MONEY LAUNDERING CASE

ED conducts fresh searches against Chandigarh-based pharma company

Raids at about a dozen locations in Punjab and Delhi-NCR

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate on Friday conducted fresh searches at about a dozen locations in Delhi-NCR and Punjab as part of a money laundering investigation against Chandigarh-based pharmaceutical company Parabolic Drugs and its promoters linked to an alleged bank fraud, official sources said.

The first round of searches in this case were carried out in October.

Some documents and electronic gadgets were recovered by the agency officials during the searches, they said.

The central agency had earlier arrested Parabolic Drugs promoters Vineet Gupta (54) and Pranav Gupta (56), who are also the co-founders of the Sonapat-based Ashoka University, and CA Surjeet Kumar Bansal (74) under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

The Punjab and Haryana High Court had recently ordered their release from judicial custody.

The Guptas stepped down from their posts at the Ashoka University in 2022 after the Central Bureau of Investigation registered a case against them

and the company in 2021 for their alleged involvement in a bank loan fraud of Rs 1,626 crore.

The ED filed a money laundering case against them in January last year.

The agency told the court in October that the two arrested directors of the company were "actively involved in defrauding the banks by availing loans or financial facilities based upon forged and fabricated documents".

It alleged that the two "intentionally changed colour of the loan funds from liabilities to assets and layered, diverted and siphoned off the said funds by way of circuitous transactions using the platform of their group companies that were under their control".

The agency said the two availed services of "shell companies" and "illegally inflated the value of primary security against which drawings were allowed by the bank".

"Under their command and control, Parabolic Drugs Ltd raised fake and unrelated goods invoices and illegally received entries from shell companies," the agency claimed.

It said Bansal, through his chartered accountancy firm S K Bansal and Company, issued "false certificates to Parabolic Drugs Ltd. which were used for availing loans from consortium of banks." Their illegal activities and abuse of loan funds caused a wrongful loss of Rs 1,626.7 crore to the Central Bank of India and other consortium banks, according to the CBI FIR, the ED told the court while seeking the remand of the three.

Bathinda education officers issued show cause notices for ordering school closure

DC says not consulted, seeks report within 2 days; Opp leaders attack govt

THE BATHINDA deputy commissioner (DC) Friday issued show cause notices to two district education officers for ordering six schools in Maur to make stay arrangements for the security staff of Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann ahead of his visit to the sub-division.

DEO (elementary) Shivpal Goyal and DEO (secondary) Bhopinder Kaur had on Thursday (December 14) issued the written order ahead of a rally on December 17 in Maur, which will be addressed by Mann and party national convener and Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal.

DC Showkat Ahmad Parray confirmed that the order has been withdrawn.

"They issued the order at their

own level to close the schools after getting a call from some police officer. I have issued show-cause notices to both DEOs," said Parray.

Issuing the show cause notice, Parray said, "issuing such an order amounts to gross negligence in duty and highly irresponsible act. You are directed to reply...within two days".

Earlier, Goyal and Kaur had written to the head teachers and principals of six schools -- Government Primary School (GPS), SD Government High School, SD GPS (all Maur Mandi), Government Senior Secondary School (CSSS) Maur Kalan, GSSS, Maur Khurd, and GSSS, Maur Mandi (Girls) -- to announce a holiday on Saturday, spruce up the campus, and ensure power backup and clean water. The order said that all the schools need to be vacated from December 15

to December 17 and added that the security staff of the CM would arrive there Friday evening. It said that head teachers have to stay in schools till December 17 evening to ensure proper arrangements.

The state education department, however, has scheduled a mega Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) for all schools in Punjab on Saturday.

Parray said the DEOs had not consulted him before issuing the order. He said the alternate security arrangements for stay of CM's security will be made. "The schools will hold the PTM as scheduled," he added.

DEO Goyal said he will reply to the notice and "explain why we had issued the order and on whose asking; we did not do it on our own". DEO Kaur declined to comment on the matter.

Meanwhile, Vikram Dev, pres-

ident, Democratic Teachers Front (DTF), questioned the "selective" action against the DEOs.

"Why are DEOs being made scapegoats? Despite repeated assurances by CM that teachers will not do any non-teaching work, they are being forced to work for political programmes. Why this selective action?," asked Dev.

Senior SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia in a post on X wrote: "On one hand, CM saab does dramas by getting photos clicked with children and on the other hand, he orders holidays in schools for his rally. Is this the Delhi model?"

Congress leader and former education minister Pargat Singh too accused government of "issuing dictatorial orders to harm children's education and misusing teachers/schools for political rallies".

19,000 schools, 20 lakh parents: Punjab set to hold mega PTM today

PUNJAB CHIEF Minister Bhagwant Mann Friday called for maximum participation in the mega parent-teacher meeting (PTM) on Saturday, in which the education department is expecting 20 lakh parents to take part.

The school education department will hold the PTM at 19,109 government primary schools and upper primary schools from 10 am to 3:30 pm on Saturday, officials said.

Parents must attend the meeting so that they can get information on their wards' performance and also give suggestions on improvement in our education system, the chief minister said.

The parents will also be pro-

vided information on the facilities in the school premises of their wards, he said.

Mann said the Punjab government is committed to raising the standard of all government schools in the state and restoring their glory.

The school education department said it is expecting the participation of 20 lakh parents in the mega PTM.

Education Minister Harjot Bains said during the PTMs across the schools, teachers, students and their parents, and the school management committees will sit together and discuss ways to improve the education system.

He said that exhibitions showcasing the accomplishments of these government schools will be the centre of attraction of this programme.

Ex-constable, who claims to be tallest Sikh in world, held with 500 gm heroin

Chandigarh: Jagdeep Singh, a former Punjab Police constable who got into limelight with his entry into reality TV show America's Got Talent, was among three arrested with 500 grams of heroin, police said on Friday.

Heroin was recovered from Singh's SUV in Tarn Taran district, a senior police official said.

Jagdeep alias Deep Singh and two others were arrested by the state special operation cell of the Punjab Police, the official said. Hailing from Amritsar, Singh is said to be the tallest Sikh in the world at 7 feet 6 inches. He was part of the Bir Khalsa group which performed daredevil acts and 'gatka'.

Singh was produced before a local court which sent him to a five-day police remand, police said. Police said they will investigate the whole nexus involved in the drug smuggling.
