Gujarat: Rain death toll 29; 27 from lightning alone

AHMEDABAD: The total death toll due to unseasonal rains in Gujarat reached 29 on Monday evening. According to the State Emergency Operations Centre (SEOC), out of the total deaths, 27 were caused by lightning alone. The other two deaths were from a structural collapse incident in Dahod district.

A senior SEOC official said, "Tabulation of new cases is still on and hence, district-wise figures would be updated by Tuesday." The 27 deaths from lightning strikes in a single day is more than half of the annual average number of AHMEDABAD: The total

In an incident in Mehsana, a youth seated in an autorickshaw parked under a tree died when the tree collapsed after being hit by a lightning bolt. The weather was particularly stormy on Sunday," said a senior fire services official in Ahmedabad.
