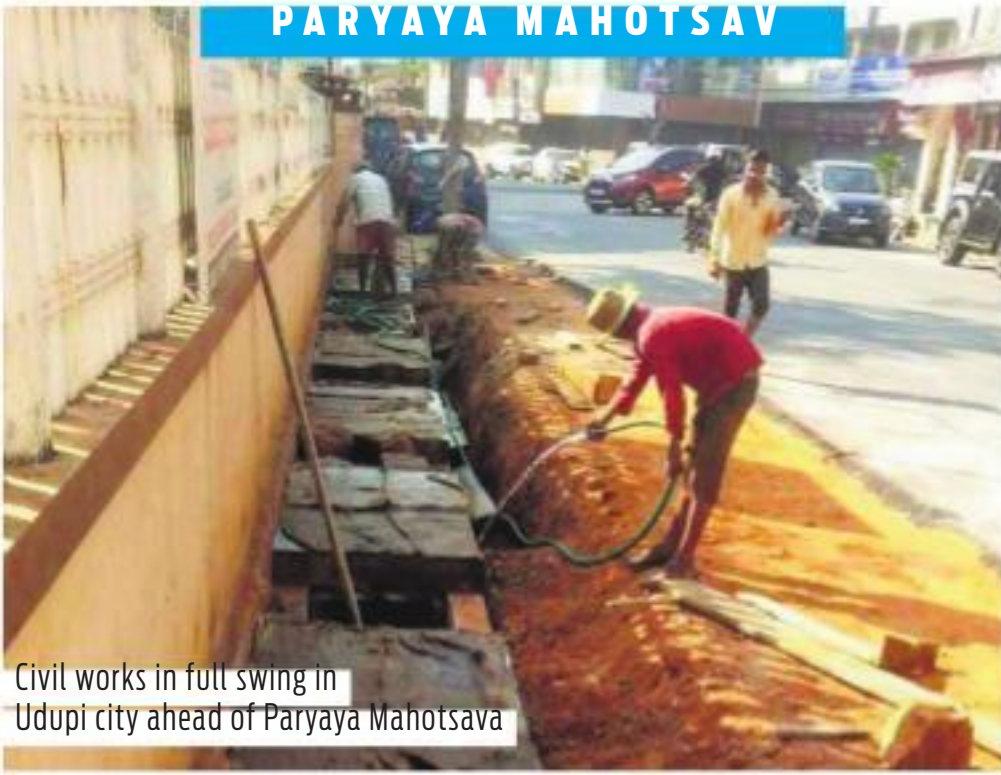

Udupi CMC takes up Rs 3-cr road repair works

The roads will be in a better condition in the city in another 10 days, says official

AHEAD of Paryaya Mahotsava in Udupi on January 17 and 18, the civic authority has taken up road repair works in the city limits at a cost of Rs 3 crore. The roads will be in a better condition in the city in another 10 days as many people will throng the city to witness the biennial event. Potholes at several stretches in the city are being filled. For the resurfacing work of the road with asphalt from Brahmagiri Circle to Town Hall in Ajjarakad area, the cost has been estimated at Rs 49.75 lakh. For pothole-filling works across the city, the civic authority is spending Rs 25 lakh. In order to reconstruct the concrete slabs that were broken, the CMC is spending Rs 20 lakh. For repainting the footpath and medians of the main roads, the CMC has set aside the amount of Rs 25 lakh. Likewise, the reconstruction of the drainage, installation of concrete slabs on

the drainage lines, widening of the road in some stretches will also be taken up and the CMC has taken up these works simultaneously. CMC Commissioner Rayappa told TNIE that apart from Rs 3 crore for civil works, the CMC will spend Rs 33 lakh for waste management from January 5 to January 20. In parts of the city, pothole filling work is already over and in the remaining places, it will be completed by January 10, he added. Udupi DC Dr Vidya Kumari K had chaired a meeting of officials of various departments on December 1 and directed the officials to ensure smooth conduct of Paryaya Mahotsava in Udupi. She had stressed on ensuring that basic amenities are provided for the convenience of visitors to the city. Sources said that temporary parking lots will be readied in the days to come, so that there will not be any inconvenience for the visitors to park their vehicles when they visit the temple town for the event.

9-year-old M'luru boy donates hair for cancer patients

ONE of the youngest hair donors, Arnab Prabhu, a 9-year-old boy from Mangaluru, has donated his 24 inches of hair for a good cause of making wigs for cancer patients. On December 29, on the day of his Brahmapadsha, Arnab, son of Srilatha Prabhu and Ashwin Prabhu from Man-nagudda in the city and a class 4 student of Amrita Vidyalaya, donated his hair that he had grown in the past 4 years. His mother Srilatha Prabhu, speaking to The New Indian Express, said, "When he turned 2.8-year-old, we contacted a person named Yathish Deshpande from Mumbai who made wigs

for cancer patients and it was in 2017, Arnab donated his hair for the first time. Later at the time of his enrollment to Amrita Vidyalaya, there were restrictions to cut hair in saloons due to Covid-19. When schools reopened, we sought special permission from the school authorities and he was allowed to grow his hair as it was for a good cause," she said. "Since we are not allowed to cut hair outside during Brahmapadsham, we had arranged for his hair cut at our residence itself by a person from a saloon. Hair must be very dry and since it was very thick and long, I had to put five ponytails and then shave off his hair. We later packed it in cover and handed it



over to Yuva Shakti Kadeshivaya organisation, an organisation which has so far done 250



plus hair donations for cancer patients in and around Mangaluru," Prabhu added.

It was Arnab's idea to donate his hair for cancer patients. Parents and teachers said it was a tough time for Arnab at the school, as his schoolmates used to make fun of him calling him a girl for long hair yet he was firm on growing his hair. "I did not pay attention to my schoolmates who made fun of me. Now, I feel great after donating my hair," Arnab said. "Teachers were very supportive despite boys being not allowed to grow long hair in the school. Since it was for a good cause, the school authorities gave permission for him to grow long hair and inspired by him, many students have come forward to donate their hair," said Srilatha.
