# NEARING 90m, NEERAJ AIMS BIG

After a national record effort in Finland, Olympic champion focusses on training & technique to hit magical mark

THE conditions were near-perfect in Turku. Tokyo 2020 Olympic champion Neeraj Chopra stood confidently on the track and took aim towards the season. He strode to the throwing mark in his typical style — seven steps to crossover, threw the javelin and half-rolled. In the second attempt, the javelin flew to a distance of 89.30m — a personal best and also a national record at the Paavo Nurmi Games in Turku on Tuesday. That mark was good enough for a silver medal.

The competition was strong as well. Most of the top throwers competed. But for Neeraj, it's just a teaser to bigger and better things this year. The 90m mark is just 70cm away.

Neeraj felt the distance of 89.30m was not something unexpected. His progression, too, lends weight to his words. During the 2018 Asian Games in Jakarta, he broke the 88m mark with an 88.06m effort. That was before his elbow injury and close association with coach and bio mechanic expert Klaus Bartonietz. On his return after injury (he missed the entire 2019 season) in January 2020, he threw 87.86m in South Africa and qualified for Olympics. He started to train with Bartonietz and after a forced Covid break, he threw 88.07m, a personal best, at the beginning of the 2021 season. "Since 2018, I had a feeling that 90m throw is possible," he said through voice notes. "Which particular day it will happen? The day I shall be able to throw

in the correct direction and in the precise angle, that day I shall be able to achieve it. It's not that I'm not expecting it."

Neeraj felt that the best part was that he could better his own mark. "Personal best means I have done better than what I had done earlier. And that's the target of every athlete. To do better

than his previous best."

It had been more than ten months since he had hurled the spear in a competition. For an athlete, it's considered a long break. Getting into competition too has its own challenges. After an Olympic gold, maintaining high standards would always be challenging. For Neeraj and his team, a throw around the 86m mark would have been considered a very good start. But 89.30m definitely lights up the season with World Championships and Commonwealth Games in quick succession next month. Like his team says, "it's a satisfying start". Turku over, Neeraj and his team were heading to Kuortane (also in Finland) on Wednesday for the next event, wh on June 18.

Neeraj sounded happy and re-

lieved too, especially for doing well after a 10-month break from competition. "I had a nice feeling to get back into competition. Ten months after the Olympics is quite a long time," said the 24-year-old. His sole objective was to start on a good note. "We were trying to implement whatever we were focussing on during training, especially technique. Even while throwing, I needed to keep that in mind," said Neeraj. "Effort was fine, but the angle of the throw was going inside (javelin drifted towards the left after throwing)." Neeraj is hopeful of good results in the days to come. "This performance will give me more confidence for the entire season and a belief that I can do better. Now I have to focus on the technique and training and throw

## Dal Lake to host sub-junior rowing nat'l

FOR the first time, Dal Lake in Srinagar (Jammu & Kashmir) will host 23rd Sub Junior National Rowing Championships and 5th Inter State Challengers National Championships from June 20 to 26. In its bid to promote gender equality, the Rowing Federation of India has made it mandatory for every participating unit to field at least one women's team to be able to compete in the sub-junior event, which will be held in two age groups — U-13 and 15. Both the events will be held over a distance of 500m. The rowers can compete in single sculls, double sculls, coxless pairs and coxless fours. However, in sub-junior, U-13 boys and girls can participate only in double sculls.

### HARDIK STEPS UP

Wicket-keeper batter Hardik Tamore cracked 115 to propel Mumbai to 393 in their first innings against Uttar Pradesh. In reply, Uttar Pradesh were reeling at 25/2 two at stumps, having lost opener Samarth Singh (0) and Priyam Garg (5) early. While the first day belonged to Yashasvi Jaiswal, who had hammered his second first-class ton, it was Tamore's show on Wednesday. Tamore, who resumed on unbeaten 51, anchored the innings after the Mumbai began from their overnight score of 260/5. He forged a 113-run stand with Shams Mulani for the sixth wicket before Karan Sharma dismissed the latter.

But Manoj Tiwary (84 batting) and Shahbaz Ahmed (72 batting) put up an unbeaten 143-run stand for the sixth wicket to take Bengal to 197/5 at the end of day's play. After Kartikeya took two wickets in the first over of the innings, Puneet Datey dismissed Abhimanyu Easwaran and Abishek Porel cheaply. However, the Tiwary-Ahmed duo ensured they did not lose any further wickets.
