

Historic temple premises turn into a dumping yard

Abandoned by villagers 3 decades ago after a woman fell into well

THE premises of the historic Mahadev temple at Karatagi in Koppal district have turned into a garbage dumping yard. Tourists visited the temple, which also has a well of historic importance, till about three decades ago.

According to some local residents, the temple was a tourist spot but footfalls dipped after the 1990s. History buffs are urging the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) to clean up the place and develop it as a tourist spot so that many students and tourists can visit and also acquaint themselves with the history of the region.

Pundalik Kalliganur, a history buff, said, "We have visited the place which is spread across three acres of land. It is home to memorial stones called Veeragallu which tell stories of the then Nayakas who fought against enemies to save the temple. There is a gun installed on the memorial stone as a tribute to the Nayakas which shows that they were martyred by enemies who used guns. This is our first impression after watching the memorial stone. There is a need to carry out a detailed study and research here".

A Karatagi resident said, "We had seen the well on the premises brimming with water till three decades ago. We have heard from our elders that an old woman fell into the well, following which people stopped using its water. As a result, it was abandoned by the villagers due to which it has turned into a garbage dumping yard. We request the authorities to develop the place as a tourist spot to not only attract tourists but

also create employment and business opportunities for the locals."

When contacted, an official from the Koppal district administration said this comes under the purview of the ASI. Officials at the Dharwad office of the ASI did not respond to calls.

Accident or murder? 1 killed, two injured

AN auto driver was killed on the spot and two of his friends seriously injured after a tipper rammed the autorickshaw in which the three travelling at Are Angadi village near Honnavar late Tuesday night. The two injured have been identified as Jannu and Vasanth Naik, with whom Vinayak Narayan Bhat, the person who was driving the tipper had an argument over a financial matter. After the verbal duel, the duo met Lobo, the auto driver and were returning home in his auto. With a motive to kill the two, Bhat allegedly rammed a tipper into the three-wheeler. While Lobo died on the spot, the two passengers sustained serious injuries and were rushed to a hospital where they are undergoing treatment. The accused is at large and the police have launched a manhunt to nab him. Honnavar police have registered a complaint and are investigating.
