AFTER MEETING WITH PSMSU

## Mann announces 4% hike in DA for govt employees, says will push Centre on OPS

Move to cost  
exchequer  
Rs 1,100 crore  
per annum

PUNJAB CHIEF Minister Bhagwant Mann Monday announced a 4 per cent hike in dearness allowance for government employees with effect from December 1. With this, the DA has increased from 34 per cent to 38 per cent.

The decision was taken following a meeting of the chief minister with the representatives of Punjab State Ministerial Services Union (PSMSU), where Mann discussed various demands of the employees.

"Had a meeting with the representatives of PSMSU and discussed their issues in detail..Sharing the good news that we are going to give a New Year's gift to the employees...DA is increased by 4% which will be considered effective from 1st

December 2023," Mann said on X. After the meeting, PSMSU president Amrik Singh said the chief minister has assured that the remaining 8 per cent DA will also be given.

The PSMSU on Sunday suspended their over a month-long pen-down strike, which began on November 8, after they received the call for a meeting with the chief minister.

Aam Aadmi Party chief spokesperson Malvinder Singh Kang said the decision will cost Rs 1,100 crore per annum to the state exchequer. He said there are 3.25 lakh employees and

3.50 lakh pensioners in the state. The Punjab Employees and Pensioners Joint Front, however, termed the hike as an "unpleasant joke" with the employees. In a statement, the front said that the employees and pensioners of Punjab will get 38% DA while the central government or employees of the governments in the neighbouring states of Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Chandigarh and Jammu Kashmir will get 46%.

It said that there is a complete silence on many other demands including reinstatement, payment of minimum wages to honorary workers, restoration of

all deducted allowances including rural allowance and implementation of Punjab pay scale on employees recruited after July 17, 2020.

Sukhchain Singh Khaira, president of Punjab Government Employees' Association, said that the employees had been demanding 12% pending DA. They have also been demanding implementation of old pension scheme (OPS) but the government hasn't made any headway in this regard, he added.

Mann, however, said the state government will flag the OPS issue with the Union gov-

ernment. He said a meeting will be arranged with the Secretary, Finance, Government of India to further push up the case.

Mann also directed to prepare timescale for ensuring promotion channels in various departments for steno typists on the basis of seniority.

The chief minister also asked the officers to ensure that the process for filling vacant posts in ministerial services of all the departments through promotion was ensured within two months.

He also announced to set up a committee for resolution of various pending demands of the employees including restoration of ACP (assured career progression) scheme and others. Mann assured the employees that the state government is fully committed to their well-being and concerted efforts will be made in this regard.

Mann said the state government is duty-bound to carve out a 'Rangla Punjab' (vibrant Punjab) for which support of every section of society is pivotal. He said the employees of the state government will also act as a catalyst for making Punjab a frontrunner in every field.

He expressed hope that the book will be of much use to researchers, art students, and art connoisseurs. Singh, born on November 29, 1901 at Hargobindpur in Gurdaspur, spent four decades from 1947 to 1986 at art village Andretta in Kangra valley in Himachal Pradesh.

### Pakistan issues 62 visas to Indians to visit Shree Katas Raj temples

On the occasion, Charge d' Affaires Aizaz Khan wished the pilgrims a safe journey and a memorable stay in Pakistan.

## SIT questions Majithia for 7 hrs; he says outcome of his stand against CM Mann

SHIROMANI AKALI Dal leader Bikram Singh Majithia was Monday questioned for more than seven hours by a special investigation team of the Punjab Police in connection with a drugs case registered against him in 2021. Majithia, who reached the SIT office in Patiala with his counsel around 11:45 am and left around 7 pm, termed the case as "false", borne out of "political vengeance". The SIT is led by Additional Director General of Police (Patiala range) Mukhwinder Singh Chhina.

A former minister, Majithia claimed that he was summoned in the two-year-old case as he spoke against 'tanashah' (dictator) Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann'. "Facts will not change. All this is vindictiveness and political vengeance. Whosoever raises voice against this government or 'tanashahi' Mann, a false case is registered against him. It is your (Mann) misconception that you can weaken Majithia this way. I will fight with full force against you. I am not scared of going to jail. If you think that I will stop raising the voice of people out of fear of going to jail, it is not going to happen," Majithia said.

The former minister was earlier booked under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act on December 20, 2021, during the Charanjit Singh Channi-led Congress government. The action was taken based on a 2018 report of the anti-drug Special

Task Force. The FIR was registered by the state Crime Branch at its Mohali police station. Majithia had later surrendered on February 20 and came out of the Patiala jail in August 2022 after the Punjab and Haryana High Court granted him bail.

Majithia also targeted former director general of police S Chattopadhyaya for the registration of case against him in 2021. He said Chattopadhyaya faces a major penalty in the matter of security breach during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the state in January last year.

On January 5, 2022, Modi's convoy was stranded on a flyover due to a blockade by protesters in Ferozepur after which he returned from Punjab without attending any event, including a rally.

Earlier, before reaching the SIT office, Majithia had said he is a law-abiding citizen and has complete trust in law. He said there is no merit in the case and this is just "politicisation". "It is only politics and it has be-

come the habit of Bhagwant Mann to play politics. They have been sleeping for two years. It's my request, if you have any proof then present it in court," Majithia said. "My fight is against the state machinery and against the state government which lodges an FIR against anyone who utters a word against it," he told reporters in Patiala.

"This is the same case in which [Delhi Chief Minister] Arvind Kejriwal tendered an apology to me. Now, I have learnt that ED has summoned Kejriwal on December 21. I can accompany him and tell him not to worry, and face the law," he added.

AAP spokesperson Malvinder Singh Kang, meanwhile, said, "There are very serious allegations against Majithia in the 2013 drugs case... those associated with him remain absconding. The case was registered during Congress rule and Majithia, instead of crying political vendetta, should face the law so that wheat gets separated from chaff".

Status of other cases

On October 14, 2015, two protesters died in an "unprovoked" police firing in Behbal Kalan. Police is also alleged to have opened "unprovoked" fire on protesters in Kotkapura same day, causing injuries. The people had gathered in two places to protest against the sacrilege of Guru Granth Sahib. The charge-sheet into the Kotkapura firing incident submitted by the SIT headed by ADGP L K Yadav had named Sukhbir Singh Badal, who got anticipatory bail from Punjab and Haryana High Court in September this year. Investigation into the Behbal Kalan firing case is underway by another SIT headed by ADGP Naunihal Singh.

## Pak plans 'Darshan Resort' at Kartarpur

*Lahore:* Pakistan's Punjab province government will establish a "Darshan Resort" close to Gurdwara Darbar Sahib in Kartarpur to provide a view of the holy site to the Sikh pilgrims staying there.

"The construction of a five-storey Darshan Resort will start next month with an estimated cost of PKR300 million," Punjab

Secretary Tourism Raja Jahangir Anwar said Monday.

He said it would be built just 500 meters away from the Gurdwara Darbar Sahib. "The ground breaking of the project will be held next month. And by the end of 2024, the resort will be completed," Anwar said, adding that the Punjab government will fund the whole project.

The provincial secretary further said that Darshan Resort will have at least 10 suite rooms on the top floor, mini theatre and gym. He said the resort will also offer a perfect aerial view of the Kartarpur Sahib. "Caretaker Punjab Chief Minister Mohsin Naqvi has already accorded approval to establish the 50-room Darshan Resort," he added. **PT**

2015 SACRILEGE CASES

## Eight years of probe, an apology and much politics

EIGHT YEARS after three incidents of sacrilege in Faridkot district, Akali Dal president Sukhbir Singh Badal tendered an apology to the Sikh community before the Akal Takht, the highest temporal seat of the Sikhs. He apologised for failing to put behind bars perpetrators of the act during the SAD-BJP alliance government in Punjab in 2015. His apology came when the party was celebrating its 103rd Foundation Day in Amritsar on Thursday. However, it was dismissed by the ruling AAP government in Punjab, the main opposition Congress, and the Punjab BJP. The Indian Express explains the cases in question, their current status and how politics played out

in Punjab after the apology.

### The three sacrilege cases that took place in 2015

A bir (copy) of Guru Granth Sahib was stolen on June 1, 2015, from a gurdwara in Burj Jawahar Singh Wala, and an FIR was registered the next day. Nearly four months later, another such case was registered on September 25, 2015 after sacrilegious handwritten posts were found in Burj Jawahar Singh Wala and Bargari villages. On October 12, torn pages of Guru Granth Sahib were found strewn and another FIR was lodged. All the three FIRs were registered in Bajakhana police station.

### The status of the three cases

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) headed by then

Inspector General (IG) and now an Additional Director General of Police (ADGP) in its final report last year concluded that the three sacrilege incidents were the handiwork of Dera Sacha Sauda followers. The 467-page report has no mention of former CM Parkash Singh Badal and his son Sukhbir Badal. Currently, the three cases are being heard in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Chandigarh. The Supreme Court had earlier this year directed that the cases be shifted from a trial court in Faridkot to Chandigarh after the accused Dera followers moved the apex court seeking transfer of cases.

### Political reaction after the apology

While CM Bhagwant Mann said, "*Muafi galtian di hundi hai, gunaha di nahi* (apology is tendered for mistakes, not for crimes)," Vidhan Sabha Speaker Kulter Singh Sandhwan dubbed the apology as "a desperate act necessitated by near-extinct SAD's political compulsions." Sandhwan has also asked "when will he (Sukhbir) apologise for Behbal Kalan and Kotkapura police firing". Senior Congress leader Partap Singh Bajwa had said that the move is nothing but a futile attempt to reclaim the lost ground. "Badal wants to form an alliance with BJP through this apology.
