

WESTERN RAILWAY TO RUN FIVE MORE PAIRS OF FESTIVAL SPECIAL TRAINS

Ahmedabad, For the convenience of passengers and with a view to meet the travel demand during the ensuing festive season, Western Railway is running 344 trips of Festival Special Trains on Special Fare to various destinations. According to a press release issued by Shri Sumit Thakur - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, five pairs of Festival Special trains that have been notified include Sabarmati - Danapur, Vande Bharat - Vadodra - Gorakhpur, Ahmedabad - Nagpur, Patna and Ahmedabad - Samastipur. Festival Special trains, with running of these Festival Special trains, almost 6 lakh passengers will be benefited especially during this festive season. Details of the festival special trains are as under:

1. Train No. 09403/09404 Sabarmati - Danapur Superfast Special (Weekly) [6 Trips]: Train No. 09403 Sabarmati - Danapur Superfast Special will depart from Sabarmati every Sunday at 08.15 hrs. and reach Danapur at 14.15 hrs. the next day. This train will run from 23rd November to 26th November 2023. Similarly, Train No. 09404 Danapur - Sabarmati Superfast Special will depart from Danapur every Monday at 18.00 hrs. and reach Sabarmati at 23.30 hrs the next day. This train will run from 13th November, 2023 to 27th November, 2023. Enroute this train will halt at Mahesana, Palanpur, Abu Road, Ajmer, Jaipur, Bandikui, Bharatpur, Alwar, Chittorgarh, Tunda, Etawah, Kanpur Central, Prayagraj, Patna, Gaya, Bhagalpur, and Patna Sahib station in both direction. Kushagra murder: Textile bizmen seek strict punishment

Surat: Traders held a meeting in the textile market area in the city on Friday demanding strictest punishment to the murderers of Kushagra Kanodia (16) who was killed on October 31 in Kanpur of Uttar Pradesh (UP). Kushagra's father Manish is a textile broker in the city and has an office in India Textile Market.

Talking with over phone, Kushagra's father Manish, said, "It is unbelievable for us that my son was killed by his teacher

We demand that the accused should get the strictest punishment."

A number of textile businessmen and office bearers of various

associations joined the meeting. They paid homage to the departed soul by offering flowers to a garlanded photo and performed prayer. The gathering also maintained silence in memory of Kushagra.

In the murder of Kushagra, her tuition teacher Rachita and her boyfriend Prabhat Shukla's role have been investigated by the police.

A fire broke out in a godown containing discarded cosmetics in Thane district. Fortunately, there were no casualties. The fire was extinguished by eleven fire engines dispatched to the location. The cause of the fire is still being investigated.

Stolen agrochemicals worth 80 crore recovered, 2 nabbed

Surat: Police on Thursday busted a gang operating a racket to steal agrochemicals meant for export. Police recovered

stolen chemicals worth Rs 800 crore. Police arrested two persons — truck driver Manish Sharma (32) and businessman Chirag Bagadiya (35) — for their alleged involvement in the racket. At least six other truck drivers are said to be arrested. Police recovered the stolen goods from multiple locations in and around the city. The accused

replaced the chemical bags with sandbags to match the weight at the time of delivering the containers at Hazira port.

Two theft offences were registered at Kosamba police station in Surat district. One case of theft is being investigated by Detection of Crime Branch, Vadodra. "The offences were registered in October, though the thefts were committed in August. Police recovered all the stolen material," said inspector R B Bhatol of local crime branch, Surat rural police. Chemicals

of two companies with facilities in Jambusar GIDC and Saykha GIDC in Bharuch district had been stolen.

Another company whose chemical was stolen is in Vadodara. The agrochemical manufacturing companies came to know about the thefts when the consignments reached their destination. The containers were meant to be sent to Germany and the US. When the receiver found sandbags in the containers, they alerted the exporters.

So far, police investigation has revealed that the accused took the trucks to an industrial plot in Bajrangar Industrial Estate of Pipodara and stole the bags of chemicals there. "A gang is operating this racket, and some key players are to be arrested. They were in touch with their truck drivers and took their help to steal the products," said V Chandrasekhar, IGP, Surat range. The accused did not find buyers for the stolen material since these chemicals have no demand locally.

Rape survivor's kin booked for vandalizing man's house

Rajkot: Family members of a 27-year-old rape survivor were booked for rioting after they vandalized the house of the accused near Morbi and set ablaze a rickshaw parked on Friday night. The police had arrested the accused, an Instagram friend of the married woman after she lodged a complaint against him, alleging that he forcibly took her to his maternal uncle's farm, raped her, and forced her to marry. The woman managed to escape from the farm and called her relatives who admitted her to the civil hospital. However, her 14-15 other relatives went to the accused's house in Nani Dahisar village near

Morbi vandalized it. According to the complaint lodged by the accused's sister with Maliya-Miyana police station, the men barged into the house, vandalized the furniture and even threatened to set it ablaze. They were armed with axes and other weapons. They even threatened to kill her brother. Their rickshaw parked outside his house was also torcht with petrol. She said that her husband suffered a total loss of Rs 40 lakh. The police have sought call detail records of the accused to ascertain if they were at the location at the time of the incident. The woman had befriended the accused on Instagram about three months ago and they

used to regularly chat on video calls. They were booked for rioting, criminal intimidation and issuing death threats and other relevant sections of the IPC.

He also criticized the Centre for allegedly misusing the Enforcement Directorate. Gehlot stated that the ED targeted the Congress leader because he is vocal against the BJP. Additionally, Gehlot promised school education in English medium, buying cow dung at Rs 2 per kg, and an insurance cover for losses in natural disasters.
