



AAP, Oppn continue to spar even as Sisodia sent to Tihar Jail

•The AAP leader was produced before special judge M K Nagpal on the expiry of his custodial interrogation •The CBI said it did not require his custody 'for now'

SEVERAL AAP leaders on Monday sprang to defend former Delhi Deputy CM Manish Sisodia who was sent on a 14-day judicial custody by a Rouse Avenue court on the expiry of his seven-day CBI custody in the so-called liquor policy scam case.



Sisodia was produced before special judge M K Nagpal on Monday on the expiry of his custodial interrogation. The CBI told the court that it did not require the custody of the senior AAP leader for now.

An official was quoted as saying later that Sisodia was brought to Tihar Jail following the court order and he will be lodged in jail number-1 after the completion of the due formalities.

AAP spokesperson Atishi highlighted that the CBI, which is probing the alleged scam, and had conducted raids at various locations of the country in this context, did not ask for Sisodia's further remand.

"Even after raiding the former Education Minister's house, office, locker, and his native village earlier, the CBI has not found any evidence to implicate him. Despite the full-time involvement of nearly 250 CBI officers for over a year in investigating the alleged Delhi excise policy scam, the agency

has not been able to find any concrete evidence against Manish Sisodia," she said. She claimed that the agency's only strategy was to coerce Sisodia into signing a false confession during the time it had his custody for seven days.

AAP MLA Kuldeep Kumar said that the whole country knew on whose behest the CBI had been acting so far. "Manish Sisodia has given the entire country an excellent model of education, and keeping such a person in jail will earn the BJP the ire of lakhs of children and their parents," he said.

Meanwhile, the BJP on Monday burnt the effigies of Manish Sisodia, Satyendra Jain and Arvind Kejriwal at several locations in the city.

ers are symbols of liquor scam and corruption, so we have gathered to burn their effigies," said BJP state president Virendra Sachdeva.

Delhi Pradesh Congress Committee president Anil Kumar Chaudhary said that the court's decision to send Sisodia to 14-day judicial custody has established that there was strong evidence against him in the alleged liquor scam.

He said that in the past 10 years, the government had created a sort of world record in committing scams without fulfilling any of the promises made to the people.

Sisodia, who held 18 portfolios in the Delhi government including Education and Excise, had resigned from the Kejriwal-led Cabinet following his arrest by the CBI in connection with alleged corruption in the formulation and implementation of the now-scrapped Excise Policy for 2021-22.

Posters by Congress mock AAP, Kejriwal

THE Delhi unit of the Congress has put up posters outside its offices highlighting the so-called liquor scam case.

The posters displayed photographs of AAP leaders Manish Sisodia and Satyendra Jain behind bars, and carried a statement of CM Arvind Kejriwal, "The one who is corrupt is also anti-national."

The Congress has also written to the Delhi L-G seeking his intervention to prevent 'tainted' MLAs Saurav Bharadwaj and Atishi from being made ministers to replace Sisodia and Jain.

Denouncing the party, Delhi Pradesh Congress Committee president Anil Kumar Chaudhary said that Delhi has now become a "capital of scams" as Jain has been languishing in Tihar Jail for 9 months in a money laundering case.

"Kejriwal, who promised a corruption-free and transparent government, has been caught in 10 major scams in the past 10 years" said Chaudhary.

Ahead of Holika Dahan, BJP burns AAP leaders' effigies across capital

INTENSIFYING its attack on the ruling AAP, BJP celebrated Holi on Monday by setting fire to effigies of AAP leaders Satyendra Jain, Manish Sisodia, and Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, spanning all 70 assembly constituencies.

BJP's state-working president Virendra Sachdeva, who protested at Hanuman Mandir said that on the occasion of Holika Dahan (which celebrates victory of good over evil), AAP leaders symbolised liquor scam and corruption.

He said Kejriwal comes to the Hanuman Mandir, to seek blessings of the Almighty before his endeavours in an election.

"With the divine blessings, he was to do good work for people and bring peace in society. But AAP dispensation took steps that proliferated liquor vends in the city, even near religious places and schools, and incentivised consumption of alcohol," he said.

Bidhuri also slammed AAP and alleged "massive corruption" in the formulation and implementation of the liquor policy for 2021-22.

Bidhuri claimed that under the old liquor policy, liquor worth ₹20,000 crore was sold every year in Delhi, out of which the government earned ₹6,000 crore but nothing came from the new policy.

Addressing the party workers, Bidhuri said that resignation of Manish Sisodia and Satyendra Jain from the Delhi Cabinet amid corruption alle-

gations is a "victory of truth" while claiming that CM would have to resign as well as he is the mastermind behind the liquor scam.

Hours before the news of the two ministers' resignations hit the headlines, the BJP had said that it would raise awareness on the "conspiracy" that was hatched to "toy" with the future of youths in Delhi by allowing the "proliferation" of liquor vends.

A Delhi court on Monday remanded Sisodia to 14 days of judicial custody.

Tight security for Holi, Shab-e-Baraat

Ahead of Shab-e-Baraat (Blessed night) and Holi, the Delhi Police has made elaborate security arrangements to prevent stunt-biking and prevent hoodliganism.

Arrangements have been made for the safety of motorists and pedestrians while ensuring smooth traffic flow.

A senior police official said that on the night of Shab-e-Baraat, devotees offer prayers beside the grave of their ancestors and also at mosques.

More than 9,000 police personnel will be deployed at several places to maintain peace. The city will be under heavy security cover of 150 companies of the para-military force.

The traffic police will also be handling arrangements with



the local police having a deployment of around 759 cops.

A police official said adequate arrangements have been made to ensure safety of motorists on roads, ensure smooth flow of traffic, keep the pedestrians on the footpaths, guide the devotees/road users regarding routes and to prevent rash and negligent driving or performance of stunts on two-

wheelers.

As many as 759 traffic officers will be deployed at 283 strategic locations. Special Traffic Police teams along with PCR and local police teams will be stationed on various locations/intersections to check drunken driving and other traffic rule violations.

"As per the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on

Road Safety, in cases of drunken driving, red light jumping, using mobile phone while driving and over speeding, driving license will be seized and violators will be liable for suspension for minimum 3 months," the official said.

The police said that they have identified more than 500 vulnerable points.

Special checking teams consisting of 2,033 officers will be deployed at 287 major intersections and 233 drunken points (vulnerable points) to detect and prosecute traffic violations.

The cops urged people not to drink and drive and drive within the speed limit.

"Two-wheeler riders have been asked to wear helmets and avoid triple riding," the official said.



Govt hospital services affected as doctors protest against assault

THE emergency block of a Delhi government-run hospital was forced to shut down for several hours on Sunday after a patient and her family members allegedly attacked doctors on duty there.

The doctors sat on protest abstaining themselves from the emergency services for hours demanding protection against such incidents.

However, the services were restored after the police arrived and filed a complaint against the patient and her attendants. The incident was reported on Sunday night at Babu Jagjivan Ram Memorial Hospital in Jahangirpuri.

According to hospital sources, the female patient came to the hospital as she suffered nose injuries. As there were several patients, the doctor asked her to wait, following which the incident took place. "The nurses said that the two

doctors in the emergency block were looking after other patients and asked her to wait," the source added.

He added, "The patient agitated and her family members started pressuring the staff for immediate treatment. Later, they barged into the doctors' room and started arguing with them." The hospital officials said that the security guards came in to rescue and disperse the attendants however; they entered again and started beating the doctors.

The doctors sustained injuries on their faces and other body parts. A case under sections 186 (obstructing public servant in discharge of public functions), 353 (assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharge of his duty), 332 (voluntarily causing hurt to deter public servant from his duty) and 34 (common intention) of the Indian Penal Code was registered and further investigation of the case is in progress, the police said.

Police arrest Nasir gang sharpshooter after tip-off

The Special Cell of Delhi Police has arrested a gangster and sharp-shooter of Nasir gang who had a long history of committing heinous crimes for over 13 years.

The accused, identified as Mohd. Yusuf (42) had been involved in 8 heinous cases including murder, police said. Deputy Commissioner of Police (Special Cell) Rajiv Ranjan Singh said his team received information about the movements and criminal activities of wanted and desperate criminals namely Yusuf and Akil in Delhi a few months ago.

"It was found that on September 6, last year accused Yusuf along with Akil committed a robbery of ₹14 lakhs in the area of Civil Lines at gunpoint. They also robbed the scooter from the riders," the DCP said.

Akil and Yusuf fled to Mumbai to evade arrest. On December 8, last year, Akil was apprehended from Nizamuddin Railway Station while he was coming from Mumbai and it was revealed that Yusuf flee to his native village in Akbarpur, UP to evade arrest, they said.

On March 1, a tip-off was received that Yusuf will meet his friend near Jaffarabad. Acting on this information, a trap was laid and the accused was apprehended.

Police finally net snatcher zooming around on high-end bike to evade arrest

A 29-year-old robber, who used to use a high-end motorcycle to zoom away after snatching, was arrested on Monday. Interestingly, he continued committing the crime despite getting shot by the UP Police twice in two different encounters.

The accused, identified as Nazakat Ali alias KTM alias Naushad alias Bhura, used to snatch on his high-speed KTM

bikes in Agra, Kanpur, Ghaziabad, Noida and Greater Noida. He was previously involved in 33 criminal cases.

DCP (South) Chandan Chowdhary said an orange-black KTM bike was used in such activity. After scrutinizing CCTV footages, they found the accused along with an accomplice committing snatching on February 15. The police identified the number of the bike which was found to be registered in the name of Ashraf. Accord-

ingly, a raid was conducted at the residence of Ashraf who informed that the bike is registered in his name but the same is being used by Nazakat, who used to be his neighbour.

"Ashraf, being the prime suspect was interrogated after which the police got to know that Nazakat lived in Gajraula, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh," the DCP said.

Subsequently, several raids were conducted at the said location and it was revealed that



Nazakat was a hardcore criminal and that he was shot twice. To avoid any suspicion, he kept changing his whereabouts, bikes and mobile numbers frequently.

The police team traced Nazakat in Sangam Vihar, Wazirabad, Delhi from where he was apprehended.

Historic Urdu poetry symposium back with a bang

SHANKAR-Shaad Mushaira -- one of the three historic Urdu poetry symposiums -- will bring veterans and new age writers/poets on the same podium. The annual event is an opportunity for Urdu poetry lovers to witness the brilliance of some of the greatest contemporary poets.

In the 54th edition of the annual symposium, prominent poets such as Waseem Bareilly, Munawwar Rana, Prasoon Joshi, Nadeem Shad, Minu Bakshi and famous screenwriter and lyricist Javed Akhtar will enthral audience with their mesmerising couplets, said the organiser-Shankar Lal Murlidhar Memorial Society.

However, given the current geopolitical situation, there will be no participation from abroad. The event will take place on March 11 at its usual venue—Modern School, Barakhamba Road.

The society, formed by the illustrious Conglomerate DCM Sri Ram, started holding the show in 1954 in which eminent poets participated regularly.

The founder of the DCM group, Lala Sri Ram, decided a periodic symposium after consulting with the leading literary figures of the time -- Josh Malihabadi, Shankar Prasad, (then Chief Commission-

er of Delhi), Professor Mujeeb (Vice Chancellor Jamia Millia Islamia), Ram Dhari Singh Dinkar, V Shankar and KG Syed (noted civil servants and educationists). They encouraged his idea of floating a trust in the memory of Sir Shankar Lal 'Shankar' (brother of Shri Ram) and Lala Murlidhar 'Shad' (son of Sir Shri Ram), who were well-known poets of Delhi.

Due to Covid-19, the Mushaira could not take place for 3 years. Speaking on the initiative, Rohit Lal of DCM Shriram Industries Ltd, said, "Urdu is part of Delhi's culture and heritage hence such events have played a important role in preserving and celebrating the heritage. This valued cooperation of great literary giants continues to enrich the cultural life of the Indian subcontinent."
