

was cut short as it started to rain, which by Amritsar standards only meant one thing, it was time for some hot chai and snacking on the side.

Le Méridien Amritsar boasts a space, Latitude, that serves as a coffee house by day and transitions into a sophisticated cocktail bar by night.

Here, in the evening, you can sample Petit Plates, portioned snacks paired with coffee, tea and even mocktails. We suggest you try the Spinach and Goat Cheese Spanakopita, Saffron and Jalapeño Arancini Cheese Balls and Chicken Tikka Tartlet.

Still full from lunch and then snacking, we decided to skip dinner and took an early start the next day. After the property's signature breakfast buffet,

we headed to the Jallianwala Bagh, a living testimony of the Indian Independence struggle. We then paid our respects at the Golden Temple, which is located within the same vicinity as the historic garden. There are also multiple shops and complexes around this area where you can shop for Punjabi jutti, hand embroidered phulkari dupattas and also the city's beloved papad and wadiyan. Later, we

visited The Partition Museum, which preserves memorabilia and documents from the India-Pakistan partition and it is definitely a must-visit. Our tour ended with a small pit stop at SG Thakur Singh Art Gallery.

We headed back to the property for lunch at Asian Bistro, a Pan-Asian restaurant that debuts teppanyaki in the city. While the space offers robust delicacies ranging from Penang Curry with Jasmine Rice, Golden Garlic Asian Green **Dumplings with Water Chest**nut to Pad Thai Noodles, it is the hand-drawn wall art and the overall design aesthetic that stands out.

One thing we particularly remember is the multi-coloured horse, placed right at the entrance and how beautifully it symbolises the triumphant, confident yet noble and spirited elements of this city.

Domestic air pax traffic volume grows around 25% in 2023

Latest data from DGCA reveals that IndiGo holds the lion's share in market share by flying 5.19 crore passengers

AVIATION watchdog Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) said recently that India's domestic air passenger traffic volume surged around 25 per cent so far this year as compared to last year.

According to data released by the DGCA, the number of passengers carried by domestic airlines from January to July this year stood at 881.94

lakh as against 669.54 lakh during the corresponding period of the previous year, registering annual growth of 31.72 per cent and monthly growth of 24.68 per cent.

The data showed that during July 2023, a total of 349 passenger-related complaints were received by the scheduled domestic airlines. The number of complaints per 10,000 passengers carried for the month of July 2023 was 0.29 per cent. The major reasons for complaints were flight problems. Airlines have received a total of 349 complaints, out of which 341

have been addressed, the data said. Notably, from January to July this year, budget airline IndiGo secured 59 per cent market share by flying 519.91 lakh passengers, while Tata Group owned Air India carried 81.37 lakh passengers, with a market share of 9.2 per cent.

Vistara, a joint venture between Tata Sons and Singapore Airlines, flew 76.55 lakh passengers, securing an 8.7 per cent market share.

AirAsia India, now known as AIX Connect, carried 66.79 lakh passengers, making up 7.6 per cent of the total traffic, the data

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In the January-July period, IndiGo carried 519.91 lakh passengers and secured 59 per cent market share, and Air India carried 81.37 lakh passengers

stated. Asaka Air, which marked its one-year anniversary on the seventh of the

month, flew 35.22 lakh passengers and claimed a five per cent market share, the data showed.

SpiceJet transported 51.20 lakh passengers from January to July this year, capturing 5.8 per cent of the market. Impressively, SpiceJet achieved the highest load factor at 88.9 per cent in July, compared to June. IndiGo also excelled in punctuality, with 86.8 per cent of its flights departing or arriving on time at major airports such as Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, and Hyderabad.
