# Cops log into social media to check traffic problems

People can share traffic-related issues and photos with police

To help people in a more meaningful way, the Hubballi-Dharwad police are making use of social media to address traffic woes in the twin cities.

Now, people can reach out to the police on their social media accounts and share traffic-related issues with photos and also get the issues solved shortly.

The city police are already on social media and addressing grievances of the public. There was a demand for separate traffic handles as the twin cities have been reporting huge traffic problems these days following enormous vehicle movements.

A senior officer said during the first 'Sanchara Samparka Divas', which was held on the second Saturday of this month, many people suggested a separate social media account to solve traffic-related issues in the twin cities. Dedicated traffic officials and staff will be monitoring the issues and they will be solved within a short time, he said. Sunil Nalavade, an urban activist, said a separate social media handle was the most required for the twin cities on the lines of Bengaluru. "Whenever people complain

about traffic problems and about violators, Bengaluru traffic police take immediate action, such an action is needed here as the city has been growing," he said.

"The public is the third eye of the traffic police, they can catch violators, and address traffic issues that are posted on social media by people. Even the public can post traffic jams, minor accidents on roads, photos of violators and more. It can be addressed by the traffic police, they should also post the

action taken by cops," he added. Hubballi-Dharwad Police Commissioner Labhu Ram said now people can directly share traffic issues on their social media accounts with photos.

"Traffic woes will be addressed in real-time and also it will be monitored by top officials. There is a team to handle social media accounts, they will inform the traffic police stations and staff concerned about the issues received on the social media accounts," he added.

# ADVOCATES STIR FOR CONSUMER BENCH ENTERS SECOND DAY

ADVOCATES of Belagavi Bar Association (BBA) continued with their protest alleging negligence of government in establishing the bench of Karnataka State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (KSCDR), in Belagavi for the consecutive second day on Wednesday.

As a part of the protest, the lawyers boycotted court proceedings and took out a rally and shouted slogans against the state government, Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai and Forest, Food and Civil Supplies Minister Umesh Katti for neglecting their demand. Bar Association vice-president Sudhir Chavan told TNIE the lawyers of Belagavi

had been demanding the government to establish KSCDR for a long time. However, the government has already made necessary provisions for the establishment of KSCDR at Kalaburgi, and Belagavi is still neglected.

Chavan said KSCDR bench has been sanctioned for both Belagavi and Kalaburgi. While the process on KSCDR bench at Kalaburgi has commenced, it is being delayed in Belagavi for unknown reasons. Minister Umesh Katti though hails from Belagavi district has failed to get funds for the same, he alleged.

Chavan said, "We will continue to boycott court proceedings until the government considers our demand."

# Panic in Kushtagi after dog bites 20 people

RESIDENTS of Vidyanagar locality in Kushtagi of Koppal district were in for a shock on Wednesday early morning as a street dog (mad dog according to locals) bit 20 people.

Initially, the dog bit seven people and when people chased, it ran around and bit 13 more people, including those arriving from rural areas to Kushtagi town. While two youths suffered injuries to their hands and legs due to dog bite, an elderly person received injuries below his stomach, said eyewitnesses. Subsequently, those injured were treated as outpatients at

Kushtagi taluk hospital and they are all but one out of danger, Kushtagi taluk hospital chief medical officer Dr Chandrashekhara Mantri told TNIE on Wednesday.

One person, who has been seriously injured, is under medical watch by the hospital doctors, he said. However, names of those injured due to dog bite were not available as they were treated as outpatients, he maintained. Meanwhile, Kushtagi residents said that the menace of street dogs has been persisting in the town. The authorities concerned, including Kushtagi Town Municipal Council (TMC), have to check the same,

been brought to the notice of the TMC, while Deputy Conservator of Forests (DCF) Harshakumar said that domestic animals do not come under the department and onus is on the Kushtagi TMC to capture mad dog and curb menace of street animals, especially dogs.

Citizens, especially residents of Vidyaniketana locality, are apprehensive of mad dog resurfacing in the town, said Gayatramma, a homemaker. A similar incident of street dog menace had occurred in Koppal a couple of years back, recalled an official of Koppal City Municipal Council (CMC).

# Woman ends life with three kids

A woman along with her three children, including a two-year-old toddler, committed suicide allegedly by jumping into a pond at Toravi Tanda-1 village near Tikota on Wednesday.

The deceased are identified as Anitha Jhadav (27) home maker and her three children Praveen (6), Sudeep (4) and Ma-

madika (2) all residents of Toravi Tanda -1. The incident reportedly occurred in the afternoon hours. She is survived by her husband Pintu Jhadav a farmer.

According to police, "Prima facie it is suspected to be a family dispute. All was not well in the family. She is likely to have jumped into the pond along with her children. The arrests with regard to the case are yet

to be made as the investigation is underway."

The police removed the bodies from the pond after nearly two hours of search operation. The police are inquiring the family members and neighbours connected to the case and no one has been either arrested or taken into custody.

A case has been registered in Vijayapura Rural police station.
