

Spirit of 'self-confidence' and 'self-reliance' need to maintain in 2024, PM Modi in Mann ki Baat

Kolhapur: Aged man dies in bike-bus collision

New Delhi, (UNI) Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said that India is brimming with 'self-confidence' and 'self-reliance' and this spirit needs to be maintained in 2024 as well.

Addressing the 108th episode of Mann Ki Baat he reminded the citizens of the numerous achievements of the country in 2023.

"India is brimming with self-confidence, imbued with the spirit of a developed India; the spirit of self-reliance. We have to maintain the same spirit and momentum in 2024 as well", Modi said.

The Prime Minister said, 2024 is just a few hours away. India's achievements are the achievements of every Indian. We have to continuously work for the development of India keeping in mind the Panch Pran."

Recounting the achievements in 2023, he said



this year "Nari Shakti Vandan Act" was passed which is one of such major steps that will empower our Nari Shakti.

"This is just a glimpse of how effective India's potential is and we have to take inspiration from these successes of the country" the PM added.

Modi said in 2015 we were ranked at 81st position in Global Innovation Index - today our rank is 40th.

"This year the number of patents filed in India was very high, of which 60

percent were from domestic funds, he said, adding that India becoming an 'innovation hub' is a symbol of the fact that we are not going to stop".

The PM pointed out how innovative technology, such as artificial intelligence (AI), has brought about convenience in different sectors of society.

He recalled the Kashi-Tamil Sangam event, where the indigenous AI-powered Bhashini app ensured proper translation of his words from Hindi to Tamil with ease. Modi added that such

technology would bring ease of functioning in different sectors including judiciary and education, once it is implemented there.

"I urge the youths to explore AI tools related to real-time translation and make them 100 per cent foolproof," he said.

Over the achievement in Sports, the Prime Minister said "This year, our athletes have also performed outstandingly in sports. Our athletes won 107 medals in the Asian Games and 111 medals in the Asian Para Games.

Modi said in the Cricket World Cup, Indian players won everyone's hearts with their performance...Now, Paris Olympics will be organised in 2024 for which the entire nation is encouraging athletes".

He also spoke about how he still receives congratulatory messages on ISRO's Chandrayaan success. "Even today, people send messages congratulating me for the success of Chandrayaan-3. I am sure, just like me, you would be proud of our scientists, especially our women scientists," the PM said.

Lauding the nation's response to the Fit India movement, Modi discussed the importance of mental health along with physical fitness.

During the programme, he also shared the experiences of grandmaster Vishwanathan Anand about his fitness routine

and talked about the importance of at least seven to eight hours of sleep in remaining composed and mentally fit during the day.

Bollywood actor Akshay Kumar also said it is essential to follow a proper diet to remain physically healthy.

The Prime Minister said, "Today there is a lot of discussion about physical health and well-being, but another important aspect related to it is that of mental health.

He also appealed to people to write to him about innovation health care start-up to realise the dream of Fit India.

"I would urge all of you to keep writing to me about innovative health care startups towards realizing the dream of Fit India. I also want to share with you the experiences of well-known people who talk about physical and mental health" Modi said.



Kolhapur, (UNI) A 67-year-old man died on the spot when his motorcycle collided head-on with a state transport bus at Nirman Chowk in Sambhajinagar, a suburb of the city, on Sunday morning.

According to the police, deceased Vinayak Balwant Khade (67), a resident of Haragnani in the city, was returning after purchasing vegetables by his motorcycle when a speedy ST bus from Kolhapur to Gargoti collided head-on with his motorcycle. In this incident, Vinayak died on the spot with a serious head injury.

Police booked the ST driver for careless driving and are investigating further.

Rahul Gandhi Reacts To Vinesh Phogat Video

New Delhi, (TNB): Rahul Gandhi of the Congress on Sunday criticised Prime Minister Narendra Modi after multiple World Championship medalist Vinesh Phogat on Saturday returned her Khel Ratna and Arjuna Award. Vinesh Phogat kept the two awards lying in the middle of New Delhi's Kartavya Path after the Delhi Police stopped her from reaching the prime minister's office.

On Tuesday, the Asian Games gold medalist grappler had decided to return her Khel Ratna and Arjuna Award to the government, saying such honours have become meaningless at a time when wrestlers are struggling to get justice. Phogat had announced her decision in a letter to PM Modi.

Stressing that self-respect comes first for "every daughter of the country" and any medal or honour comes after that, Gandhi indirectly mentioned former Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) president Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, who had been accused of sexual harassment by three well-known grapplers. "Today, has the cost of 'political gains' derived from a declared 'strongman' become greater than the tears of these brave daughters? The prime minister is the guardian of the nation, witnessing such insensitivity causes anguish," Gandhi wrote on social media X (formerly Twitter). As a mark of protest, Phogat left the awards at the Kartavya Path and the Delhi Police later picked them up.

Phogat, along with Olympic medalists Sakshi Malik and Bajrang Punia, had protested against the election of Sanjay Singh, a close aide of Brij Bhushan.

Sakshi had also announced her retirement from wrestling soon after Sanjay Singh's appointment.

It's ploy to ensure Siddaramaiah son's victory in LS poll : BJP MP on brother's arrest

Mysuru, (UNI) Mysuru-Kodagu MP and BJP leader Pratap Simha on Sunday said his brother Vikram Simha has been arrested to end his political career and ensure the victory of Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah's son in next year's Lok Sabha election.

He also questioned Siddaramaiah of why hasn't the police produced his brother before the judicial authority even after his arrest around 1500 hours on Saturday.

"I want to salute Siddaramaiah ... he will trample on anyone for

his son's political future and ensure victory in the ensuing Lok Sabha election. Not everyone gets such a father. Are you trying to end my career because I have become an obstacle for you? ...," the MP asked.

Vikram Simha was arrested yesterday jointly by the police and forest officials, and taken to Hassan district for allegedly felling 126 trees without obtaining any permission.

He alleged that his brother's name now appears in the FIR, and yet he has been arrested. "The authorities have



dragged my brother's name in the Belur (Hassan) land issue. My brother was arrested on charges of tree felling, but his name is not in the FIR. I want to know - why his brother has not been produced before the ju-

diary even after he was arrested at 3 pm yesterday," he asked.

Pratap Simha also asked CM Siddaramaiah why the police have not yet arrested those whose names have been re-

corded in the FIR by the police. "The FIR had named Jayamma and Rajesh Shetty. One more person Ravi, who is known to have helped them, escaped. Why haven't these three persons been arrested so far?" he asked.

The BJP MP also rubbish allegations that his brother was abducting and not cooperating with the investigating agencies. "My brother went to the office of the forest de-

Kerala: Sevabharathi sets record by donating 1000 houses to homeless Kerala

Thiruvananthapuram, (UNI) Sevabharathi has set a new record by donating nearly 1,000 houses to many poor families under its flagship initiative 'Shelter to Rest One's Head' (Talachaiakkanoridam) project aimed at better housing for homeless in Kerala.
