292 fresh Covid cases, 3 deaths in Kerala

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Kerala reported 292 fresh COV-ID-19 infections and three deaths due to the disease in the last 24 hours, according to data on the Union Health Ministry website on Wednesday.

Of the 341 COVID infections reported nationwide till 8 am today, 292 were from Kerala taking the active cases in the state to 2,041, as per the Ministry website.

With that, the total number of cases under this category rose to 68,37,203 till date.

On Tuesday, state Health Minister Veena George had said that despite the increase in COVID cases in Kerala, there

was nothing to be concerned about as the state was well prepared to handle the virus infection. The minister had also said that directions have been issued to provide special facilities for COVID patients and ensure availability of isolation wards, rooms, oxygen beds, ICU beds and ventilators in hospitals.

Two succumb in K'taka

Two Covid-19 related deaths and 20 fresh cases were reported in Karnataka, according to a Health bulletin issued on Wednesday.

The bulletin stated that the deceased - both male aged 44 and 76 - died on December 16 and December 17 respectively in Bengaluru. One of them was asymptomatic while the other patient complained of breathlessness.

Earlier in the day, Karnataka Health Minister Dinesh Gundu Rao said that a 64-year-old man died in the city due to Covid-19 infection five days ago. Asked if the cause of death was the new subvariant JN.1 of the SARS CoV-2 virus, he said it was not known so far. PTI

THE Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission is set to fill 392 job openings across 15 categories next year. Telangana debt at ₹6,71,757 cr, says Deputy CM

THE white paper on state finances tabled in the Legislative Assembly on Wednesday paints a bleak picture of Telangana's fiscal situation as it says that the total accumulated debts are ₹6,71,757 crore as of date.

Most of this debt was raised in the last 10 years. The white paper highlighted that the state requires ₹1,59,940 crore to complete ongoing works, of which ₹86,957 crore has to be allocated in the Budget for the coming

Initiating the short discussion on the white paper, Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka, who also holds the Finance portfolio, said that the aim of the government in releasing the white paper was to know the current financial situation and start the journey afresh.

"We have no enmity towards anyone. We wanted to end the financial misrule and correct it. At present, the State is borrowing money to repay its debts. I appeal to Opposition parties to cooperate with the government to set things right," Vikramarka said. He said that the government considers Opposition parties as political opponents and not enemies.


