

Jessica beats number 1 Aryna at WTA Finals

As match point after match point came and went - there were six in all she didn't convert - Jessica Pegula made sure she stayed calm and didn't, as she put it, "freak out" against No. 1-ranked Aryna Sabalenka at the WTA Finals. When her seventh chance to end things arrived, Pegula finally was able to complete a 6-4, 6-3 victory over Sabalenka in round-robin action at the season-ending championship for the top eight players in women's tennis on Tuesday.

"We all, as tennis players, have experienced that to some extent - on both sides. So, I mean, I try to use my match experience as best I can," said Pegula, a 29-year-old American who is now guaranteed to finish atop her group and reach the semifinals in Cancun.

"Every match, you're always going to feel different. But I think the more you put yourself in those situations, the better you feel when they come up again. It doesn't feel like you have to panic as much."



On Tuesday's other singles match, 2022 Wimbledon champion Elena Rybakina beat Maria Sakkari 6-0, 6-7 (4), 7-6 (2). That eliminated Sakkari from semifinal contention and means Sabalenka will face Rybakina on Thursday for their group's second berth in the final four; that's a rematch of the Australian Open title match in January, won by Sabalenka.

Pegula has won both matches and all four sets she's played so far at these WTA Finals, a year after going 0-3 at the competition. She had lost four times in a row to Sabalenka, who was the runner-up to Coco Gauff at the U.S. Open in September. On Tuesday, on a temporary hard court that has drawn criticism from Sabalenka and others, Pegula dominated for

stretches. That included a four-game run in the opening set, and then a 4-0 start to the second while grabbing 16 of 19 points. The big-hitting Sabalenka - who lost just one game on Sunday against Sakkari - finished with more than twice as many unforced errors as Pegula, including a 17-8 margin in the first set. "I gave her too much," Sabalenka said.

The toughest portion for Pegula was at the end.

Serving for the match at 5-2, she got to 40-15 to earn a pair of match points. That's when Pegula double-faulted for the first time all evening, and followed immediately with another. Soon enough, Sabalenka had broken her.

In the next game, Pegula got to love-40 - three more match points. And Sabalenka saved each of those, the first two with backhand winners, the next with a forehand winner. A sixth match disappeared when Pegula netted a forehand.

Soon enough, though, Sabalenka was faltering, double-faulting, putting a forehand into the net to offer up a seventh chance for Pegula to end the match, then framing a backhand to wrap it up. "A really solid match - up until the couple of double-faults at the end. I mean, I felt like I was in control and playing smart and doing everything really well," Pegula said.

"Sometimes you need to get through those moments to really test yourself."

Alcaraz loses at Paris Masters in return from injury, Zverev and Hurkacz advance

Carlos Alcaraz's hopes of finishing the season as the top-ranked player took a hit after a 6-3, 6-4 loss to qualifier Roman Safiullin in the second round of the Paris Masters.

In his return from injury, Alcaraz dropped serve four times and made 27 unforced errors to 21 for Safiullin, a former world No. 2 junior.

"I didn't feel well, you know, in the game," Alcaraz told a news conference on Tuesday.

"I think I didn't move well. In the shots, I think I had a good quality of shots. But, you know, physically, in the part of movement, I have to improve a lot."

The Spaniard was knocked out in the fourth round of the Shanghai Masters nearly three weeks ago and withdrew from the Swiss Indoors in Basel because of a left foot injury and muscle fatigue to his lower back. Alcaraz leads the ATP Tour with six titles this year but hasn't lifted any trophy since Wimbledon. He seems to be running on fumes lately because of his demanding style of play. "Probably the season has been so, so long," Alcaraz said. "Probably that affects my game."



The second-seeded Alcaraz and Safiullin traded breaks in the third and fourth games. Alcaraz struggled to find his range and dropped serve at 4-3 with a poor game that included a double fault and two unforced errors. Safiullin hit a service winner and two backhand winners to grab the opening set.

Play was briefly interrupted in the beginning of the second set to switch off a vivid pink light under the roof of the arena that troubled the players when they were tossing the ball to serve. Alcaraz rifled two consecutive return winners to break for a 3-1 lead only to see Safiullin break back in the next game with a forehand pass. Alcaraz dropped serve again in the seventh game,

hitting a forehand long at the end of a long rally. Safiullin converted his second match point when Alcaraz sent a forehand return wide.

"Even if he's not in the best shape, it's tough to beat him, so I'm really happy that I made it," Safiullin told the ATP.

Last season, Alcaraz became the youngest year-end No. 1 in the history of the ATP rankings. He is looking to achieve the extraordinary feat of claiming two year-end No. 1 finishes at only 20.

Top-ranked Novak Djokovic had racked up 500 more points than Alcaraz this season before the Paris Masters.

Djokovic won't be able to clinch the year-end No. 1 spot in Paris since Alcaraz still gets 10 points for his second-round defeat.

There are 1,000 points for the Paris Masters winner and 1,500 points for a perfect run at the ATP Finals.

Daniil Medvedev also has an outside chance of finishing the season as the No. 1 player.

The fifth-seeded Andrey Rublev, the 16th-seeded Karen Khachanov, Tallon Griekspoor, Alexander Bublik and Daniel Altmaier also moved into the third round.



Bhavina gives wings to 2 para athletes's sporting dreams

Para table tennis player Bhavina Patel is now doing for others what she wished someone had done for her also - giving wings to someone's sporting dreams with much-needed financial support.

In 2021, Bhavina became only the second Indian woman to win a Paralympic medal when she clinched the silver in women's singles table tennis class 4 final. It was also the country's first medal in para table tennis.

A medal in a multi-sport event in India brings with it a lot of perks including fame, attention, sponsors and cash rewards.

And after her Tokyo Paralympic silver medal, Bhavina thought of ways how she could make the Indian Para athletic movement stronger. One day she had an epiphany and Bhavina knew what she had to do.

"After Tokyo, I got a lot money. I thought what should I do, how can I help others. So now I am sponsoring two players," Bhavina told PTI.

Daughter of Hasmukhbhai Patel, a small-time shopkeeper at Sundhiya village in Gujarat's Mehsana district, Bhavina was diagnosed with polio when she was only 12 months old.

"I come from a small village. I never dreamed that I'd play table tennis but today I have a lot of knowledge and I want to share it."

"The more exposure para athletes get the better it is for them. I had to face a lot of financial problems, I don't want others to face the same," the wheel-chair-bound athlete said. One could sense the pride in Bhavina voice when she said, "I have adopted two para athletes. I take care of their training expenses etc as per their requirements."

Pragya Ghildial and Jashvant Choudhary are the two para table tennis players Bhavina is supporting.

Pragya, who injured her spinal cord in a road accident in 2005, and Bhavina were rivals and also partnered together for doubles way back in 2008.

An extrovert who wanted to try new things, Pragya, ventured into different sports and would compete on and off until the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 following which she quit sports. "I know Bhavina since the time I took up table tennis in 2008. She and I used to compete against each other. We also played doubles together. I left table tennis after the Delhi Commonwealth Games in 2010," the Delhi-based Pragya said.

Third division Port Vale advances to English League Cup quarterfinals

While Premier League giants Manchester United, Liverpool and Arsenal do not yet know if they will advance to the quarterfinals of the English League Cup, third-division Port Vale has already secured its place in the next round. The Midlands-based team has never played higher than the second tier of English soccer and has never won one of its major trophies.

But it could be rubbing shoulders with some of the biggest teams in the land in the last eight of the cup after a 1-0 win against Mansfield on Tuesday. Alfie Devine's goal five minutes into the second half at One Call Stadium ended fourth-division Mansfield's own hopes of a potential quarterfinals matchup against top-flight opposition. Port Vale will not



be the only team from outside the Premier League in the next round after Middlesbrough came back to beat third-division Exeter 3-2. Middlesbrough won the League Cup in 2004 and is hoping to secure promotion to the Premier League this season under manager Michael Carrick, who lifted every major club prize during a storied playing career at Manchester United.

But Port Vale is turning out to be the story of the competition so far as the lowest-ranked team remaining and having advanced to the quarterfinals for the first time in its history. Its fans will likely be hoping to be drawn against the likes of United or Liverpool

if those teams advance Wednesday. Defending champion United hosts Newcastle at Old Trafford, with manager Erik ten Hag coming under increasing pressure to turn his team's form around after seven defeats in all competitions this season.

Liverpool travels to Bournemouth, while West Ham hosts Arsenal.

With Chelsea, Everton, Burnley and Fulham also still vying to advance, there is every chance Port Vale could face top-flight opposition in the next round.

Aishwary wins 50m rifle 3P gold in Asian Shooting C'ships

Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar won the gold medal in the men's 50m rifle 3 positions individual event and helped India grab a team silver at the Asian Shooting Championship in Changwon, Korea on Wednesday. The 22-year-old Tomar shot 463.5 in the final to win the gold. China's Tian Jiaming took the silver with a score of 462.7. Another Chinese, Du Linshu picked up the bronze with 450.3. Tomar had finished fifth in the qualification round with 591.

The Indian trio of Tomar, Swapnil Kusale and Akhil Sheoran won the team silver with a total score of 1764, behind China (1777). India has already got maximum two possible Olympic quota places in this event through Kusale and Sheoran. Kusale had won the Paris Games quota during the World Championships in Cairo last year. Sheoran did the same in this year's World Championships in Baku.
