Minister of State for Communications, Sh. Devusinh Chauhan visited the stall and appreciated the systems and urged the Department to scale up the systems for bettering the lives of Pensioners.

Secretary, DOT understood the breadth of the systems and appreciated the systems.

Secretary, DARPG was given a demo of the SAMPANN and thereafter acknowledged that the system has been discharging pension directly to pensioners.

Several other senior officers of the GoI and TSPs and officials of several TSPs visited the stall. The stall facilitated submission of Life Certificates using Face Authentication.

Ex-Member (Services) and Ex-CMD, BSNL submitted their Life Certificate using the Face Authentication Jeevan Praman App.

At the stall, QR codes have been displayed for accessing LF Handbook for decentralized licenses, Simplified Financial Compliance of License Agreements for TSPs and CGCA website Link for revenue related orders. At the stall QR code has been displayed for submission of feedback by Telecom Licensees visiting the Stall.

SARAS, which was launched by the DOT on 15.01.2021 is a portal for the licensees for ease of compliance of financial conditions of license agreements. Through SARAS portal, Licensees are able to avail facility to make online payments for LF, SUC, Spectrum Auction payments and CAF/EMR penalty, Testing Fees and other penalties. SARAS has led to Fully Digital and Paperless Submission of Statement of Revenue and License Fee on Quarterly Basis and Audited Document and Annual Financial document on Annual Basis.

It enables Online Submission of Deduction document and Access to Online Assessment and demand notices for LD and SUC, demand notices for other dues. It acts as a Single Window for issuance of No Dues Certificate and thus exit management. Already 2659 licensees are on boarded on SARAS.

Through SARAS revenue around Rs two lakh crore has already been collected.

SAMPANN - System for

Accounting and Management of Pension' project is a seamless online pension processing and payment system for Department of Telecom communications pensioners. It was dedicated to the nation by the Honorable Prime Minister on 29th December 2018.

More than Four Lakh pensioners of DOT/BSNL/MTNL are currently being serviced by the system. India via SAMPANN which has improved the service delivery to pensioners by providing a single window setup ensuring the following benefits:

Timely settlement of pension cases  
Provision of e-Pension Payment Order  
Login for each pensioner enables access to key information like payment history

Online submission of grievances and timely SMS alerts  
An amount of approx. Rs. 1,239 crore is being disbursed as monthly pension via SAMPANN.

Also, till September 2023, SAMPANN has resulted in savings of approx. Rs 44 crore and would accrue an annual recurring savings of Rs 40 Crore per annum for the Government.

## Making business out of education is antithetical to our societal cause, cautions Vice-President

### Let us not drain our brains and foreign-exchange to foreign locations- VP

The Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankar today emphasized the need of taking education as a service to the nation and urged everyone to 'give back whatever you take from it'. Leveraging Education for the purpose of making commerce and business is antithetical to the societal cause and the sublimity, virtuosity of our civilization', he added. Describing quality education as the most impactful transformational mechanism that improves any society, the Vice-President cautioned against draining of our brains and our foreign exchange to foreign locations. Addressing the 3rd Convocation Ceremony of the Royal Assam Global University in Guwahati today, the Vice-President described Convocation as the 'reward of training imparted by your teachers, fruitifying hopes and aspirations of the family'. He further advised the students to refrain from engaging in activities that could bring disrepute to their teachers and parents. Praising the National Education Policy, the Vice-President underlined that implementation of this policy has led to the

integration of knowledge and skills by allowing the students to pursue simultaneous courses. Commending the recent successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 on the south pole of the moon, after an unsuccessful attempt in 2019, the Vice-President underscored that 'Failure is a necessary step in success'. Drawing an analogy, he compared failure to a glass of water that can be viewed as either half-filled or half-empty. The Vice-President also underlined the pivotal role played by alumni contributions and patronage in nurturing the world's most prestigious universities. Additionally, he urged the students to establish a lasting connection with their institution and consistently contribute to its resources for the betterment of education. Emphasizing the need to consume natural resources based on necessity rather than fiscal affordability, Shri Dhankar called for the optimal utilization of these resources. While conferring degrees and medals, the Vice-President noted with happiness that more than 'two-third of them were girls'.



He referred to this as a reflection of the 'changing profile' of the nation. Shri Dhankar also highlighted that the passing of the Women Reservation Bill in the Parliament was a historic step for the largest democracy on the planet. During the one-day tour, the Vice-President earlier visited the Cotton University in Guwahati and interacted with the students and faculty

members. Later in the evening, he attended the felicitation program organized by the members of the Brihatar Guwahati Marwari Samaj in Guwahati. Shri Gulab Chand Kataria, the Governor of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, the Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Ranaj Pegu, Minister of Education, Government of Assam, Ms.

Nanadita Gorlosa, Minister of Power, Sports & Youth Welfare, Cooperation and Indigenous Tribal Faith and Culture, Government of Assam, Shri Paban Kumar Borthakur, Chief Secretary of Assam, Dr. Ashok Kumar Pansari, Chancellor, Royal Assam Global University, faculty members and other dignitaries were present at the event.

## Woman who forced man to lick her shoes arrested

RAJKOT: The young businessman in Morbi, who had allegedly forced her former sales manager to lick her shoes last week, was arrested along with her brother and a business partner after they surrendered on Monday. Vibhuti Sitapara alias Ranibha (26), her brother Om (21), and business partner Raj Padshah (23), who were accused of the case, were following a complaint lodged by her former

employee Nilesh Dalsaniya. On November 22, they had lashed him with a belt and allegedly forced him to lick her footwear for demanding his pending salary of 18 days. The trio surrendered after their anticipatory bail applications were rejected by a local court.

On Sunday, the police arrested DD Rabani alias Mayur Kalotra on Sunday while the accused Pandshit is yet to be arrested.

Dalsaniya was fired from the job last month over some performance issues. On November 22 evening, he approached Patel to ask for the pending salary of 18 days. He was accompanied by his elder brother Mehul and friend Bhavesh Makwana.

He told police that Rabani and Raj Patel slapped them and five people including Vibhuti took him to the company's terrace where he was lashed with a belt. They also hurled casteist slurs at him.

Dalsaniya alleged that Vibhuti also forced him to lick her shoes and threatened to

kill him if he was spotted near Ravapur Chowki where the factory is located.

A businesswoman, Vibhuti alias Ranibha Patel, promoter of a ceramic company in Morbi, allegedly forced a sacked sales manager, Nilesh Dalsaniya, to lick her boots while others lashed him. The victim had called and messaged Patel to ask for his unpaid salary. Patel and others were booked under the Prevention of Atrocities Act as Dalsaniya is a Dalit. The accused made a video of the incident and forced Dalsaniya to apologize.

## Gujarat: Rain death toll 29; 27 from lightning alone

AHMEDABAD: The total death toll due to unseasonal rains in Gujarat reached 29 on Monday evening. According to the State Emergency Operations Centre (SEOC), out of the total deaths, 27 were caused by lightning alone. The other two deaths were from a structural collapse incident in Dahod district.

A senior SEOC official said, "Tabulation of new cases is still on and hence, district-wise figures would be updated by Tuesday."

The 27 deaths from lightning strikes in a single day is more than half of the annual average number of

such deaths across the state. From 2017 to 2021, Gujarat recorded an average 49 deaths annually from lightning strikes, according to National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) reports.

Among the deaths, Dahod recorded the highest at four, followed by three deaths each in Banaskantha and Bhachar, and two in Tapi. Eleven districts recorded one death each. Of these, two persons were reported dead in the same incident in Ambetha of Bhachar district's Hansot taluka.

Relief and rescue operations in the state said that while

the single-day deaths are high, they are also one of the highest among states that experienced the impact of Sunday's Western Disturbance. "If one observes the pattern, the majority of the deaths have occurred when a person was out during the thunderstorms - in the open or was taking shelter under a tree. In an incident in Mehansa, a youth seated in an autorickshaw parked under a tree died when the tree collapsed after being hit by a lightning bolt. The weather was particularly stormy on Sunday," said a senior fire services official in Ahmedabad.
