Doctors remove knife from man's neck after his suicide bid

AHMEDABAD: A 57-year-old man was rushed to the Civil Hospital with a knife lodged in his neck. Tired of mental health issues, the Nana Chitroda resident had tried ending his life by stabbing himself in the neck. He fell unconscious and was spotted in time to be rushed to the Civil Hospital where the knife was surgically removed. Civil Hospital officials said the man tried to kill himself on October 31. His family took him to the hospital where the emergency care staff could see only the knife's handle sticking out of his neck. Dr. Ja Upadhyay, professor and head of the

hospital's ENT department, said sonography and x-ray revealed that the knife had luckily missed the main artery, but the patient had lost a lot of blood. "He was taken to the operation theatre and the knife was removed in a surgery that lasted for over three hours. Any delay could have been fatal," she said. A 28-year-old man was arrested in Chennai for allegedly abducting home-aid women at knife-point. He was also known to steal women's underwear. The man was caught by a group of youths who formed a team to patrol the area after receiving complaints. The suspect, identified as Tamizh Prabhu, confessed to targeting houses where women lived alone or their husbands worked night shifts.

Instagram affair: Woman's lover kills husband

RAJKOT: A crime with all trappings of an estranged relationship, love affair aided by social media, and sinister plot to eliminate the husband was unraveled in Porbandar on Wednesday with the cold-blooded murder of a 35-year-old man.

Early in the morning, 65-year-old Jessa Odedara and the body of his son Raju in a pool of blood at the latter's house.

He immediately approached the Kamlabag police naming his wife Krupali

and her paramour Nitesh Vekariya (23) as suspects. After the day-long investigation, police arrested Vekariya and Krupali's brother Vishal Samani (23) who had come down to Porbandar from Rajkot with the plan to kill Odedara.

According to details of the case, Odedara was married to a woman named Nita 15 years ago. However, they settled for a mutual divorce two years after marriage. About eight years ago, Odedara and Krupali fell

in love and got married. They have a seven-year-old daughter from the marriage.

After about a year issue, Krupali, who was active on Instagram met Vekariya and fell in love with him. The affair turned serious as she severed the eight-year relationship with Odedara and went to live with Vekariya in Rajkot where he works as a driver.

Odedara, who was deeply in love with Krupali, convinced her to return home and tried to normalize their relationship.

Some two months ago she returned to his house in Porbandar. However, after living for barely a fortnight, she left the house again and went back to Vekariya. Odedara, however, did not give up his efforts to bring her back.
