In a press conference held in Munugode, AICC General Secretary and former Union Minister Jairam Ramesh expressed concern over the alleged ten-year continuation of Nizam's rule in Telangana. He criticised Chief Minister KCR, accusing him of neglecting governance and confining himself to his farmhouse.

Ramesh highlighted the upcoming Assembly elections as a battleground between Congress and a coalition of BRS, BJP, and MIM. He confidently asserted that Congress, backed by the people's support, will seize power in the State. Accusing KCR of a lax attitude Ramesh claimed that the Chief Minister failed to fill vacant positions in government departments over the past decade, leading to a tragic surge in unemployment-related suicides. He recalled the efforts of Telangana MPs from 2012 to 2014, emphasising Sonia Gandhi and then-Prime Minister Manmohan Singh's role in establishing the separate State. Criticising the concentration of power within a single family, Ramesh argued that the current administration's limited scope is causing hardships for the common people. He urged the citizens of Telangana to rally behind
