# STOLEN MOBILES WORTH 1.08 CR RECOVERED

THE police have recovered 600 phones worth Rs 1.08 crore that were stolen or lost in the last two months. So far, the district police have recovered 1,630 mobile phones worth Rs 4.01 crore in seven phases, in the district. SP P Parameshwar Reddy told the reporters on Thurs-

day that Mobile Hunt app, introduced by the police department in February this year, coupled with CEIR (Central Equipment Identity Register) portal have proved immensely useful to the police in recovering stolen mo-

bile phones. Mobile phones theft is more in places like Tirupati, world famous pilgrim centre, compared to other places, and it will be more at crowded places like bus stand and railway stations.

He asked the people, who lost their mobiles, to complain immediately on 'Mobile Hunt' WhatsApp number 94906 17873, by providing all the required details of the phone. Upon receiving the complaint, police will im-

mediately block the mobile phone number, lost or stolen, to avoid misuse of the information in the mobile and also to stop its usage. SP Parameshwar Reddy lauded the cybercrime unit led by Cyber cell CI O Ramachandra Reddy and his staff for recovering the stolen mobile phones within a short period. He informed that police will conduct awareness programmes on Mobile Hunt and CEIR portal. On this occasion, SP Parameshwar Reddy cautioned the people against various forms of online frauds, which have increased manifold. He requested the public not to get lured by attractive offers, incentives or high returns. ASPs Venkat Rao and Vimala Kumari, Cyber cell CI O Ramachandra Reddy, cyber cells staff were present.

# YSRCP, TDP must clarify their stand over CAA: CPM

CPM senior leader and its politburo member BV Raghavulu demanded YSRCP and TDP to specify their opinion on the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) proposed by BJP-led NDA government. The CPM leader, who came to Nellore to participate in the party meeting, addressing the media on Thursday, recalled that earlier both the parties supported the NDA government during the introduction of CAA Bill in the Parliament, despite other Opposition parties declining such bill. Pointing out that both YSRCP and TDP are making hue and cry over the uplifting of living standards of Minorities in AP, he questioned as to why they extended support to the NDA

government when the CAA Bill was introduced in the Parliament. Recalling Union Home Minister Amit Shah's statement in Calcutta over his party commitment in implementing CAA on Wednesday, Raghavulu opined that this type of Bill, if comes into existence, will destroy the lives of Muslim Minorities in the country. He demanded if YSRCP and TDP are really wants Minorities' welfare, they should demand the Central government to roll back CAA or tender apology to the public. The CPM leader found fault with the YSRCP of conducting cast survey and described it as mere eye wash tactics and bogus. He suggested the ruling party to demand the NDA government to conduct caste census along with population census.

# TDP leader complains to CEO against bogus voters

Party Chandragiri Assembly constituency candidate P Nani seeks thorough enquiry on the applications received and approved during State-wide special summary revision

TDP Chittoor Parliament constituency in-charge and party candidate for Chandragiri Assembly constituency Pulivarthy Nani met Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Mukesh Kumar Meena in Amaravati to complain about bogus voters in Chandragiri Assembly constituency voters list. Accompanied by party senior leaders including K Atchannaidu, he submitted a complaint to the CEO at his office in Amaravathi on Thursday. Alleging large scale irregularities in the voter list of Chandragiri constituency,

the TDP leader, in his representation sought an enquiry into the irregularities in the inclusion of new voters and also deletion of voters from list. He alleged that bowing to the pressures from the ruling party leaders, the officials, more so booth-level officers (BLOs) failed to check enrollment of bogus voters and also removal of ineligible voters from the list. Suspecting foul play in the State-wide special summary revision (SSR) which is going on, Nani alleged that at the behest of ruling party leaders, the poll officials indulged in irregularities in approving the applications including Form 6 (inclusion

of new voters), Form 7 (deletion of ineligible voters) and in Form 8 (for shifting of residence or for any correction in the entries in the voters list), which resulted in large number of bogus or ineligible voter list of Chandragiri constituency. He stressed on a thorough enquiry on the applications received and approved during the SSR. In a release here on Thursday, Nani said the CEO gave a patient hearing on the complaint and assured to look into the complaint. The CEO also said to take stern action on anyone found involved in the enrollment of bogus voters and removal of eligible voters based on false claims.
