

## Employment Opportunities to Unemployed Youth in Jammu and Kashmir

The data on Employment and Unemployment in Jammu and Kashmir is available through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June of next year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS reports, the estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status in Jammu & Kashmir was 6.7% and 5.9% during 2019-20 and 2020-21, respectively, which shows that the unemployment rate in Jammu & Kashmir has declined.

Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Accordingly, the Government of India has taken various steps for generating employment in the country. The Government of India has announced Atmanirbhar Bharat package to provide stimulus to business and to mitigate the adverse impact of Covid 19. Under this package, the Government is providing fiscal incentives of more than Rupees Twenty Seven lakh crore. This package comprises of various long term schemes/programmes/policies for making the country self-reliant and to create employment opportunities.

The Atmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY) was launched with effect from 1st October, 2020 to incentivize employers for creation of new employment and restoration of

loss of employment during Covid-19 pandemic. The total number of beneficiaries under the scheme, till 28.11.2022, benefits of Rs. 7855.07 Crore have been provided to 60.13 lakhs beneficiaries under the scheme. In Jammu & Kashmir, benefits of Rs. 35.39 Crore have been provided to 19.34 lakhs beneficiaries under the scheme till 28.11.2022.

Government is implementing Prime Minister Street Vendor's Atma Nirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi Scheme) since June 01, 2020 to facilitate collateral free working capital loan to street vendors to restart their businesses, which were adversely impacted during the Covid-19 pandemic. As on 02.12.2022, 37.68 lakh loans amounting to Rs.4,378 Crore have been disbursed under the scheme. In Jammu & Kashmir, 17.95 thousands loans have been disbursed under the scheme as on 02.12.2022. The Government of India is encouraging various projects involving substantial investment and public expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Deen Dayal Antodaya

Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) etc. for employment generation. Pradhan Mantri Mauda Yojana (PMMY) was launched by the Government for facilitating self-employment. Under PMMY, collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to micro/small business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities. Upto 25.11.2022, an amount of Rs.15.56 lakh crore was disbursed in 37.76 crore loan accounts sanctioned under the scheme. In Jammu & Kashmir, an amount of Rs. 4,209.69 crore was disbursed in 1.89 lakh loan accounts sanctioned during 2022-23 (till 25.11.2022) under the scheme. The Production Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes is being implemented by the Government with an outlay of Rs. 1.97 lakh crore, for a period of 5 years starting from 2021-22 which has potential for creating 60 lakh new jobs.

All these initiatives are expected to collectively generate employment in the medium to long term through multiplier-effects. PM Gati Shakti is a transformative approach for economic growth and sustainable development. The approach is driven by seven engines, namely, Roads, Railways, Airports, Ports, Mass Transport, Waterways and Logistics Infrastructure.

## Ministry of Education organizes one-day Consultation Workshop on Reimagining Vocational Education and Career Guidance for School Students

Secretary, Department of School Education and Literacy, Shri Sanjay Kumar, chaired the consultation workshop and the appropriate Framework for higher education institutions in a phased manner over the next decade. Trades and Courses shall be chosen based on skills gap analysis and mapping of local opportunities to make it demand driven. Concentrated efforts from all stakeholders will be required to de-stigmatize Vocational Education and make it aspirational. The National Credit Framework, currently under finalization by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship will also eliminate traditional hierarchies and silos between different areas of learning. It will help in removing complex separations between arts and sciences, between curricular and extra-curricular activities, between vocational and academic streams, etc. By providing credits for academic, extra-curricular and experiential learning, NCF will help dropouts from the formal education system to get reintegrated by aligning their practical experience with the appropriate Framework levels. The consultations were also addressed by Ms. Dhruvarakha Siram Chief of Generation Unlimited (YuWah), Youth Development and Partnerships and Mr. Terry Durian, Chief of Education, UNICEF. Various ideas related to reimagining, reinventing vocational education modules etc. were discussed at length. Importance of life skills - both vertical and horizontal, aspirational disconnect and information asymmetry in uptake of vocational education, etc. were also focus of these discussions. In the light of newly launched National Education Policy, 2020 the aim should be to empower students with skills such as cloud computing, artificial intelligence, machine learning, data analytics, robotic process automation, cybersecurity, etc.

## Health Minister Shri Rishikesh Patel regarding the current situation of Corona

A review meeting was held today at Gandhinagar Swarnim Centre regarding the current situation of Corona under the chairmanship of Health Minister Shri Rishikesh Patel. In this meeting with the top officials of the health department, instructions were given from the health minister Shri to prepare all arrangements as a precautionary measure to protect against corona in the state. Health Minister Mr. Rishikesh Patel reviewed in detail all arrangements related to corona including availability of beds, ventilators and oxygen tank arrangements, adequate quantity of medicine in PHC, CHC, civil hospital of the state. Instructions for mandatory corona testing and testing of foreign tourists were also given by the Health Minister Shri. As a result of the best Corona vaccination in the state, Gujarat is now against Corona "It is safe. At present, 2 to 3 small cases of corona are being seen in the state every day.

## An era of peace in North East since 2014, 80% decline in civilian deaths, 6000 militants surrendered; Shri Thakur AFSPA rolled back from many areas, peace accords signed; Minister

The policy focus of Government of India is 'Zero Tolerance Against Terrorism', Union Minister Shri Anurag Thakur said today. In a detailed statement to the media at his residence, on the efforts of the Government to counter terrorism, Shri Thakur said that while Government has worked on the legal front by strengthening UAPA, at the same time it has also taken steps at the enforcement level by giving National Investigation Agency a truly federal structure by introducing National Investigation Agency (Amendment) Act and the collective effect of these measures has been a weakening of the ecosystem of terrorism. Highlighting that India has raised its concerns at the highest global levels, he said that in international conferences and meetings, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has always pressed the world to unite against terror. The 90th Interpol General Assembly witnessed a participation of over 2000 foreign delegates and culminated in the announcement of 'Global Action Against Act of Terrorism', he added. "The Governments resolve against terror has been displayed time and again from Surgical Strike to Balakot Strike. The action by our armed forces has caused a significant drop in terrorist incidents in Jammu and Kashmir. Similarly, we have achieved a 94% conviction rate in terror financing cases" Shri Thakur said. The Minister spoke at length about the efforts of the Government towards creating an atmosphere of peace in North East and said that an era of peace has dawned in North Eastern region of India since 2014 when insurgency violence has seen a sharp decline of 80 percent and civilian deaths have seen an 89 percent drop. Added to this is the achievement of surrender by six thousand militants since 2014, he underlined.

The Government is committed to go beyond armed action to counter terrorism and has worked to create an atmosphere of lasting peace across the region. These peace treaties are a legacy of the achievements of the Government. Underlining this aspect, Shri Thakur listed the peace agreements signed by the Government

Bodo Accord in January 2020, Bru-Reang Agreement in January 2020, NLF-Tripura Agreement in August 2019, Karbi Anglong Agreement Sept 2021, Assam-Meghalaya Inter State Boundary Agreement in 2022. Speaking on the Armed Forces Special Powers Act, the Minister said that AFSPA roll back has been only



Minister informed the media. The Minister also delved into the rescue operations run by the Government over the years. Highlighting that rescuing Indian lives in distress are of a paramount concern for the Government and the country has been on the fore front of running rescue operations across the world, Shri Thakur listed the achievements.
