Couple found dead on tracks

MIRYALGUDA: The incident of an unidentified young man and a young woman committing suicide by falling under the train came to light near Miryalaguda railway station in the district on Sunday

According to Railway GRP SI Salakamma, Railway SI Pawankumar Reddy, the railway staff in early morning found the bodies on the railway tracks at Miryalaguda railway number 115 milestone and informed the railway police. The body parts were strewn all around.

The man was said to be of about 30 years age, and the woman could be about 25 years old. The railway ticket found at the spot was bought at Vijayawada railway station at 11 am on Saturday.

They could have Janmabhoomi Express, which was scheduled at that time. No evidence was found to trace their identities. The bodies were shifted to the mortuary of Government Area Hospital, Miryalaguda.
