Minor kept hostage, gang-raped in Gwalior

A 17-year-old girl was allegedly kidnapped, held hostage and gang-raped in Gwalior, police said on Wednesday. The incident took place under Bilowa police station limit on October 31. Two girls, who were friends, were preparing for Class 10 examination. One girl approached the victim seeking help in study. While chatting, the friend took her to a lonely place and handed her over to one of their known friends. The known person handed over the girl to another man and left the spot. The accused raped the girl and tied her hands. After committing crime, he thrashed her.

Next day, when the family members searched the girl in the village, the man left girl and fled. He threatened the girl not to expose names of kidnappers. When the girl reached home, she narrated the ordeal to family members. Seeing the girl's condition, family members did not approach police immediately. They lodged the complaint after six days. Gwalior Additional Superintendent of Police Rishikesh Meena said FIR had been registered in the case. The facts are being investigated and appropriate action will be taken, he added. There are four accused in the case. A team has been formed by the police and efforts are underway to trace them.

287 vehicles checked, Rs 2.63L fine imposed on traffic rule violators

4-yr RI for candidate, impersonator

Special Judge, CBI, in Gwalior on Wednesday sentenced candidate Jitendra Singh and impersonator Jaideep Singh to four years of rigorous imprisonment along with fine of Rs 14,100 each, for committing fraud in police constable recruitment examination conducted by Vyapam in 2012. Middleman Amit Sachan and candidate's brother Narendra Singh will undergo three years of rigorous imprisonment with fine of Rs 1,000 each in this regard. The CBI had registered

the case on Supreme Court's order. Earlier, a case was registered at Police Station in Dehat, Bhind. It was alleged that Jitendra Singh, native of Bhind district, had filled two application forms for police constable recruitment examination 2012, mentioning different residential address. He was allotted two different examination centres. His appearance in written test was registered at both the examination centres on the same date and time. After the trial, the court found them guilty and convicted them.

Retd bank employee, daughter found murdered at home

In a shocking incident, a retired bank employee and his divorced daughter were found murder at his place under Sanyogitaganj police station on Wednesday evening. They were hit by a heavy object by the killer. The bank employee's son, who is a prime suspect in this double murder, is missing. A manhunt has been launched to nab him. ACP (Sanyogitaganj)

Tushar Singh identified the father-daughter duo as Kamal Kishore Dhamande (76) and Rama Arora (53). Dhamande lived in IDA Building in Samwad Nagar near Navlakha Bus Stand. Rama was his elder daughter. The duo was found murdered by Dhamande's youngest son-in-law. Later, the police ascertained that the bodies were two days old and had injury marks on their heads. The cops suspect that they were killed by a heavy object following a

struggle with the killer. While both bodies were found in a bedroom, blood stains were also found in another room. However, the police failed to recover murder weapon from the spot. Preliminary investigations revealed Dhamande, Rama and his son Pulind stayed in the house, while his wife was staying with her youngest daughter somewhere in the city. As her brother Pulind was missing, police suspect him to be the prime suspect.

Class 10 student dies under suspicious circumstances

A 16-year-old boy died on the intervening night of Tuesday-Wednesday following a three-day long fever, the police said. The police suspect foul play, as foam was coming out of his mouth when he was rushed to the hospital. Investigating officer (IO) Bhagwat Singh told Free Press the boy who died has been identified as Sumit Jatav (16), a student of Class 10 at a private school in the city. He had been suffering from fever since November 5. His kin told the cops they had taken him to the People's hospital when his fever relapsed on Tuesday. He was given medications, after which his condition became stable. He was later discharged from hospital. But on the intervening night of Tuesday-Wednesday, his condition started deteriorating and he was rushed to Hamidia hospital. He died while undergoing treatment there. According to doctors, foam had been coming out of Jatav's mouth when he was brought to the hospital. The body was sent for post mortem to ascertain the exact reason for the death.

BJP putting up anti-Nath posters: Cong complains to EC

Later, Yadav claimed that IMC team had put up the poster on the diklat of BJP candidate from Indore-1 assembly seat Kailash Vijayvargiya and BJP leader Narendra Saluja, who was expelled from Congress. We have lodged a complaint with Election Commission of India (ECI) in this regard." He also asked the ECI to declare Indore-1 constituency as sensitive one. Denying Yadav's claim, Saluja said that the BJP never indulged in dirty politics and added that hte party was contesting elections on development plank.

'90% Indians unaware of protein necessity'

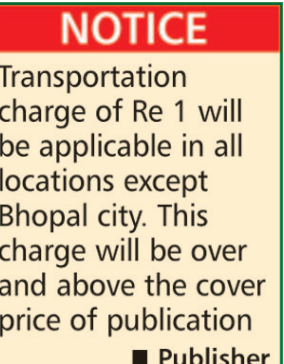

According to a survey, 73% of Indians do not consume the recommended daily amount of protein and over 90 are unaware of this necessity, said Dr Rohini Patil, a nutritionist from Pune. "It also revealed that many households in India are not aware of importance of protein as vital macronutrient. The study, primarily involving mothers, found that most of them lacked an understanding of essential role of protein and reasons for consuming it," she added. She was speaking at an event, Badam Pe Charcha, a natural approach to mitigating India's protein problem, in the city on Wednesday. She said some misconceptions that food containing protein causes weight gain and that it's hard to

digest. The facts are that protein consumption can help to prevent weight gain, help one feel satiated, along with being good for muscle health. Commonwealth gold medalist (karate) Supriya Jatav said, "As a karate player, I've come to understand just how vital proper nutrition is for optimal performance. It's like the best friend my muscles need for growth and quick recovery."
