Medicos from S'kulam stranded in Ukraine

Students say they are located 500 km from Kyiv, add they're not facing issues now but situation may worsen

TWO students from the district sought government assistance for evacuation from Ukraine after Russia invaded the country.

N Kumara Swamy Naidu of Kambarivalasa village in Veeraghattam mandal and S Vamsi Krishna of Palakonda mandal headquarters are in their fifth year pursuing medicine at the Bukovinian State Medical University in Chernivtsi, Ukraine.

Speaking to TNIE over the phone, Kumara Swamy said, "At least 1,000 Indian students, including 70 from both Telugu states, study at the University. Among them, we two are from Srikakulam district. As of now, we don't have any problems as the bombing has begun in the western part of Ukraine which is 500 km from Kyiv city. But the situation is getting worse by the hour. All forms of transportation, markets and ATMs are closed. So, we are facing issues with regard to getting essential commodities. It seems like the situation might worsen in the next 48 hours.

"My parents are afraid of the prevailing situation. So, I request the Indian Embassy as well as the government to evacuate us as soon as possible. Indian embassy officials have directed us to safe places (nearby bomb shelters) according to Google maps list as Ukraine is under mar-

tial law. However, it will get difficult to reach the these places once Russian army starts the attacks," he added,

Vamsi Krishna told TNIE, "We are scared to see what is happening in the eastern part of Ukraine. So, we want to come back to India. I appeal the Indian government as well as the Embassy to evacuate us as soon as possible from Ukraine."

Kumara Swamy and Vamsi's parents met Srikakulam MP Kinjarapu Ram Mohan Naidu and requested him to help their children.

The MP spoke to the students through WhatsApp video call and assured them that they will be evacu-

Following this, Ram Mohan Naidu also wrote a letter to External Affairs Minister Subrahmanyam Jaishankar, urging him to take necessary steps through the Indian Embassy for the safe evacuation of the students.

Ukraine crisis: Power outages, Wi-Fi issues add to parents' woes

PARENTS of students from the State pursuing education at various universities in Ukraine are anxious as their children are stranded in the country that Russia has invaded.

The flights, which left for Ukraine from India to evacuate those stranded, were forced to return as all the airports in Ukraine were shut in view of the air strikes.

ready stopped. The anxious father urged the government to facilitate communication between the parents and their children in Ukraine.

'We are hearing sounds of bomb explosions and blasts causing panic to us," she said.

There are nearly 3,000 students from India in four university hostels in Oleksiivska and of them about 800 are Telugus. "We are in touch with Indian embassy officials, but they are in a hapless position to aid us," she said.

Explaining the situation there, she said, "All departmental stores ran out of stock as people resorted to panic buying. We do not have sufficient food. I have some biscuits and cakes and two bottles of water with which I have to sustain now. I have no idea how long we will be in bunkers," Sreeja said. She booked a flight ticket to Delhi from Kyiv for Saturday to return home. "All the flight tickets were booked by students from my university. But flights have been cancelled. My parents back home are a worried lot. The Indian embassy should take steps for our safe re-

turn to India," she pleaded. Sreeja said those who were supposed to catch the Thursday flight left for Kyiv on Wednesday. But their flight was cancelled and they were stranded at the airport.

"Like many other students, including those from AP, we are in a state of despair. We do not know what to do. We urge PM Modi and CM Jagan to bring us back to India by military flights if civilian flights are not allowed," she urged. "I never thought that I would be caught in such a tense situation. I came here in December with a lot of hope to study MBBS and return to India as a doctor," Sreeja said.

Her father Reddi Arjun told TNIE that his daughter is very intelligent. "We sent her to Ukraine for medicine due to much delay in NEET and no clarity on the exam schedule," he said.

Arjun, who runs a cement shop, said they were trying to bring Sreeja back to India for the last 15 days. However, due to delay in getting transit visa, she could not come back.

Sreeja and other students had gone to Ukraine on temporary visa, which was supposed to be renewed after three months. However, there was a delay in renewal and they had to depend on temporary visa, he added.

"We have appointed two officers who are in touch with Telugu students. There is much concern in the wake of cancellation of flights. The AP government is coordinating with the Ministry of External Affairs to reach out to the stranded Telugu students in Ukraine," he

Assuring that all steps are being taken to bring back the stranded students to AP safely, he said Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy had already written a letter to the Union Minister for External Affairs in this regard.

"We are requesting parents not to worry about their children's safety in Ukraine. The State government is in constant touch with the Ministry of External Affairs and evolving steps to bring back the stranded students to AP in special flights once the situation improves,' Suresh said. Later, he spoke to Yeshwant, an AP student stranded in Ukraine, over phone and enquired about the situation in the East European country and advised him to strictly follow all the directions issued by the Indian embassy in Kyiv and not to venture out unnecessarily.


