Man shot at in Dera Bassi parking: Police say US-based gangster may be involved in it

JAGDEEP SINGH DEEP MOHALI, DECEMBER 10

MOHALI POLICE on Saturday said they had arrested one man who was involved in allegedly opening fire in a parking lot in Dera Bassi three days ago (December 6) and claimed that they were probing links of a US-based gangster in the incident.

On the night of December 6, three men had allegedly opened fire in a parking of Balmiki Basti area in Dera Bassi, targeting one Sahil, who managed to escape unhurt in the in-

Subsequently on the basis of a complaint filed by Sahil, the police lodged an FIR and launched investigations, during the course of which they figured that the complainant had an old enmity with US-based gangster Lala Benipal.

A police officer said that

Benipal, who hails from Mehandpur village near Dera Bassi, planned the shootout and his brother Harvinder Singh is a suspect in the case. Police had registered an attempt to murder case against three unidentified persons on December 6.

Sahil, in his complaint, had told the police that he was in the parking area after having attended a marriage party when three unknown men had opened fire at him.

The police officer told The Indian Express that they so far believe that Sahil had an enmity with Lala Benipal, who had planned the incident and Harvinder Singh and his accomplices had carried out the shoot-

No info about arrest of accused in Gogamedi murder case: UT Police

Shri Rashtriya Rajput Karni Sena president Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi was shot dead by 3 men at his home in Jaipur

HOURS AFTER three men were apprehended in connection with the murder of Shri Rashtriya Rajput Karni Sena president Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi from Chandigarh, the UT police claimed on Sunday they had no information about where the accused were nabbed

However, sources said the joint team of Rajasthan Police and Delhi Police apprehended three men – Rohit Rathore, Nitin Fauji and Udham – after conducting a raid at a guest house in Sector 24 in Chandigarh on Sunday evening. They also nabbed their associate identified as Udham.

"The assailants had checked in at Kamal Palace around 7.40 pm. They submitted photocopies of their Aadhaar cards and paid Rs 900 for a room for one day," said a source.

"Around 8 pm, a team, whose members were in plain clothes and uniforms, came and asked the receptionist about the two people wanted in a murder case. The team members showed photographs of the suspects to the hotel manager, Bhim Sen, who also arrived at the hotel. Later, the police team overpowered them," added the

PGI 'HONOUR KILLING' CASE

Woman injected with unknown substance dies, cops add murder charges

Chandigarh: Harmeet Kaur, 24, wife of Gurvinder Singh and resident of Rajpura, Patiala, who was admitted to PGIMER on November 7 after a referral from an outside hospital in a critical condition, breathed her last at 7:00 pm on Sunday.

Harmeet was admitted to the gynecology ward of the Nehru Hospital, PGIMER, when an unidentified woman posing as a nurse injected an unknown substance into the patient on the night of November 15 in an alleged case of honour killing.

According to a statement issued by PGI on Sunday night, Harmeet, when referred to the institute, already had acute kidney injury, absent urine output, and multi-organ dysfunction, resultant of complications of delivery on November 4, that is excessive bleeding (PPH) and severe infection (puerperal sepsis). She had already received dialysis before a referral to PGI.

On arrival in PGIMER, the patient's bleeding was controlled. Later, she was shifted to the Advanced Trauma Centre ICU on November 16 due to a poor prognosis, which may be a consequence of the unknown substance injected into her through a fraudulent attempt which aggravated the already critical condition. Harmeet was put on life support and doctors were monitoring the patient. However, despite best efforts by the treating team, she could not be resuscitated and died

at 7 pm on Sunday. Her mortal remains have been shifted to the mortuary here in PGI. The body will be handed over to the next of kin after completing the medico-legal formalities by the police. The police added murder charges under Section 302 of the IPC to the FIR against four people, including a woman paramedic, Japreet Kaur, and brother of the victim, Jasmeet Singh. Two other accused are Buta Singh and Mandeep Singh. They were lodged in Model Burail Jail. A case was registered at Sector 11 police
