NOIDA, DEC 31 /-- As harsh winter grips the state, the Uttar Pradesh Social Welfare Department has launched an initiative to provide shelter to the destitute elderly people at old-age homes to protect them from cold weather conditions.

The facility is available across department-run old age homes in all 75 districts of the state, including Gautam Buddha Nagar and Ghaziabad in western Uttar Pradesh. Officials said. The general public can also inform government officials about destitute elderly people by calling the Elder Line in 14567 or the state police's emergency number 112, they said. Old age homes have facilities for food, warm clothes, medicines, means of entertainment, etc. Additionally, doctors are also available so that sick elderly people can be treated, if needed, according to officials. "The state government is continuously working for the safety, health and dignity of the weak and destitute elderly people of the society. For this, adequate arrangements have been made by the government in old age homes. "A campaign has been started to save destitute elderly people from the cold wave," UP Minister of State for Social Welfare (Independent Charge) Asim Arun told PTI. The minister has also written a letter to the Director General of Police of Uttar Pradesh, seeking cooperation in surveying destitute elderly people and taking them to old age homes with respect. District Social Welfare Officers across the state are contacting the Superintendent of Police/Commissioner of Police of their district to establish coordination. If the police personnel see any destitute old people during night patrolling, with the help of the Social Welfare Department, they will be taken to old age homes. Gautam Buddha Nagar Social Welfare Officer Shailendra Bahadur Singh said, "The old age home in this district is located in Dankaur where the elderly destitute can stay in the winter." Ghaziabad Social Welfare Officer Amarjeet Singh said the district's old age home is located in Duha area where all facilities have been made available for elderly homeless people.

"The department appeals to the general public to inform us at 14567 or the police at 112 if they find any elderly person spending nights in the open. People can also call on my official number 9151935257 any time," Singh told PTI. The minimum temperature in several districts of Uttar Pradesh has dipped into a single digit in the last week of December. The weather department has predicted dense to very dense fog across the state during the first two days of the New Year and light rains in western UP after that. (PTI)

Dalit woman thrown into hot cauldron for protesting against molestation in UP

BAGHPAT, DEC 31 --/ A young Dalit woman was allegedly thrown into a hot cauldron of a jaggery-making unit for protesting against molestation in the Budaun district, police said on Sunday. The 18-year-old woman, who sustained serious burn injuries, is undergoing treatment at the GTB Hospital in Delhi, police said, adding that three accused, including the cauldron owner, have been arrested. Inspector-in-charge of the Binauli police station M P Singh said that the woman, a resident of Muzaffarnagar, worked at Pramod's cauldron in a village. Lodging a complaint at the Binauli police station on Saturday, the woman's brother said that on Wednesday, she was working at the cauldron when Pramod, Raju and Sandeep allegedly molested and misbehaved with his sister. When she protested, the accused allegedly threw her into the hot cauldron with the intention of killing her, and also hurled "casteist words" towards her. After this, the three accused fled. Singh said that on the complaint of her brother, police have registered a case against accused Pramod, Raju and Sandeep under sections 354 (assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty), 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace), 307 (attempt to murder) of the IPC and under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes
