Mumbai: Observing that a mother will not put her daughter's chastity at stake for a measly discount, a special Pocco court this week convicted and sentenced a 23-year-old salesman to three years rigorous imprisonment for twice molesting a 17-year-old girl during trials at the saree store where he was employed. The accused had sexually abused the minor while draping her sarees. Special judge Anis A J Khan refuted accused Datta Salunkhe's defence that the child's mother had falsely implicated him after he turned down her request for a discount. The voice that was Rahul's lifeline in epic borewell rescue in C'garh

NDRF Rescuer From AP Recounts Heart-Stopping Moments With Trapped Boy

Raipur: What a mother's voice is to her baby in the womb, an NDRF constable's incessant calling was to little Rahul, 24x7, for nearly five days. "Rahul wake up... Rahul have a banana, Rahul..." was a constant echo at the rescue site at Pihridi village of Janjgir-Champa in Chhattisgarh.

Rahul is speech and hearing impaired but constable B Anil Kumar's booming voice seems to have sent down reassuring vibrations because every time he shouted, Rahul would look up.

"This connection was struck at the very beginning. As I hunched down and peered into the borewell to see where the kid was, in that

exact moment he looked up at me. It was like an omen. Isko bacha lenge (we'll save him), I told myself. And the little one kind of reassured me. I felt he was saying, 'if you try, you can save me, I won't give up,' said Anil, hoarse with emotion and

from shouting for five days. After a pause, Anil said: "As a rescuer, you have to be tough and aren't allowed to cry. But whenever I saw Rahul responding to my calls despite his challenges, it would choke me up," said the NDRF man.

Anil was Rahul's lifeline from 11.30pm on Friday to nearly midnight on Tuesday, lying on his stomach, hollering down a dark hole, and even keeping count of Rahul's breaths.

"That's how I knew he was panicking when heavy drills were used to cut through the massive slabs of rock that blocked us. His chest began heaving rapidly and I shouted that we need to stop drilling," Kumar, a native of Guntur in Andhra

Pradesh, said. He is with NDRF's 3rd battalion and was posted in Bhilai a month ago.

The scene when NDRF arrived on site on Friday night was gloomy, he said. No one knew if Rahul was alive. A camera was roped in to check. And then began one of the biggest and most complex rescue ops the country has seen.

"I started calling out Rahul's name. With children, you need to develop trust and confidence. The little child was crying. I slowly roped down a banana and a packet of juice. He devoured it," the NDRF personnel recounted. It's not known how much the differently-abled boy heard, but he would respond to indicate he was alive.

There were several heart-stopping moments, Anil said. "On Saturday evening, I suddenly saw a creature slithering around. My blood froze. It was a snake. I started praying for his safety and kept trying to identify the snake. When I could make out it was non-poisonous, I almost wept with relief, but then the child wouldn't know it. Imagine his terror! But he stayed calm," he said. Another nerve-wracker was when water started rising in the borewell. "At one point, Rahul was neck deep in water. It was a very tense time," he said. Rescuers and villagers worked frantically to pump out water in the area so that it didn't rise in the borewell.

Time to handhold farmers to begin work on ground to improve soil health: Sadhguru

New Delhi: With the global save soil movement heading for its last leg of awareness campaign bringing 74 countries on board, Sadhguru of the Isha Foundation has said it's now time to handhold farmers both within India and outside to begin actual works on the ground to improve health of the soil by increasing its organic content.

For this, five big states — Gujarat, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh

and Maharashtra — have already signed MOUs with the Isha Foundation while others including Karnataka may do so in coming days, making it the largest such movement where respective govern-

ments would work to improve the health of the soils through policy interventions and support.

Though India has a policy in the form of a central flagship scheme of 'Soil Health Cards' (SHC), Sadhguru, who launched the scheme in March, felt the scheme needs a little bit of tweaking to ensure enough organic content in the soils.

"You are looking at soils as a resource. But, I am looking at soils as a source of life. As a source of life, it must be kept alive because it's the founda-

tion of our existence. Now if you are looking at it only in terms of how to use it then you are thinking let's throw some more nitrogen, phosphate etc. and we are done. So, SHC should include ensuring a percentage of organic content. Once that happens then we are moving in the right direction," said Sadhguru.

In an interview to TOI, Sadhguru explained how the ongoing SHC is a bit different from what he has been pitching for through the ongoing 'save soil' movement. Full report on www.toi.in

Another reason for stock replenishments at pumps getting delayed is longer distance from depots or terminals. "In particular, this has been noticed in Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka. These are states where large quantity of supply was being done by retail outlets," the ministry said. The ministry described it as a seasonal surge and attributed to agricultural activities, bulk buyers switching to retail outlets and a substantial reduction in the sales by private players pushing their substantial volumes. "Simultaneously, as a result of a crackdown by the government, these volumes have also been added to the RO diesel sale," it said.

There are widespread concerns the radical Agnipath scheme to recruit the bulk of soldiers for only four years on an "all-India, all-class" basis will hit professionalism, regimental ethos and fighting spirit of the Army. It is also feared it will lead to militarisation of society with over 35,000 combat-trained youth being ren-

dered jobless every year. The Army vice chief, however, maintained these are largely ill-conceived and misplaced. "Regimentation, ethos and camaraderie is an output of a group of soldiers staying together, eating together and fighting together, irrespective of whether they belong to a particular community or not. There will be no dilution of the basic ethos," he said.

'Rahul Gandhi takes 3-4 hours break to review his responses'

When approached for a response, Congress secretary Pranav Jha told TOI: "proceedings of the ED are of judicial nature and leaking them is a criminal offense. Therefore, we will not comment on it."

Rahul's questioning will continue on Friday as he sought exemption on Thursday. Rahul and his mother Sonia Gandhi, the Congress president, together hold 76% stakes in Young Indian and the remaining 24% was held by Vora and Oscar Fernandes (12% each). Vora and Fernandes passed away in December 2020 and September 2021, respectively.

The ED sources denied the suggestion that it was not letting Rahul leave until 11pm out of any design. "He leaves late because after every three hours of questioning, the Congress leader takes 3-4 hours of break to 'review' his responses... effectively, we have been getting only around six hours to question him," the source said.

While Rahul's questioning will resume on Friday, Sonia Gandhi has been summoned on June 23 for questioning in the case after she sought deferment because of Covid infection. She is under-

going treatment at the Sir Ganga Ram Hospital here. Meanwhile, chaos continued on the streets of central Delhi with Congress workers indulging in arson and violent protests, breaking police bandobast while trying to march towards the ED office at APJ Abdul Kalam Road. Rahul, as usual, appeared after 11 am at the enforcement agency on Wednesday and took a lunch break for an hour before rejoining at 4 pm. For the last two days he had been leaving the agency's office past 11 in the night.

Sources said that the probe shows that after Young Indian's acquisition of A.J.L, two of YI's founders Suman Dube and Sam Pitroda, exited as a shareholder transferring their shares to Sonia and Oscar Fernandes.

In Shopian, acting on specific information about the presence of terrorists in the Kanji Ullar village area, a joint cord-and-search operation was launched by the police, Army (34 RR) and CRPF (178 Bn), IGP (Kashmir) Vijay Kumar said, adding that security personnel were fired upon when they approached the spot where the terrorists were hiding, leading to an encounter in which two terrorists were killed.

The terrorists slain in Shopian were identified as Jan Mohammed Lone of Brapirora, Shopian, and Tufail Nazir Ganie of Ramnagri, Shopian. The IGP said Lone had been involved in the killing of the bank manager in Kulgam on June 2. He added that Lone had been an OGW for LeT district commander Adil Ramzan and that he had killed the bank manager on the LeT commander's directions.
