Speed up handover of title deeds: CM

- Directs officials to complete distribution of permanent title deeds to the beneficiaries in 2,000 villages where Phase-1 land resurvey has been over by Jan
- Tells authorities to recruit necessary staff for village/ward secretariat for taking up resurvey in 2,000 villages in phase 2 and complete handover of title deeds by Feb 15
- Besides, title deeds, CM wants officials to write letters all beneficiaries explaining how they are benefited while getting relief from the land disputes and court cases arising out of Section 22-A of Registrations Act

CHIEF Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy directed the officials to expedite the distribution of permanent title deeds to the beneficiaries in 2,000 villages where the first phase of land resurvey has been completed under the YSR Jagannanna Saswatha Bhu Hakku-Bhu Raksha Scheme.

Taking stock of the distribution of title deeds during a review of the scheme on Monday, the Chief Min-

ister instructed the officials to complete the distribution of title deeds by January.

Responding to the action plan outlined by the officials to take up the survey in 2,000 villages under the second phase and complete the distribution of title deeds by February 15, he told them to recruit necessary staff in more than 15,000 village and ward secretariats by taking the village secretariat as a unit. The resurvey, taken up after 100 years, should be foolproof and of high standards as

the task is going on like a 'maha yagnam' and bound to re-write the history. He suggested that, after handing over the title deeds, individual letters be written to all beneficiaries explaining how they are benefited while getting relief from the complex land disputes and court cases arising out of Section 22-A of Registrations Act. While stressing the need to speed up the survey to find a permanent solution to land owners who suffered from various litigations, he directed the geology and mining de-

partment to increase production of survey stones at their units and make them ready by March.

Earlier, officials told the Chief Minister that permanent title deeds were handed over to 7.29 lakh persons in 2,000 villages in 4.3 lakh subdivisions under the first phase that witnessed two lakh mutations and 92,000 first time entries and solved 19,000 land disputes besides saving Rs 37.57 crores of people's money.

He was also informed that arrangements have been made to complete the survey by July 2023 in 4,119 ward secretariats spread across 123 corporations and municipalities in the urban areas of the state.

Deputy Chief Minister (panchayat raj and rural development) Budi Mutyala Naidu, chief secretary Dr K S Jawahar Reddy, principal advisor to CM Ajeya Kallam, chief commissioner (land administration) G Sai Prasad, principal secretary (panchayat raj and rural development) Gopala Krishna Dwivedi, finance secretary K V V Satyanarayana, commissioner (survey settlements and land records) Siddharth Jain, panchayat raj commissioner Kona Sasidhar, CCLA secretary A A Imtiaz, municipal administration director Pravin Kumar, director of mines and geology V G Venkata Reddy were among those present.

Kodali Nani flays TDP for organising Ranga anniversary

FORMER minister and MLA Kodali Sri Venkateswara Rao (Nani) claimed that he had been organising the death and birth anniversaries of the slain Congress MLA Vangaveeti Mohan Ranga for the last 18 years to recall Ranga's services to the downtrodden.

Addressing the media here on Monday, Kodali Nani alleged that it was the political forces in the TDP who assassinated Ranga. Ranga strove hard to highlight the mistakes of the then TDP government to the notice of the people and also attempted to bring the problems of people to the notice of the government.

"Ranga was the leader of people and he was a force to reckon with." Ranga launched a hunger strike seeking protection for his life. However, the then TDP government resorted to his murder, he said. Even 34 years after his assassination, he was still alive in the hearts of people, he remarked.

"If Vangaveeti Radhakrishna thinks that he was meted out injustice in the YSRC, it is his personal opinion. Our friendship is above party lines. Whatever party affiliations, Radhakrishna and I am still friends," he said. Kodali Nani dismissed the incidents of Sunday in Gudivada as 'a mere farce'.

Anantapur cops bust illegal arms gang

THE special operation teams of Anantapur district police busted a well-organised network of rowdy sheeters-cum-hired killers of Bengaluru city having connection with fake Indian currency note (FICN) manufactures based out of Bellary and Anantapur, according to a statement from the office of the director general of police (DGP) here on Monday.

The police arrested Bengaluru-based rowdy-sheets, including Jamsheed alias khan alias Jeeshan, Mubarak, Ameer Pasha and Riyaz Abdul Shaik who are procuring ganja from Shirpur of Maharashtra and small arms from illegal manufacturing hubs of Madhya Pradesh.

The special operation teams also seized illegal arms manufacturing unit owned by Rajpal Singh at Umarti of Warla tahsil in Barwani district of Madhya Pradesh and took into custody Rajpal Singh who is an arms manufacturer, dealer-cum-distributor and Nannu Suthar Adivasi, who is supplier of arms.

The police seized in all 18 weapons, including a sophisticated semi-automatic Beretta, three 9 mm pistols with 15 rounds, eleven 0.32 mm with 63 rounds, one revolver, two tapanchas with two rounds from the accused.

state. During the preliminary investigation, it is revealed that the accused were involved in gang rivalries, hired killings, extortion activities in Bengaluru city limits by using illegally procured firearms.

Director general of police K V Rajendranath Reddy complimented the 14-member police teams and announced a reward of Rs 25,000 in cash for them.

Covid mock drill today

"Such exercises would help our operational readiness, help in filling gaps if any and will consequently strengthen our public health response."

The exercise will focus on parameters such as availability of health facilities in all districts, capacity of isolation beds, oxygen-supported beds, ICU beds and ventilator-supported beds, and optimal availability of doctors, nurses, paramedics, AYUSH doctors, and other frontline workers, including ASHA and Anganwadi workers.

Referring to the surge in Covid-19 trajectory in many countries around the world, the Union Health Ministry on Saturday underlined that it was necessary that in all states and UTs requisite public health measures are put in place to meet any exigencies.

"Preparedness of Covid-19 health facilities is crucial to ensure that states and districts are in a state of readiness to meet increase in clinical care needs due to any spurt in cases," Union Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan said in a letter.

"The objective of this exercise is to ensure operational readiness of these health facilities for management of Covid-19," he said. Bhushan further said follow-up on any gap assessment shall be required to be undertaken by the additional chief secretary, principal secretary, secretary (health) and or

MD-NHM of states who will also be required to monitor the exercise personally under the overall guidance of the health minister of respective states. The Uttar Pradesh government on Monday activated the administrative machinery to test Covid preparedness and management, including conduct of mock drills at medical colleges and hospitals across the state, after two fresh cases were reported from Unnao and Agra.

Delhi government officials on Monday began physically visiting all government hospitals in the city to ascertain their preparedness to deal with any eventuality in view of the surge in Covid cases in some countries, the authorities said.

"We have started physically visiting all government hospitals. An inventory of beds, liquid medical oxygen, ventilators and other equipment is being prepared. It will be ready by Monday evening," East Delhi District Magistrate Anil Banka said. A mock drill will be conducted across all city government hospitals on Tuesday following the Centre's directions.

India saw a single-day rise of 196 new coronavirus infections, while the active cases have marginally increased to 3,428, according to Union Health Ministry data updated on Monday. The tally of Covid cases was recorded at 4.46 crore.

Videocon founder Dhoot held in ICICI loan case

NEW DELHI: The CBI on Monday arrested Videocon Group founder Venugopal Dhoot in connection with the ICICI Bank loan fraud case, officials said. The 71-year-old Dhoot was arrested from Mumbai after a brief questioning session on Monday morning, hours before former CEO and MD of the ICICI Bank Chanda Kochhar and her husband Deepak Kochhar were to be produced before a Special Court for remand hearing. The CBI is planning to file a charge sheet against the three and other suspects soon, they said. The three-day remand of Kochhars arrested on December 23 is getting over on Monday. The CBI had taken into custody Chanda Kochhar and her husband Deepak alleging that they were not cooperating with the investigation and giving evasive replies.

On one hand, there were forces of lakhs while on the other there were just 'Veer Sahibzaade' who did not budge at all," he said referring to the two martyred children of the Guru.

"Aurangzeb and his people wanted to convert the religion of Guru Gobind Singh's children with the force of a sword and that is why he decided to kill the two innocent children. Imagine that era when against the terror of Aurangzeb, against his plans to change India, Guru Gobind Singh ji stood like a mountain," he said.

Modi said in the name of history, people were being taught versions that promoted an inferiority complex among them. To move forward in the 'Amrit Kaal' and to take India to the heights of success in the future, "we have to break free from narrow views of the past", he added. "Any country with such a glorious history must be full of self-confidence and self-respect, however, concocted narratives are taught to infuse inferiority. There is a need to get free from the narrow interpretation of the past to move forward," he stressed.
