

Trichy councillors seek eviction of street vendors from arterial roads

Encroachments Lead To Traffic Congestion

Trichy: Expressing concerns over street vendors encroaching major roads, Trichy corporation councillors in the council meeting on Wednesday sought the local body to streamline street vendors to prevent traffic bottlenecks. A section of councillors urged the authorities to regulate the mobile eateries functioning during the night as they don't contribute to the local body's revenue but occupy arterial roads and junctions.

Councillor P Senthilnathan (ward 47) said a woman riding a two-wheeler on Pudukottai Main Road near Kallukuzhi bridge lost her life in a road accident last week caused due to encroachments by

vendors. "When corporation employees try to remove encroachments, there is no support from police. Outlets are illegally occupying the walking tracks around the Anna stadium at Khajamalal too."

Councillor V Leela (ward 49) said that accident risks have increased drastically due to street vendors encroaching roads. N Prabhakaran (ward 17) said that trucks parked on the carriageway of East Boulevard are also causing accidents.

Councillors expressed dis-

satisfaction over the lack of regulations for food carts selling meat items. "Nobody is inspecting the quality of food items sold during night eateries, which are not paying any user fee to the local body," T Muthuselvam, councillor of ward 57 said.

Replying to councillors, mayor Mu Anbalagan said that encroachments on roads hindering public movement will be removed.

"We will insist the police commissioner to deploy officials to help our staff during

UGD works to be completed by March, says mayor

Trichy: The Trichy corporation on Wednesday informed councillors that the ongoing underground drainage (UGD) project works in three phases will be completed by March this year.

"Out of the total 858km long UGD pipelines, works have been completed for about 800km. Pending works including in Pattabiraman Street will be completed before March. The contractors were informed about the deadline," mayor Mu Anbalagan said. Before the present elected council assumed office in March 2022, only around 75km long UGD pipelines were installed,

he added.

Councillor P Govindarajan (ward 41) said roads in his ward damaged due to UGD works have not been relaid so far.

Replying to councillors, the mayor said a proposal was sent to the government seeking funds to relay 311km long roads damaged due to UGD works. "Around 450km long roads were already relaid in the areas where works were completed. Funds allocated for repairing damaged roads in Trichy were one of the highest for any urban local bodies in the state."

V Ramadoss (ward 55) said UGD works have been too slow in Karumandapam. TN

Two cops suspended after visiting BJP's enrolment camp

Trichy: Two policemen attached to the Velippalayam station in Nagapattinam district were placed under suspension on Wednesday on charges of violating service rules.

The action comes days after the two policemen deployed for bandobust duty at BJP state president K Annamalai's padayatra in Nagapattinam, visited the saffron party's membership enrolment camp set up at the place wearing their service uniform.

Police officials said the two had allegedly enrolled themselves in the party on the day, which was a violation of 18(1) of the Tamil Nadu Subordinate Police Officers Conduct Rules 1964. Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Thanjavur range T Jayachandran issued the suspension order.

The action comes days after the two policemen visited the saffron party's membership enrolment camp set up at the place wearing their service uniform

The incident happened on December 27 evening, when Annamalai visited Nagapattinam to participate in the 'En Mann En Makkal' yatra. In a video widely circulated on social media, sub-inspector K Rajendran and special sub-inspector A Karthikeyan, who were on bandobust duty at Avurithidal area on that day, are seen approaching the BJP's membership enrolment camp at Avurithidal enquiring something with the volunteers.

Based on the video, SP Harsh Singh ordered a DSP to inquire into the incident. During the inquiry, the two

policemen denied giving a missed call at the BJP enrolment camp to join the party. However, they refused to surrender their mobile phones for verification.

The inquiry report was sent to the DIG of Thanjavur range for further action on December 29, said SP Singh told TOI. They were transferred to armed reserve police on the day.

Singh said that the two policemen had given their mobile phone to BJP volunteers at the enrolment camp and received it back after a while.

The official order from the Thanjavur range has stated that it was a gross misconduct for having tried to join as a member in a political party, in violation of the rules.

Meanwhile, Annamalai condemned the suspension and demanded the state government to revoke the order.

Three back-to-back snatchings in Trichy

Trichy: Three incidents of chain and bag snatchings were recorded in the last one week in Trichy city.

M Sundaram, 63, from Kallar street in Periya Milaguparai was walking on the road near KAP Viswanatham Government Medical College (KAPVGM) around 9pm on Tuesday, when two men on a bike snatched his mobile phone and fled.

On December 28, M Pushpalatha, 44, of LIC colony in KK Nagar was riding her bike near Cloud Nine church on Sathanur Road at around 7pm, when two unidentified

people on a bike grabbed her five sovereign gold chain. She managed to catch hold of 2.5 sovereigns of the chain while the snatchers fled the scene with the broken part.

On December 30, two bike-borne snatchers targeted Nagarathinam, 58, of Viswas Nagar on Thanjavur Road. She was riding pillion with her brother near the Manjathidal railway station when the duo tried to snatch her bag. Nagarathinam lost control and fell on the road and suffered head injuries and was admitted to a hospital.

8,000 students get dates syrup to prevent iron deficiency

Trichy: As many as 8,000 school students in Andanallur block in Trichy district on Wednesday were distributed with a one kg dates syrup pack each in an initiative aimed at preventing iron deficiency conditions among government school students. The initiative covering students of classes I to XII was implemented by the school education department in association with the corporate social responsibility (CSR) drive of Trichy-based Lion Dates Private Limited.

School education department officials said that during routine health checkups, some of the students at government schools in Andanallur block were found to have iron deficiency. As poor health conditions may impact their school attendance, the company was approached to support in distributing dates syrup. The

department distributed the dates syrup to all elementary, middle, high and higher secondary government students in Andanallur. "We have already distributed such dates syrup to the Trichy corporation school students in Andanallur block. Soon, we will expand the initiative to anganwadis," K Maruthanayagam, block education officer said.

The cost of each pack of dates syrup was estimated at ₹390. Parents were encouraged to feed the syrup to their children periodically. The distribution of dates syrup in a one-time drive, officials said.

Rail restaurant to come up in Trichy

Trichy: The Trichy railway division will soon launch a restaurant on a coach within the premise of the railway museum located in the city. Following Chennai, the authorities have taken this initiative to provide dining experience to rail passengers and the public. A private company will set up the restaurant and run it for a period of five years at a licence fee of ₹15 lakh, officials said.

To station the coach, a concrete base was laid to a length of 30m. The process of laying a broad gauge track is now in progress.

"Kitchen will not be on the coach. Dining will also

be arranged out of the coach based on the demand. We expect the work to be completed by the mid of March" a senior official from the commercial department said.

After five years, the agency will hand over the coach to the railways. There is also a plan to provide a parking space inside the museum premises for the public coming to the restaurant.

Man dies in hit-and-run incident

Trichy: A 68-year-old man died after he was hit by an unidentified vehicle at Oottathur in Trichy on Tuesday.

Police said S Mudiappara of Keelavaladi in Lalgudi taluk was walking on the side of a road near Perumal temple on Tuesday morning when the unidentified vehicle hit him. He suffered severe head injuries and died on the spot, said a police officer.

The Kanakiniyanallur police filed a case and took up the investigation based on a complaint from Mudiappara's daughter D Lourde Mary, 37, of Oottathur. The preliminary investigation revealed that the vehicle which hit him was a four-wheeler. TNN
