

# Man shot at in Dera Bassi parking: Police say US-based gangster may be involved in it

MOHALI POLICE on Saturday said they had arrested one man who was involved in allegedly opening fire in a parking lot in Dera Bassi three days ago (December 6) and claimed that they were probing links of a US-based gangster in the incident.

On the night of December 6, three men had allegedly opened fire in a parking of Balmiki Basti area in Dera Bassi, targeting one Sahil, who managed to escape unhurt in the incident.

Subsequently on the basis of a complaint filed by Sahil, the police lodged an FIR and launched investigations, during the course of which they figured that the complainant had an old enmity with US-based gangster Lala Benipal.

A police officer said that

Benipal, who hails from Mehandpur village near Dera Bassi, planned the shootout and his brother Harvinder Singh is a suspect in the case. Police had registered an attempt to murder case against three unidentified persons on December 6.

Sahil, in his complaint, had told the police that he was in the parking area after having attended a marriage party when three unknown men had opened fire at him.

The police officer told The Indian Express that they so far believe that Sahil had an enmity with Lala Benipal, who had planned the incident and Harvinder Singh and his accomplices had carried out the shooting.

Contacted, Dera Bassi Station House Officer (SHO), Sub-Inspector Ajitesh Kaushal, said that their investigations were at the initial stage and he cannot comment on the same at this stage.

# No info about arrest of accused in Gogamedi murder case: UT Police

Shri Rashtriya Rajput Karni Sena president Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi was shot dead by 3 men at his home in Jaipur

HOURS AFTER three men were apprehended in connection with the murder of Shri Rashtriya Rajput Karni Sena president Sukhdev Singh Gogamedi from Chandigarh, the UT police claimed on Sunday they had no information about where the accused were nabbed from.

However, sources said the joint team of Rajasthan Police and Delhi Police apprehended three men – Rohit Rathore, Nitin Fauji and Udhm – after conducting a raid at a guest house in Sector 24 in Chandigarh on Sunday evening. They also nabbed their associate identified as Udhm.

“The assailants had checked in at Kamal Palace around 7.40 pm. They submitted photocopies of their Aadhaar cards and paid Rs 900 for a room for one day,” said a source.

“Around 8 pm, a team, whose members were in plain clothes and uniforms, came and asked the receptionist about the two people wanted in a murder case. The team members showed photographs of the suspects to the hotel manager, Bhim Sen, who also arrived at the hotel. Later, the police team overpowered them,” added the source.

Sen told *The Indian Express*

the police team members checked the recording of CCTV cameras after nabbing the two suspects. “Later, we found that the footage of the camera of the time when the suspects had entered our hotel was missing. Three men had arrived in an autorickshaw to our hotel. They demanded a room and told our staff that they need a room for one night. They told our staff members that they would go to night clubs in the night,” he said.

“This morning, a team of Chandigarh police came to inquiring about what had happened last night here. We told them about the incident last night. We also told the Chandigarh police that the team members, who had apprehended the suspects, had told us not to disclose the episode to anyone. The Aadhaar card copies which were submitted by the suspects found of other persons,” added Sen.

Sources said that assailants were coming from Manali when they halted in Sector 24 Chandigarh.

Meanwhile, Inspector Malkit Singh, Station House Officer, Police Station 11, said, “We came

to know that the two assailants had stayed at a non-descript guest house Kamal Palace in Sector 24 through media reports. Ideally, Rajasthan or Delhi Police should inform us about the arrest. Initial information indicates that the assailants were in a public transport vehicle intercepted near ISBT-17, Sector 22, and the killers were subsequently arrested,” added the senior officer.

Gogamedi, 50, was shot dead by three men, including Rathore and Fauji, at his home in Jaipur on Tuesday. One of the gunmen was subsequently killed in retaliatory firing.

## Why Delhi Police didn't take UT Police in confidence?

An IPS rank officer posted in Chandigarh police said, “The joint team of Rajasthan and Delhi Police could have apprehended the shooters in a ‘hot pursuit without conducting a raid at the specific location. In such a situation, the police team chasing the criminals is not obligated to inform the local police about the arrest. Initial information indicates the movements of the suspects being tracked continuously by the police team for a long time. Suspects were changing their locations frequently. As their location turned stable and they entered the hotel, the police team apprehended them. We can not term it a ‘raid.’”

# Six kidnap Kharar man from busy market, rob him of ₹2 lakh

SIX MEN reportedly committed a daredevil robbery after kidnapping a Kharar resident from a busy market in Mohali's Sector 70 and robbing him of Rs 2 lakh. Police registered a case Sunday and launched an investigation.

The complainant Harpreet Singh, a resident of NRI Enclave, Jhuggian road, Kharar stated to the police that he had gone to

Sector 70 in connection with his business and while he was present at Jubilee Heights, he saw a Haryana registration number cab stopped and one of the man identified as Sherry, approached him. “There were around three other men sitting in the car, then two more men came there on a bike and snatched Rs 2 lakh from me. They forcibly put me in the car and assaulted me. They also took my iPhone and attacked me with a knife. Later they abandoned me near Mundi Kharar,”

the complainant alleged. Acting on the complaint, police registered a case under sections 363 (kidnapping), 395 (dacoity), 397 (robbery or dacoity, with attempt to cause death or grievous hurt), 398 (attempt to commit robbery or dacoity when armed with deadly weapon), 506 (criminal intimidation) and 120-B (criminal conspiracy) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) at Mattaur police station against Sherry and his five unidentified accomplices.

# Woman injected with unknown substance dies, cops add murder charges

*Chandigarh:* Harmeet Kaur, 24, wife of Gurvinder Singh and resident of Rajpura, Patiala, who was admitted to PGIMER on November 7 after a referral from an outside hospital in a critical condition, breathed her last at 7:00 pm on Sunday.

Harmeet was admitted to the gynecology ward of the Nehru Hospital, PGIMER, when an unidentified woman posing as a nurse injected an unknown substance into the patient on the night of November 15 in an alleged case of honour killing.

According to a statement issued by PGI on Sunday night, Harmeet, when referred to the institute, already had acute kidney injury, absent urine output, and multi-organ dysfunction, resultant of complications of delivery on November 4, that is excessive bleeding (PPH) and severe infection (puerperal sepsis). She had already received dialysis before a referral to PGI.

On arrival in PGIMER, the patient's bleeding was controlled.

Later, she was shifted to the Advanced Trauma Centre ICU on November 16 due to a poor prognosis, which may be a consequence of the unknown substance injected into her through a fraudulent attempt which aggravated the already critical condition. Harmeet was put on life support and doctors were monitoring the patient. However, despite best efforts by the treating team, she could not be resuscitated and died at 7 pm on Sunday.

Her mortal remains have been shifted to the mortuary here in PGI. The body will be handed over to the next of kin after completing the medico-legal formalities by the police. The police added murder charges under Section 302 of the IPC to the FIR against four people, including a woman paramedic, Japreet Kaur, and brother of the victim, Jasmeet Singh. Two other accused are Buta Singh and Mandeep Singh. They were lodged in Model Burali Jail. A case was registered at Sector 11 police station.

# Balongi murder: Accused has criminal past, say police

*Mohali:* The accused, Paras, who murdered a fast food joint owner at Balongi on Friday has a criminal past and was booked in a drug smuggling and a theft case in Solan district of Himachal Pradesh, police said.

Joginder Singh Rana, 34, who ran a fast food shop in the name of Mr Grill at Balongi, was murdered by Paras over a dispute relating to an electric stove and an adaptor. After murdering Rana, Paras fled to Baddi in HP from where he went to Kasol to find a hideout to evade his arrest.

Kharar-1 Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Karan Sandhu told The Indian Express that the accused has a criminal background and after committing the crime, he fled to HP on his bike.

Rana's brother Mohit stated to the police in his complaint that his brother had told him in the past that Paras was bothering him and also took away his induction stove and an adaptor charger and despite several requests, Paras did not return his brother's articles.

According to Mohit, around 3 pm on December 7, his brother had gone to Sai Homes, a paying guest house at Balongi to bring his induction and adaptor from Paras. After that, Rana's phone was switched off. The CCTV footage in the PG showed that Paras was taking a bag on a bike. Later, it was found that Paras was taking away Rana's body to dispose of it.

# 2 held in drug peddling cases

*Chandigarh:* Police have arrested a 23-year-old engineer, who recently passed out from Jammu University, for alleged drug peddling. As much as 236 gm of charas was recovered from his possession.

Police said that the suspect identified as Aman Thakur has been taking coaching for UPSC exams and staying as a paying guest in Sector 22. Police said that the accused is a native of district Chamba. He was arrested by a team of District Crime Cell near Sector 22.

Police said that during interrogation, Thakur disclosed that he has been selling drugs across the Tricity for the last six months. He used to purchase the contraband from Kullu, Himachal Pradesh. A case was registered at Sector 17 police station.

Meanwhile, in another drug peddling case, the crime branch has arrested a close associate of gangster Bhuppi Rana who is lodged in Bathinda Jail. The suspect was identified as Dheeraj Sharma and 30 gm heroin was recovered from him.
