Railway body demands road renovation

Lalitpur (UP): The members of the colony inspection group of the divisional headquarters inspected the east and west railway colony. A member of CIG divisional headquarters Gaurav Shrivastava represented the Railway Employees' Sangh. Shrivastava gave feedback on the poor condition of the houses in the eastern part of the colony. The area remains dirty because of poor sewage and drainage system, Shrivastava informed the members of the group during their inspection. He showed the condition of the square near the railway station and demanded the renovation of houses in the colony and improvement of the road leading from railway station to Chitra Square.

MAN GETS 20-YR RI FOR RAPING MINOR

Satna: A man has been sentenced to 20 years' imprisonment for abducting and raping a minor girl who went to get her KYC done. The court of additional session judge Sachin Sharma also imposed a fine of Rs 5,000 on the culprit. The mother of the minor lodged a complaint at Singpur police station on November 7, 2022 that her daughter had gone missing. In the complaint, her mother said that her daughter had gone to Singpur to get her KYC done, but when she did not return home, the woman lodged a complaint. The police arrested the man after taking statement from the girl and presented him to the court.

Gunrunning racket in south-western districts under NIA, ATS lens

As many as 17 habitats of the Sikligars in the four south-western districts—Dhar, Barwani, Khargone and Burhanpur—are involved in illegal arms manufacturing and supplies. On Tuesday, the MP-ATS conducted raids and searches in Khargone district and arrested two accused, and seized finished and unfinished weapons. Sources in ATS claimed that the Sikligars are now using modern technology to manufacture guns, which can be matched with the high quality branded products. Not only this, they are selling them to the terrorist-gangster nexus. DIG, ATS Tarun Nayka told Free Press, “We are working on the issue

and we are also focusing on the working of the Sikligars. The police have prepared vast plans to control them.” Recently on March 12, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) crackdown against terrorist-gangster-drug smugglers nexus having suspected links to Khalistani separatist elements and conducted searches at 30 locations in Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Chandigarh. In the state, the NIA teams from Chandigarh searched multiple locations, which included villages of three south-western districts – Khargone, Barwani and Burhanpur. Importantly, many of these villages where the premises were searched are infamous for housing gunrunners and gunmakers from the Sikligar community, which

since generations has mastered the art of making firearms. According to sources, the gunmaking is going in Umarthi village on MP-Maharashtra border in Barwani district and Signur village in the adjoining Khargone district. Both these villages have long been notorious for gunmakers/gunrunners. The work is also done in Pachore village of Burhanpur district. Kharti village in Rajpur of Barwani district as well as Satipura Faliya in Bhagwanpura town of Khargone district have been under the NIA and ATS lens for their gun making skills. In 2023 also, an NIA team conducted a search in Umarthi village of Barwani district. In the past too NIA teams have conducted searches in similar cases in Ujjain and Ratlam districts of western MP.

Bundelkhand Vikas Sena to hold Holi Milan function on Monday

Lalitpur (UP): The centre head of the Bundelkhand Vikas Sena Harish Kapoor has said the Sena will organise 33rd Holi Milan function at Company Bagh on March 25. Residents urged to stop using disposable utensils

Sagar: Commissioner of Nagar Nigam Rajkumar Khatri has appealed to the residents to stop using disposable utensils and non-standard plastic items. They not only pose hazard to public health but also choke drains and dirty the roads, so using disposable utensils should be stopped, he said. Khatri made the statement during an inspection of different areas, including Rajghat

square, in the city recently. Instead of using plastic-made utensils, the people should go for steel, clay and glass-made wares, he said. Khatri has also advised the hotel owners and customers at Rajghat square not to throw the disposable utensils on roads which dirty the area. The hotel and food outlet owners should keep dustbins in which the customers throw leftover of food and dispos-

able utensils, he said. But the people should use utensils made of glass which never dirty an area, he said. Afterwards, he inspected a pipeline damaged by the workers of Tata Engineering. He asked the officials of Nagar Nigam to work in coordination with workers of Tata Engineering. He also inspected a project at Dugdugi hills. Tata Engineering is doing the work.

4 held for robbing photographer

Chhatarpur: The Jujhar-nagar police of Chhatarpur on Thursday claimed to have arrested for persons, who had robbed a photographer of his video camera and other belongings on Wednesday. The police said the key accused was an acquaintance of the victim., and all of them fell into the police net within 24 hours. As per police, the victim who was robbed is named Rakesh Kushwaha (19). He works as a photographer and a videographer. On Wednesday evening, he had been heading towards a wedding for clicking pictures and filming videos of the event. During this, four masked robbers assaulted him on the way, and robbed him of his video camera, as well as its batteries, cell phones and other equipment. Kushwaha approached the police immediately, and lodged a complaint against unidentified accused. The police quizzed Kushwaha with regard to his suspicion on anyone.

Kushwaha named one Sunil Kushwaha, who was nabbed by the police and interrogated strictly. Sunil confessed to committing the crime along with three of his friends. He told the police that he too, used to work at a studio, and to expand his business, robbed Rakesh of his belongings. The police took him as well as other of his accomplices into custody, and seized all the stolen booty, as well as the bike of the accused, along with a country-made pistol used in committing the crime. One minor was also among the accused, who has been sent to the correction home in the town.
