Cops also called in the trio's parents for questioning and informed them to keep an eye on the children if they develop any such habits.

The video that went viral in the meantime showed some locals questioning the students in uniform about the tubes of adhesives found in their bags. Used for repairing tyre punctures, the residents suspected the kids of using it for intoxication. The tubes and tools were recovered from three students aged 9, 10 and 13 years. As they could not give satisfactory responses, the locals shot a video and alerted the cops. "We did not get any evidence to prove that the materials were used for intoxication. After finding it, the children kept the material in their were used for intoxication. After finding it, the children kept the material in their bags, but we could find no trace of them using these for intoxication," said a police officer. "The residents made a video of the kids and were in a hurry to share it. The filming of the children violates the law," said the police.
