Airport operator(s) resorting to such practices (mandating the availing of optional non-aeronautical services as a prerequisite for aeronautical services as a prerequisite for aeronautical services, if any, are in clear violation of the AERA Act, 2008," it adds. Sources privy to the developments said the airport operator has imposed a RS 50,000 decongestion charge per charter in addition to a non-aero ancillary charge per aero ancillary charge per passenger of Rs 17,857 plus 18% goods and services tax (GST). An email questionnaire sent to Adani Airports on Thursday went unanswered. "These charges increase the cost of travel by at least 40%.
