Namburi eyes Sathupalli seat

IN a strategic move, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) had nominated senior Dalit leader Namburi Ramalingeshwara Rao to contest from the Sathupalli Constituency. Recognising his decade-long commitment to the party, the BJP has bestowed the ticket upon him.

Hailing from an agricultural background, the 52-year-old leader holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from JNTU Hyderabad. Namburi's political journey began in student organisations and as a contributor to Telugu daily papers, showcasing his early dedication to public service.
