country. Out of the 111 national waterways identified under the National Waterways Act 2016, 26 were found viable for cargo and passenger movements which included National Waterway 73 on Narmada river and National Waterway 100 on Tapi river. According to data tabled in Lok Sabha earlier this month, in Gujarat, cargo movement through national waterways began in 2017-18 when 11.52 million tonnes of cargo was transported. In 2020-21, the cargo

transportation reached 25.72 million tonnes and till February 28, 2022, 26.68 metric tonne had been clocked for financial year 2021-22. In Gujarat, the bulk of the cargo movement is happening through the Tapi river. Of the 25.72 million metric tonne of cargo transported in 2020-21, 25.6 million metric tonnes was conducted through Tapi and only 0.2, 31.1 metric tonnes happened through Narmada.

## Gujarat: 11 booked for 'torturing' nurse, 'abetting' her suicide

Ahmedabad : Days after a staff nurse at Mansa Civil Hospital in Gandhinagar allegedly died by suicide at her residence, police booked 11 of her in-laws for allegedly torturing her and abetting the crime, taking into account a handwritten note by the woman. According to police, the body of nurse Bhumika Chavda (29), a resident of Raj Bungalows in Mansa, was found under mysterious circumstances by a few neighbors of the society. Bhumika is the younger sister of Hardevsinh Chavda, a head constable with sector 21

police station in Gandhinagar, and was married to Rahul Dabhi. The couple had two daughters aged two and three years.

"On March 31 night, my brother-in-law Rahul called me and said that he was away from home and Bhumika was not attending calls. Later, when Rahul asked a neighbour to check his house, when they found Bhumika hanging in one of the rooms," said Hardevsinh in his complaint.

"After she was rushed to civil hospital in Mansa, doctors declared her BPT

dead. On April 1, I found a suicide note written by Bhumika in which she has named 11 of her in-laws, excluding her husband Rahul, for mentally and physically torturing her," he added.

Taking cognisance, police have booked 11 accused, including the parents of Rahul Dabhi, under IPC sections 306 for abetment to suicide and 498a for cruelty against a woman. According to police, the body of nurse Bhumika Chavda (29), a resident of Raj Bungalows in Mansa, was found under mysterious circumstances by a few neighbors of the society.
