Haryana to soon have own state song

Washout in LS...

It was also demanding action against BJP MP Pratap Simha, who had authorised the visitor passes for the two men who breached security to enter the House. The usual laying of papers as well as standing committee reports could not be tabled in the lower house on Thursday and Friday due to protests. The three bills that seek to replace the criminal laws were listed on the agenda on Thursday and Friday but could not be taken up for consideration.

Soon after the RS met at 11 AM, it was adjourned till 2 PM within minutes amid protest by Opposition after Chairman Jagdeep Dhankhar rejected their demand to suspend the scheduled business of the day to discuss the security breach in Parliament. Soon after the listed papers were tabled, the Chairman informed the members that he had received 23 notices under Rule 267 of the Rajya Sabha procedures for suspension of the scheduled business of the day to discuss the "serious situation arising out of breach of security" in Parliament on December 13. The Chairman did not approve the notices, and announced the Zero Hour.

At this point, the entire Opposition members erupted in protest. Aam Aadmi Party member Raghav Chadha tried to raise a point of order by making a hand gesture. Dhankar objected to the gesture, and said, "Mr Chadha, you don't have to do like this (hand gesture) to raise a point of order...use your tongue...don't do it." "... you were convicted, you were sentenced by this House," the Chairman said to him. Chadha was earlier suspended from the Upper House, but his suspension was ended later.

At 2 PM, Opposition members were up in arms again raising the security breach issue.

Dhankhar adjourned the proceedings for the day as his repeated request for order in the house did not yield result.

The house will now reconvene on December 18. Before adjourning the house, Dhankhar asked Leader of Opposition Mallikarjun Kharge and Leader of the House Piyush Goyal, and other floor leaders to meet him in his chamber. Kharge had said the home minister of the country can give interviews on TV but is averse to giving a statement on the floor of Parliament.

"INDIA parties demand that Shri Amit Shah should give a statement in the Parliament and then it should be discussed in both the houses," he said. "It is our duty to raise our voice on this serious issue of national security, it is our parliamentary duty," Kharge also said in a post in

"What kind of justice is it to illegally suspend opposition MPs over the huge lapse in security of Parliament and its MPs," he also asked.

Woman shot...

Kajal was in touch with another person, which Devendra disliked and asked her not to talk to the man. When the order was issued, the Congress leaders alleged that it was a conspiracy to write off the scheme.

Move Czech...

The plea alleged that Gupta -- who was detained at Prague Airport on June 30 this year -- was subjected to forced consumption of beef and pork during his detention in Czech custody and was denied consular access, the right to contact his family in India, and the freedom to seek legal representation. "The petitioner seeks the appointment of legal counsel in both countries-Czech Republic and the US. He specifically requests the court to appoint an Indian advocate to represent him, underscoring the language barrier and the lack of adequate representation during the extradition trial in Prague," it added.

No Friday prayers for 10th consecutive week

SRINAGAR

The management committee of the Jamia Masjid in Nowhatta here alleged that the Jammu and Kashmir administration did not allow Friday prayers for the tenth consecutive week.

Anjuman Auqaf Jamia Masjid in a statement said the authorities once again disallowed Friday prayers at the central mosque for the 10th consecutive Friday and also put Mirwaiz-e-Kashmir Muhammad Umar Faroog, who delivers the Friday sermon there, under house detention.The Anjuman said that no reason is provided by the authorities for these restrictions and curbs.

Meanwhile, the Mirwaiz condemned the repeated closure of the mosque on Fridays and his "arbitrary onoff detention", including on Fridays. "I fail to understand why the central Jamia Masjid was being targeted again and again unless it is to cause grief to the Muslims of the valley and show them their place in Naya Kashmir," the statement said.

Nothing changed in 11 yrs, says Nirbhaya's mom

NEW DELHI

"It has been 11 years and nothing has changed. We got justice with everyone's cooperation but several cases are stuck in the lower court for 10 to 12 years," said the mother of the 23year-old paramedic student whose gang-rape and murder on December 16, 2012, had seared the na-

tion's soul. The student, who came to be known as Nirbhaya -the fearless one -- was raped and brutally assaulted inside a moving bus in south Delhi by six people, before being thrown out on the road. She died on December 29, 2012, in Singapore's Mount Elizabeth Hospital. Of the six ac-Singh Ram allegedly committed suicide in the Tihar Jail days after the trial began in the case while the juvenile was released in 2015 after

that nothing is going to change. Many cases come to us also and we can only extend our moral support to them." Badrinath Singh said, "Giving justice to one Nirbhaya will not give justice to everyone. What happened to Anjali who was dragged on New Year's Eve? During the investigation, it was found that the accused were drunk, but it

was not her fault." "When the protests were held in our daughter's case, several women took part in it with their children and faced water canon. People struggled a lot during that period. But nothing has changed," he added.

Anjali Singh, an employee of an event management allegedly firm, was dragged under a car for

kilometres on December 31 night in 2022 in Delhi before she succumbed to serious wounds while still under the car. Nirbhaya's mother said that the system should function properly. There should be change, justice should be given on time and police should also work properly, she said.

"What happened to the case in which 25-year-old Anjali was dragged for 12 kilometres? "I met her family. Her mother is not well and she was the only earning person in the family," Asha Devi said.

According to a National Crime Records Bureau report, Delhi recorded the highest number of crimes against women among the 19 metropolitan cities in India in 2022. The national capital reported 14,158 cases of crimes against women in 2022 followed by 6,176 in Mumbai and 3,924 in Bengaluru.

RHEA MOVES HIGH **COURT AGAINST CBI** LOOKOUT CIRCULAR

Rhea Chakraborty has moved the Bombay High Court challenging the lookout circular issued against her by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in connection with its probe into the death of actor Sushant Singh Rajput.

Rajput was found dead in his apartment in suburban Bandra on June 14, 2020, and his father had, in July that year, lodged a complaint with Bihar police accusing Chakraborty, the actor's then girlfriend, and her kin of abetting his suicide.

In her plea, Chakraborty sought for the circular to be quashed and in a separate application sought temporary suspension of the circular as she has to travel abroad for a professional event.

CBI lists ex-Mumbai top cop, others as 'unrelied' witnesses

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has submitted a list of 23 witnesses it would not be examining against former media executive Indrani Mukerjea and other accused in connection with the killing of her daughter Sheena Bora.

The agency in the list, submitted to a special CBI court here on Thursday. that includes Mumbai's former police commissioner Rakesh Maria and other police officials said they would not be examined in the trial as they were "unrelied witnesses".

Indrani and her two former husbands - Peter Mukerjea and Sanjeev Khanna -

are accused of being involved in the killing of Sheena Bora, Indrani's daughter from her first relation. Sheena (24) was murdered on April 24, 2012, allegedly by her mother Indrani, Khanna, and driver Shyamvar Rai in conspiracy with Peter Mukerjea.

The killing, however,

came to light only in 2015

when Rai was arrested by the Mumbai police in another case. At the time, Maria was the city police commissioner and had supervised the probe.

The case was later transferred to the CBI.

Indrani had earlier this year sought the court to direct the CBI to submit a list of witnesses it was going to examine.

In April, the agency had submitted a list of 92 witnesses who would be exam-
