No bandhs, street violence in J&K in year gone by: MHA

Ministry Lists Successes In Enacting New Laws, Curbing Maoist Violence

New Delhi: The bygone year seems to have seen the back of bandhs and street violence in Jammu and Kashmir with 'nil' incidents of organised hartals and organised stone-pelting related to terrorism and separatism recorded until December 15, as against 52 hartals and 1,221 stone-pelting incidents in 2018, the year before the nullification of Article 370.

The home ministry, in a year-ender account of its actions and achievements, said terrorist-initiated incidents in J&K were down to 44 in 2023 (until December 15) from 228 in

During the period under comparison, encounters fell to 48 from 189, civilians killed to 13 from 55 and security personnel fatalities to 26 from 91

Nationally the home ministry underlined the enactment of three criminal justice laws as an important achievement. The ministry made a mention of various peace pacts signed with insurgent groups as well as the settlement of inter-state border disputes in the north-


The peace settlements, coupled with the complete removal of AFSPA from Tripura and Meghalaya and its partial lifting in Assam, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur, extremist incidents, 71% fall in fatalities of security forces and 86% decline in civilian deaths in the north-east region.

On the ethnic violence in Manipur that broke out in May, the home ministry said various remedial measures were taken including one-time special assistance of ₹102 crore for running relief and rehabilitation schemes for those affected by the violence; and a ₹89 crore grant for the scheme of complementary nutrition and hygiene support to people living

MHA declares outfit founded by Geelani 'unlawful association'

New Delhi: The Centre on Sunday designated the Tehreek-e-Hurriyat (TeH), Jammu & Kashmir, a separatist outfit founded in 2004 by the late, pro-Pakistan Hurriyat 'hawk' Syed Ali Shah Geelani, as an 'unlawful association' for a five-year period under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UA-PA), 1967, reports Bharti

minister Amit Shah said TeH was involved in "forbidden activities to separate J&K from India and establish Islamic rule in the Union Territory". "The group is found spreading anti-India propaganda and continuing terror activities to fuel secessionism in J&K," he posted on X.

4 commandos injured as militants attack outpost in Manipur town near Myanmar

Imphal: Troubled Manipur's trial by bloodshed since May continued into the last day of the year as suspected militants attacked a police outpost in Moreh bordering Myanmar early Sunday, leaving four commandos wounded in a burstof gunfire.

A village guard was also injured in a blast at Tumukhong village in Imphal East district, a day after unidentified gunmen killed another village sen-

The militant attack on the outpost at Moreh Turelwangma Leikai started around midnight on Saturday with a shower of rocket-propelled grenades, mortar fire and bullets from automatic rifles. The fighting continued till 2am, police officials said.

The injured police commandos - Diliangam Komson, M Priyokumar, N Borjao and M Sunil - were initially hospitalised in an Assam Rifles camp before being moved

to Imphal for advanced treatment. They are said to be out of danger. The tribal organisation Kuki Inpi Tengnoupal accused the police commandos of torching the houses and indiscriminate firing on Kuki-Zo localities there.

Residents of Moreh displaced by the ongoing conflict, who are currently taking refuge in a government college in Imphal East, staged a demonstration on Sunday against the renewed attacks on state forces deployed on the border.

Varanasi: Two members of the BJP's IT cell in Varanasi were among three people arrested late Saturday and identified as the alleged perpetrators of the November 2 gangrape of a 20-yearold BTech student of IIT-BHU on campus. The three young men have confessed to the crime, including disrobing and filming the survivor at gunpoint, and could be charged under the National Security Act and the UP Gangsters and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act, Kashi DCP R S Gautam said on Sunday.

Lanka station house officer Shivakant Mishra identified the arrested trio as Kunal Pandey of Sunderpur's Brij Enclave Colony; Anand, alias Abhishek Chauhan, of Jivadhipur Bajardiha; and Saksham Patel of Bajardiha.

Hours after their arrest, social media was flooded with screenshots of Kunal and Saksham's Facebook pages mentioning the positions they hold in the BJP's IT cell. The BJP's Kashi media in-charge Navratan Rathi said Kunal was the convenor of the cell's city unit while Saksham was its co-convenor.

DCP Gautam said the motorbike and mobile phone used in the crime, besides other electronic evidence, had been seized. The arrested trio's criminal history, if any, is being checked.

Based on the survivor's complaint on November 2, Lanka police had registered an FIR. The survivor said she had stepped out for a walk outside her hostel around 1.30am that night when a male friend from the same institute joined her at the Gandhi Memorial Hostel crossing. The duo was approaching the Karmanbir Baba temple when the motorbike-borne accused approa-ched them. The survivor was forcibly separated from her friend and assaulted, she said.

The crime triggered a tumult on campus, with thousands of students joining a sit-in that continued for days

Later, IIT-BHU students staged a demonstration near the office of the institute's director, protesting the delay in arresting the accused.
